

Stamp and Cover Sales Circuits - Upon request, sales circuits containing stamps and covers based upon the collecting interests of the members of each individual chapter, are sent as often as once a month. They are shipped to arrive just prior to the Chapter's scheduled meeting date and may be retained for 30 days thereafter. A special discount, based upon the total purchases of their members, is given to Chapters to help defray return mailing costs of the circuits.

Chapter Newsletter Competition - The Chapter Newsletter Competition gives clubs the opportunity to showcase their publication and have them critiqued. Judged by experts, awards are presented based on content and layout. Entries are displayed at the annual APS Stampshow.

Research Library - An APS Chapter and all its members are entitled and encouraged to utilize the vast resources of the American Philatelic Research Library. A nominal fee is charged to cover the costs of book loans and photocopies of short articles. The Library publishes a quarterly journal, Philatelic Literature Review, to which APS Chapters may subscribe.
