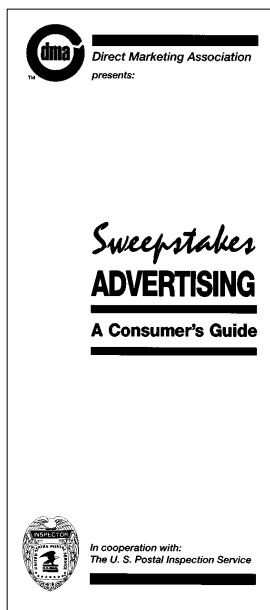
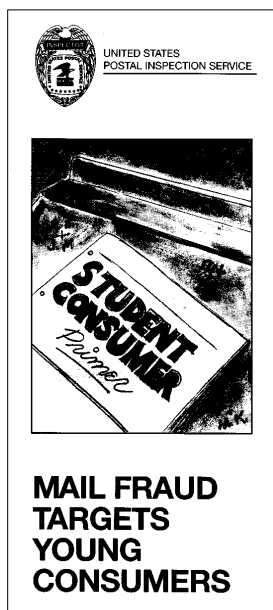

Two New Consumer Publications Now Available



The Postal Inspection Service has produced two new publications that postmasters are encouraged to order from the material distribution centers. The first, Publication 546, *Sweepstakes Advertising*, describes the differences between sweepstakes promotions, premium promotions, and lotteries. It also tells consumers how to determine when a sweepstakes promotion is likely to be fraudulent.

The second, Publication 548, *Mail Fraud Targets Young Consumers*, warns secondary school age consumers of the various mail fraud schemes that target young consumers, such as work-at-home schemes and credit card and advance fee loan scams. The brochure contains valuable tips for recognizing and avoiding fraudulent schemes and lists hot line phone numbers for the Inspection Service and the National Consumer's League.

Selective Service System Registration Program

The U.S. Postal Service and the Selective Service System (SSS) have an interagency agreement whereby the Postal Service agrees to administer Selective Service registrations at all classified post offices, stations, and branches. Selective Service registration is still an ongoing function, and window service personnel are reminded that registrations are to be accepted from our customers. SSS reimburses the Postal Service for its participation in this program.

The SSS Form 6, *Transmittal Sheet*, is mailed directly to post offices from the Selective Service office. Return SSS Form 6 by First-Class Mail only. Do not use any special service (such as certified mail) in addition to the First-

Class rate. SSS reimburses the Postal Service only for First-Class postage.

Revised Official National Zone Charts

Revised zone charts for all zone-rated mail will be available by July 1. Customers who wish to receive a complete set of national zone charts may purchase the complete set from the National Customer Support Center (NCSC) on electronic media at \$35 each or computer-printed hard copy (526 pages) at \$15 each. The NCSC accepts MasterCard or VISA as a method of payment. An order form is attached for your convenience (see page 17).

Customers may obtain official zone chart local data (1–2 pages) free of charge upon request from the postmaster at the office of mailing. Customers also may request a limited number of individual zone charts from the local post offices for a nominal fee.

Conditions Applied to Mail Addressed to Military Post Offices Overseas

Mail addressed to, from, or between military post offices overseas is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. The table below outlines these conditions by APO/FPO ZIP Code through the use of footnoted mailing restriction codes, which appear on the last page of the table.

Acceptance clerks should use this table with the inte-

grated retail terminal (IRT) to determine whether an APO/FPO ZIP Code is active and what conditions of mailing apply. For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, refer to Handbook PO-514, *Express Mail Military Service*, and the local EMMS directory.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2966-A is required. Prepaid mail from a contractor addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use—Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or an exemption endorsement.

B1. Form 2966-B is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

B2. Form 2966-A is required except on official mail, which does not require customs declaration or exemption endorsement. The AAFES will furnish a computer listing of all items mailed from its activities to Philippine APOs. Other mail order companies must either use Form 2966-A on each item or provide computer lists. Computer listings must include a description of the items, the dollar values of the items, and complete address including the PSC box number and APO of the addressee, the date of mailing, the insurance registry number, if applicable, and the serial number of any item over \$25 in value and any electrical item with a plug over \$15 in value.

B3. Form 2966-A is required for mailing between MPOs. Prepaid mail from contractors addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use—Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or exemption endorsement.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotape, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers or cordless telephones are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C022.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, second- and third-class mail are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

Length

42" 72" length and girth combined
 over 42" to 44" 24" girth
 over 44" to 46" 20" girth
 over 46" to 48" 16" girth
 Maximum length 48"

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM part C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 12 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All second-class, third-class, and fourth-class mail (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Use Form 2966-A, *Parcel Post Customs Declaration—United States of America* (self-adhesive label), for merchandise and all articles subject to customs duty. Include commercial invoice in each item.

Domestic Postal Money Orders

As detailed on pages 36 through 38 of *Postal Bulletin* 21887, dated February 16, 1995, and on pages 26 and 27 of *Postal Bulletin* 21892, dated April 27, 1995, the domestic postal money order form will no longer be sold for payments outside the United States, its territories and possessions, and the Freely Associated States. To enforce this action, the following restrictive endorsement is being placed in bold red lettering on the lower right face and in black ink on the reverse of all domestic postal money orders:

NEGOTIABLE ONLY IN THE U.S. AND POSSESSIONS

Domestic money orders bearing this restrictive endorsement will be available for sale after June 15, 1995. You may use existing supplies of the current domestic money orders until supplies are exhausted.

In anticipation of changing sales patterns resulting from this action, all retail clerks should maintain a supply of the pink international postal money order form (MP1) and the authorization to issue an international money order form set. If operational conditions dictate, offices are permitted to break packages of the pink international postal money

orders and individually assign them to retail clerks. A record detailing which serial numbers have been assigned to each clerk must be maintained.

Lobby posters advertising that domestic postal money orders will be honored only domestically are being prepared in English and Spanish, and will be disseminated to all offices. In addition, a notice will be placed on the Postal Vision system.

Retail clerks are not required to inquire of postal customers at the point of sale as to whether they will be sending domestic money orders to foreign countries; however, if clerks have reason to believe that customers intend to send funds to a foreign country, they should direct the customers' attention to the lobby posters.

The domestic and international banking systems have been notified of the Postal Service's policy regarding domestic money orders. International banks have also been notified that if they accept domestic postal money orders bearing the restrictive endorsement the Postal Service will initiate "charge back" action.

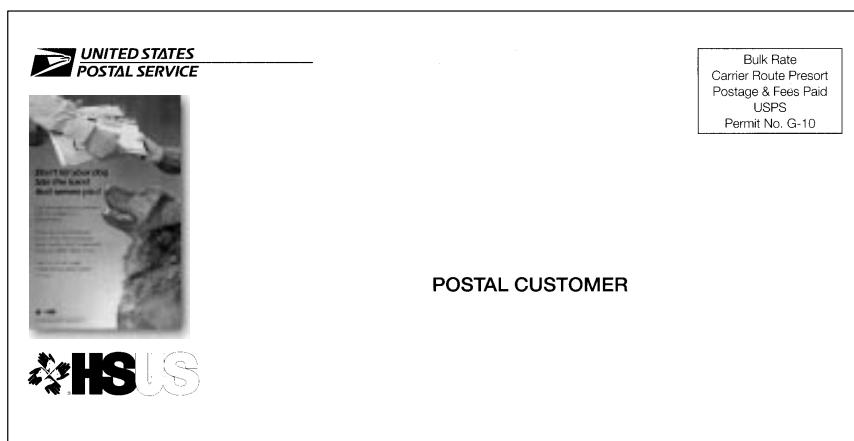
National Dog Bite Prevention Week, June 12–17, 1995

National Dog Bite Prevention Week June 12 – 17

More than 2 million dog bites are reported each year in the United States. It's a serious problem for everyone — not just the 2,700 letter carriers who were bitten last year. It's a problem we all can help solve! Here are some safety tips for you and your family.

How to avoid being bitten:

- Don't run past a dog. The dog's natural instinct is to chase and catch prey.
- If a dog threatens you, don't scream. Avoid eye contact, try to remain motionless until the dog leaves, then back away slowly until the dog is out of sight.
- Don't approach a strange dog, especially one that's tied or confined.
- Always let a dog see and sniff you before you pet the animal.

How to be a responsible dog owner:

- Spay or neuter your dog — unneutered dogs are more likely to bite!
- When your letter carrier comes to your home, keep your dog inside, away from the door in another room or on a leash.
- Don't let your child take mail from the letter carrier in the presence of your dog. Your dog's instinct is to “protect” the family.
- Obedience training can teach your dog proper behavior and help you control your dog in any situation.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 95-12

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

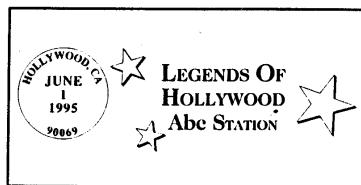
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage

(32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 Code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Alice Hamilton, MD, Stamp (Great Americans Series)

The Postal Service will issue a 55-cent Alice Hamilton, MD, stamp (Item 1017) in a pane of 100 on July 11, in Boston, MA. The stamp, designed by Chris Calle of Ridgefield, CT, goes on sale nationwide on July 12.

The stamp features Alice Hamilton, MD, who earned her medical degree from the University of Michigan in 1893. Following study in Germany, she spent 22 years in Chicago as a resident at Jane Addams' Hull House, where her eyes were opened to the problems of the working class in industrialized America. One of her many firsts include a study, published in 1911, conclusively demonstrating the prevalence of lead poisoning in industry, leading to measurable improvements in many factories. Her subsequent work included the dangers of poisons used or produced in explosives manufacture, the effects of the air hammer on the hands of stonecutters, the occurrence of spastic anemia in workers who used jackhammers, and the perils of monoxide emissions in steel mills. Dr. Hamilton was also responsible for the discontinuation of use of "dope poisoning" in the manufacture of airplanes during WWI. In 1919, Alice Hamilton became the first woman appointed to the Harvard faculty when she joined a new joint program in industrial hygiene between Harvard Medical School and the Harvard School of Public Health. In 1915, she was a delegate to the International Congress of Women at The Hague, and in 1928, Dr. Hamilton was one of two physicians appointed in a U.S. delegation to a League of Nations Health Commission. In 1924, at the invitation of the Soviet Union's Department of Health, she visited the USSR and, upon her return, her commentary concerning their dedication to economic equality led the House Committee on Un-American Activities in 1949 to label her a supporter of "Communist

fronts." At age 93, in 1963, she signed an open letter protesting continuing U.S. military involvement in Vietnam. Dr. Hamilton died in 1970 at the age of 101. Dr. Hamilton was a leading social reformer in the new century. Her scientific texts and papers, the individuals she mentored, and her spirit of inquiry have had a lasting impact on public health and social reforms of this century.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 30 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase the stamp at their local post office, affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place the items in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service returns the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by August 10, 1995.

Energy Conservation Through Lighting

The Energy Policy Act of 1992 requires the Postal Service to reduce energy consumption 20 percent by the year 2000. Using 1985 as the base year, Postal Service consumption has decreased 2.7 percent through FY94.

Since lighting is the major source of energy consumption within the Postal Service, "Turn Out The Lights When Not Needed" is the easiest way to reduce utility bills and conserve energy. Note that if lights and transmitting equipment such as RCUs or credit card terminals are on the same circuit, lights should not be turned off if this also turns off the transmitting equipment.

In some facilities, replacing or retrofitting existing lighting systems is energy efficient and economically beneficial. Lighting projects must be designed and reviewed by quali-

fied individuals to assure that state-of-the-art lighting technologies are installed and that the quality of lighting is maintained or improved.

The General Services Administration (GSA) and the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) have state-of-the-art lamps, ballasts, and fixtures. DLA provides technical information and procurement assistance through 1-800-DLA-BULB (1-800-352-2852). Postmasters and plant managers should "Turn Out The Lights When Not Needed" and contact their area energy coordinators for helping reduce energy consumption.

Alternative Financing of Energy Projects

Projections of Executive Order 12902 intensified interests in the alternative financing of energy retrofit projects. The Postal Service has generic shared energy savings contract documents and policy that must be followed on such projects.

Vendors may approach postmasters and plant managers with offers to provide services that include energy surveys and installation of energy-efficient equipment at zero cost. The contract offer may include payment stipulations that are tied to the utility bill or the local utility company. Utility companies may offer similar services. Postmasters and

plant managers should contact their local utility company to determine what energy-related services are available.

All proposal inquiries or contract offers for alternative financing of energy projects must be referred to the purchasing and materials service centers and the area energy coordinators. Additional information is available directly from these sources.

Energy Consumption Reporting

The Energy Consumption Reporting System was eliminated in 1992. Postmasters and plant managers are no longer required to submit energy consumption data unless notified by area energy coordinators.

Area energy coordinators will identify facilities where energy consumption will be monitored. Facilities will include all processing and distribution centers, processing and distribution facilities, airport mail facilities, airport mail centers, bulk mail centers, vehicle maintenance facilities, customer services greater than 50,000 square feet, and a

random selection of customer service area offices and customer service stations and branches.

Postmasters and plant managers should use their utility bills to track energy performance and should investigate any variances or unfavorable trends. They should contact the area energy coordinators for assistance.
