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Government Fiscal Year Closing Instructions for the Postal Service

Headquarters Closing Instructions

The Postal Fiscal Year 1997 (FY97) ends September 12, 1997. Accounting Period (AP) 13, FY97, will contain all activity in Budget Authorization (B/A) and finance number detail. AP 14, FY97 is a bookkeeping control period to accommodate the September 30, 1997, Government Fiscal Year (GFY) reporting requirements. Revenue and expense accruals will be generated mechanically at the national level for this period. No other revenue and expense activity will be recorded in AP 14, FY97. FY98 begins on September 13, 1997, and ends on September 11, 1998.

I. Trial Balance and Related Reports

The Minneapolis Information Service Center (ISC) will render the National Consolidated Trial Balance Report to Headquarters according to the following schedule:

The Minneapolis ISC will provide related financial reports within the normal time frame after trial balance reporting.

II. Capital and Expense Commitment Activities

All organizations must limit their expenditures to essential spending. All vice presidents must review all discretionary spending for nonpersonnel expense items. Automation and mechanization equipment expense contracts and remote barcoding sorting (RBCS) keying and maintenance contracts are considered nondiscretionary spending.

Capital. Purchasing will not accept any requisitions after August 22 unless work is currently under way on advance requirements or the buying manager grants an exception. Capital commitments, particularly Postal Support Equipment, should also be limited to essential needs.

Expenses. Year-end requirements for expense commitment activities follow. For FY97, a minimum of \$5,000 may be accrued per contract sequence number. For miscellaneous (non-commitment) expenses, a minimum of \$5,000 may be accrued per individual purchase or service.

Purchasing and Materials will process all requisitions for the issuance of contracts against FY97 funds according to the following priority:

- Priority 1 Capital commitment requisitions.
- Priority 2 Expense commitment requisitions.
- Priority 3 Expense non-commitment requisitions.

For requisitions received before September 12, Purchasing and Materials will make every attempt to issue the required contract in time for the San Mateo Accounting Service Center (ASC) processing against the FY97 budget. Contracts for requisitions requiring issuance of a solicitation or negotiations with vendors received between now and September 12 may not be issued in time for processing against FY97 funds. Requisitions received after September 12 will be processed for FY98.

All commitment documents with award dates prior to and including September 12 must be forwarded to reach the San Mateo ASC no later than September 15. Advise the San Mateo ASC of all goods and services received through September 12 by sending appropriate receiving reports or certified invoices to the San Mateo ASC no later than September 15. Budget coordinators must expedite processing of receiving reports and certified invoices to the San Mateo ASC. These documents are used to charge costs to the proper fiscal year.

If it is impossible to furnish a certified invoice in time to reach the San Mateo ASC before September 15, then complete Form 8163, *Request for Fiscal Year 1997 Expense Accrual*, found on page 11. Documentation must support these forms that are prepared for booking accruals (e.g., letters from vendors who have yet to bill for goods or services already delivered). Budget coordinators have received special instructions for processing these documents.

When you submit the actual certified invoice, include the statement "Accrued to FY97" on the face of the document.

Documents received at the ASC pertaining to September 13 and subsequent activity will be recorded in FY98.

A. USPS/GSA Purchasing Credit Card Program

Corporate Accounting at Headquarters will make arrangements with Rocky Mountain Bank to ensure that expense and capital purchases incurred through September 12 have been billed.

Capital, Expense, and Inventory Purchases. Rocky Mountain Bank will forward the August 18 VISA billing tape to the San Mateo ASC for processing in AP 13, FY97. Rocky Mountain Bank will forward a special September 12 VISA accrual tape to the San Mateo ASC for processing in AP 13, FY97, charged service-wide and reinstated (reversed) in AP 01, FY98. The September 18 VISA billing tape will be processed and paid against applicable finance numbers in AP 01, FY98. The normal VISA Credit Card Payment Report will be sent to approving officials after the billing tape is processed. Expenses for purchases made with the VISA card but not included on the September 12 accrual tape will also be paid against FY98 funds.

Note: All charges not on the August 18 billing will be charged to B/A Holder offices in FY98. No accruals will be accepted for any type of VISA card purchases. The September 18 billing will be the first of 12 tapes processed to B/A Holder offices in FY98. There will not be a tape processed in AP 10, FY98.

For purchases, credit card approving officials may manually reallocate their actual expense — within nonpersonnel categories and capital budget — to account for their credit card purchases, if they observe all guidelines on the use of the credit card.

B. Imprest Fund

Imprest fund cashiers should submit SF 1129, Reimbursement Voucher, for expenses incurred through September 12 to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15. Cashiers entering SF 1129s on-line must cut off by close of business (COB) September 12 for FY97 expenses. Do not use a Form 8163 for September 12 and prior expenses received after the cutoff.

C. Nonpostal Training

For completed nonpostal training, offices should submit an original Form 1782, *Training Request and Authorization*, with supporting documentation (e.g., invoice, canceled check) to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15 for payment in FY97. The ASC will not accept Form 1782 without supporting documentation. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue these expenses.

D. Government Printing Office

On September 12, the Government Printing Office (GPO) will deliver to the San Mateo ASC a magnetic tape of outstanding printing requisitions. The San Mateo ASC will establish accruals for those items not yet billed to the Postal Service that have a contractual deliver-by date of September 12 or earlier. Also on September 12, GPO will furnish a magnetic tape of outstanding printing requisitions that have been paid by GPO but not yet billed to the Postal Service. The San Mateo ASC will also establish accruals for these items. Headquarters Printing will coordinate this accrual information with GPO and the San Mateo ASC. A minimum of \$5,000 will be accrued for each GPO printing requisition.

Note: Headquarters Printing Purchasing will also coordinate non-GPO printing accruals. Printing purchases against basic pricing agreements (BPAs) will not be accrued.

E. FEDSTRIP

Headquarters offices authorized to make FEDSTRIP purchases should anticipate their needs through *September 12* and issue FEDSTRIP requisitions *no later than August 31*.

Exception: The material distribution centers (MDCs) may place FEDSTRIP orders through September 12. However, the St. Louis ASC must be advised no later than COB September 12 of all orders placed after August 31.

F. Utilities — Headquarters Field Revenue Offices Only

To estimate September 1–12 utility accrual, multiply .40 times the total utility bill for August 1997. Complete Form 8163 and submit to the San Mateo ASC.

Example:

AUGUST BILL = \$12,500 .40 X \$12,500 = \$5,000

The amount to be included on Form 8163 as the accrual for the first 12 days of September is \$5,000. Attach a copy of the August bill as documentation. A minimum of \$5,000 should be accrued per individual purchase or service.

G. Utilities — Non-revenue Offices Only

By September 15, all applicable offices must submit utility bills to the San Mateo ASC. To estimate September 1–12 utility accrual, multiply .40 times the utility bill for August. Complete Form 8163 and forward to San Mateo ASC. Attach a copy of the August bill as documentation.

H. Travel/Relocation

All Headquarters offices must promptly submit travel and/ or relocation vouchers through the proper administrative channels to the San Mateo ASC on the following schedules:

 Vouchers for all travel and/or relocation performed through September 12 must be received by the San Mateo ASC by September 15. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue these expenses. All other travel vouchers should be entered through remote entry sites by September 19.

Note: The traveler may need to request a hotel bill, car rental bill, etc., as of September 12 and submit a travel voucher for all expenses incurred as of September 12.

- Corporate Accounting at Headquarters will arrange with travel agencies to accrue expenses incurred for transportation costs under the American Express Government Travel Account (GTA).
- Costs incurred from relocation management firms services (e.g., transportation of household goods and home sale expenses) through September 12 will be accrued by Corporate Accounting at Headquarters.

I. Government Bills of Lading (GBL)

GBL invoices dated through September 12 must be transmitted to the San Mateo ASC by September 18. National Traffic Service (NTS) should resume transmission on September 22.

J. Liquidation of Accruals

Accruals must be liquidated as soon as possible. Offices submitting accruals must monitor their payments against those accruals to ensure that the accruals are properly liquidated. All FY97 accruals processed by the San Mateo ASC that remain unliquidated at the end of AP 06, FY98, will be reversed automatically as a prior year credit. Subsequent payments will be charged to the appropriate budget finance number as a FY98 expense.

K. Incentive Awards

Forms 1727, Award Recommendation/Authorization, and Vice President, SPOT, and Informal Awards forms for EAS employees, submitted in time to reach the Minneapolis ASC by September 9, will be recorded in AP 13, FY97. Such forms received after this date will be recorded in AP 01, FY98.

L. Back Pay Awards

All offices are requested to expedite the processing of back pay awards and forward the completed documentation to the Minneapolis ASC as soon as possible. Documents submitted for payment on or before September 12 must be received at the Minneapolis ASC by August 19 to ensure processing in AP 13, FY97.

Field Closing Instructions

These Postal Fiscal Year (FY) closing instructions and reporting dates published supplement the procedures followed during the normal accounting periods and/or quarterly reports. Address questions about these instructions to the local post office or district office for clarification or technical assistance.

I. Activities Affecting the Accounting Service Center (ASC)

A. Statement of Account Activities (Including CAPS)

The Accountbook for FY97 continues through COB September 12. Postmasters of CAG A–G offices and installation heads of processing and distribution centers (P&DCs), air mail centers (AMCs), remote encoding centers (RECs), bulk mail centers (BMCs), the Philatelic Fulfillment Center, the Stamp Depository, and the Stamped Envelope Unit, submit a statement of account that includes financial transactions from August 16 through September 12. Identify this statement as AP 13 and submit it on Form 1555, *Statement of Account (CAGs A–L)* (August 1996 edition). Offices and installations that use the Standard Field Accounting System (SFAS) will transmit the computerized Statement of Account

(SOA) and mail a hard copy of the SOA to the ASC as usual. The deadline for data entry of SOAs for all CAGs H–L offices not on SFAS is extended to Monday (noon, central daylight time), September 22, of AP 01, FY98. Normal quarterly processing deadline will resume in Quarter I, FY98.

Postmasters of CAG H–L offices must submit a Statement of Account for Quarter IV, covering May 24 through September 12, 1997. CAG H and L offices submit Form 1555. All offices must submit the statements of account to their district for on-line entry no later than Monday, September 15. The normal accounting period support detail items listed below must accompany them.

Account identifier code (AIC) support documents required:

Identify the required support documents with the AIC and finance numbers. The totals expressed in the support documents must agree with the amounts in the respective AIC and be arranged in the same order as listed on the statement of account.

- 1. Less-Than-Bulk Stamp Requisitions. Eliminate intransit stamp shipments between the stamp distribution office/stamp distribution network (SDO/SDN) and the associate offices. Post offices should carefully estimate their requirements and requisition in sufficient time to permit shipments by the SDO or the SDN no later than Friday, September 5. They should count in stamp stock promptly upon receipt and enter it in the Accountbook. In case of an emergency shipment, the district must ensure that the applicable office makes the proper entries in its Accountbook.
- 2. Bank Reconciliations. All banking post offices must reconcile their bank statements as of September 12 to balances reflected on statements of account in AIC 802, Cash in Bank (see Handbook F-1, Post Office Accounting Procedures, section 352).
- **3. Stamp Stock Inventories.** Verify stamp stock records by September 12 (see Handbook F-1, 428.4).
- 4. Local Procurement of Supplies. Offices must anticipate their AP needs and procure early in the AP. They must pay promptly all approved bills for goods and services authorized for payment.
- Accounts Payable and Reporting System (APARS). APARS will remain open for FY97 processing through Friday, September 19. It is important for district accounting offices to enter all bills for FY97 by COB Friday, September 19.

Note: Do not process payments applicable to FY98 during the week of September 15 because they will be erroneously charged to FY97.

6. Accruals—Goods and Services Received But Not Invoiced. The procedures for recording accruals have changed. Accruals will no longer be recorded to AIC 064 (Prior Year) on the Statement of Account. Accruals will now be reported using Form 8163 if amount(s) is \$5,000 or greater. A separate Form 8163 must be prepared for each transaction. For example: An expense has accrued for \$5,000 and \$3,000 for ABC Vendor. The applicable office (e.g., purchasing office, etc.) must complete Form 8163 for the \$5,000 expense only. The \$3,000 expense will not be accrued

for FY97 because the amount is less than \$5,000. This expense must be paid in FY98. Please note that accruals will not be established without proper documentation to support Form 8163 (e.g., letters from vendors who have yet to bill for goods/services delivered). This is not applicable to purchases with IMPAC VISA card.

If expense is less than \$5,000, the expense will be recorded in FY98.

By completing Form 8163, the San Mateo ASC will record the expense to the applicable finance number for FY97. During AP 1, FY98, the San Mateo ASC will credit the office for the amount shown on Form 8163. This credit will offset the expense when invoice is paid in FY98.

When the district accounting office enters the invoice in APARS, enter September 12, 1997, in the effective date field (EFF DATE on TXNs P20/928). By doing this, the San Mateo ASC will know that this payment relates to a prior year accrual. If this is not done, the accrued amount will not be liquidated. Unliquidated (credit) balances will be reversed by the San Mateo ASC in AP 07, FY98, and charged to the appropriate budgetary finance number.

The following procedures must be performed when recording accruals for \$5,000 or greater:

- During AP 13, FY97, the applicable office prepares Form 8163 for all items to be accrued over \$5,000. Please note that a separate form must be completed for each transaction that is \$5,000 or greater. This form must be submitted to the address listed in Number 3 below by September 15.
- For non-committed or non-contractual expenses, the following fields on Form 8163 do not have to be completed:
 - a. sequence number.
 - b. contract/task order number.
- 3. The applicable office forwards the original Form 8163 to the following address and maintains a copy locally:

- 4. When the invoice is received in FY98 for processing, the applicable office should annotate "Accrued to FY97" on the face of the document. Attach a copy of Form 8163 to the invoice and submit to the district accounting office for payment.
- The district accounting office will enter the invoice in APARS.

The district accounting office must enter September 12, 1997, as the effective date in the effective date field (**EFF DATE** on TXNs P20/928) in APARS. If the bill is not paid by AP 6, FY98, and September 12, 1997 is not entered in the

effective date field, the San Mateo ASC will reverse the credit that was made in AP 1, FY98. This is necessary for tracking the accruals recorded on Form 8163 for FY97.

Note: Do not process bills applicable to FY98 during the week of September 15. All payments entered to APARS through September 19 will be charged to FY97.

B. Miscellaneous Activities

- All Vehicle Maintenance Facilities (VMFs) Using USPS-Owned Vehicles. All offices conducting their final vehicle sale for FY97 must submit a copy of SF Form 97, The United States Government Certificate of Release of a Motor Vehicle, in time to reach the San Mateo ASC before COB Friday, September 12. Transmit microcomputer data by COB September 15, at 5 p.m. eastern daylight time (EDT).
- 2. Official Mail Accounting System (OMAS) Transactions. All OMAS transactions dated September 12 or earlier must be input to the Minneapolis ASC via the Distributed Data Entry/Distributed Reporting System (DDE/DR) no later than September 15. This includes original transactions as well as corrections of all suspended transactions. The Postal Service Financial Report (PSFR) for AP 13, FY97, will include transactions dated through September 12. Transactions dated after September 12 should be handled in the normal manner and will be included in AP 01, FY98.

3. Special Reminders

- a. Districts should ensure that all their CAG A–J offices mail Form 835, Quarterly Report of Originating Registered and COD Transactions, to the district for keying via the on-line system no later than September 19, for completion of data entry by September 25.
- b. Submit Forms 2130, Claim for Loss. Claims are adjudicated before using AIC 633. The date of the entry to the Claim for Loss AIC (519, 520, 633) in the Accountbook must be in AP 13 or Postal Quarter (PQ) IV.
- c. Fund Cost Transfers. All managers of administrative services must ensure that Form 7370, Request for Non-Cost Funds Transfer, is input in the Journal Voucher Transfer (JVT) System by COB Friday, September 12. If these forms cannot be entered in the JVT System by this date, they must be mailed to reach the Minneapolis ASC, General Accounting Section, by Tuesday, September 16.

II. Miscellaneous Activities Affecting the St. Louis ISC

A. Project Authorization Control System (PACS) Documents

All capital and expense commitment documents, Forms 4211, *Facility and Fixed Mechanization Project Contract*, must be received by September 12 at the St. Louis ISC for AP 13, FY97, processing. Commitment documents received after September 12 will be recorded in AP 01, FY98.

By September 5, the St. Louis ASC must receive all capital and expense payment documents, Forms 4211-A, Facility and Fixed Mechanization Project Contract Payment Authorization, and Forms 4211-B, Invoice and Payment Authorization, approved by contracting officers for AP 13 processing. Checks will be dated September 12.

By September 5, the St. Louis ASC must receive all appropriate Forms 1233, *Project Financial Change/Completion Report*, pertaining to AP 13 and prior.

During AP 13, a special year-end capital investment review is required whereby field-funded capital contracts and modifications must be approved by the area finance manager or the senior budget and financial analyst before the contract award.

B. Vehicle Hire

By September 15, all postal installations having vehicle hire for AP 13, ending September 12, must submit their payment certification reports to their servicing VMF for input into the Vehicle Management Accounting System (VMAS) for transmission by September 23.

No later than September 12, submit all prior period Forms 8049 to the St. Louis ISC. Submit Forms 1804-C, *Postmaster's Certification of SDM Equipment Maintenance*, to the St. Louis ISC by September 15.

C. FEDSTRIP Procurement

All offices should anticipate their needs through September 12 and submit FEDSTRIP requisitions no later than August 31. Do not submit requisitions from September 1 through September 12 except for emergency items.

D. Uniform Allowances

The district must process and transmit all invoices to the St. Louis ASC by COB September 9.

E. Money Orders

Postmasters must submit money order vouchers to the St. Louis ASC in accordance with Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, 744. Post offices on the Money Order Voucher Electronic Transmission (MOVET) system send in vouchers only on an exceptional basis when the electronic transmission fails.

F. Passport Activity

Postmasters must submit Form 5660, *Summary of Passport Applications Accepted*, to the St. Louis ASC on a normal Quarter IV schedule for AP 13, FY97, and PQ I, FY98.

III. Miscellaneous Activities Affecting the San Mateo ASC

A. All Offices Using USPS-Owned Vehicles

The San Mateo ASC will make arrangements to accrue expenses incurred for commercial oil company credit card purchases.

Certified invoices for bulk fuel, oil purchases, and motor vehicle parts other than BPAs with delivery dates of September 12 or prior must reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15.

All Forms 4541, Order-Invoice for Vehicle Repair (Commercial Work Order), and invoices for vehicle washing for work that was completed through September 12 must be submitted to the appropriate support VMF by September 15 for entry into VMAS and subsequent transmission to the San Mateo ASC for payment processing.

No accrual Form 8163 entries are to be submitted for activity relating to bulk fuel, oil purchases, and motor vehicle parts.

B. Mail Transport Equipment Centers

The Mail Transport Equipment Centers (MTECs)/Forest Park and Edgewater have been closed. All Inventory Materials will be written off in AP 13.

C. Payment or Submission of Bills

It is important for the year-end closing of accounts that all postal installations promptly certify and submit to the San Mateo ASC those bills and receiving reports for goods and services received through September 12 that the San Mateo ASC must pay. Submit these bills in time to ensure receipt at the San Mateo ASC no later than September 15. In order for the ASC to account for the remaining FY97 procurement items properly, please note:

 Expense Items. If goods or services were received before September 13 on contracts, or purchase or delivery orders, the receiving reports and certified invoices must reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15.

Evidence of receipt (receiving reports and certified invoices) on expense items are the documents used by the San Mateo ASC to charge cost to the proper fiscal year.

If offices have evidence of receipt of goods or services, but fail to notify the ASC, these costs will be charged to their FY98 budget.

If invoices for goods and services were received for BPAs, certify the BPA cover memorandum, attach appropriate invoices, and mail in time for receipt at the San Mateo ASC by September 15.

Note: It may be necessary to change the BPA September cover sheet cutoff to September 12 to submit the cover sheet to the San Mateo ASC in time. If invoices for non-metered fuel delivered before September 13 were received, submit certified invoices in time for receipt at the San Mateo ASC by September 15. There will be no accruals for BPAs or non-metered fuel.

2. Capital Equipment Items. During AP 13, a special year-end capital investment close-out is required. Before the contract award, field-funded capital contracts and modifications must be approved by the area finance manager or the senior budget and financial analyst.

All capital commitment documents dated or awarded on or before September 12 must be received at the San Mateo ASC by September 15 to ensure processing in AP 13, FY97. For capital goods received before September 12, submit the appropriate receiving reports to the San Mateo ASC.

3. Establishing Expense Accruals. A minimum of \$5,000 may be accrued per contract sequence number. For non-contractual miscellaneous expenses, the minimum of \$5,000 may be accrued per individual purchase or service. If it is impossible to submit a receiving report or certified invoice in time to be received at the San Mateo ASC by September 15, use Form 8163, Request for Fiscal Year 1997 Capital and Expense Accrual, on page 11 and mail it to the San Mateo ASC. Form 8163 must be accompanied by supporting documentation (e.g., letters from vendors indicating the dollar amount of services rendered through September 12, 1997).

Note: When you submit the actual invoice in FY98, include the statement "Accrued to FY1997" on the face of the document.

Facilities must review their service contracts and submit to the San Mateo ASC Form 8163 for any unbilled goods and services received September 12 and prior that states the amount to be accrued for FY97. Only if no certified invoice or receiving report was previously submitted, use Form 8163 appearing on page 11. For each contract, submit one Form 8163, signed by an appropriate individual. The San Mateo ASC must receive this notification by September 15.

Note: Do not submit Form 8163 if a certified invoice or receiving report was already submitted.

4. USPS/GSA Purchasing Credit Card Program. Corporate Accounting at Headquarters will make arrangements with Rocky Mountain Bank to ensure that expense and capital purchases incurred through September 12 have been billed.

Capital, Expense, and Inventory Purchases. Rocky Mountain Bank will forward the August 18 VISA billing tape to the San Mateo ASC for processing in AP 13, FY97. Rocky Mountain Bank will forward a special September 12 VISA accrual tape to the San Mateo ASC for processing in AP 13, FY97, charged to service-wide and reinstated (reversed) in AP 1, FY98. The September 18 VISA billing tape will be processed and paid against applicable finance numbers in AP 1, FY98. The normal VISA Credit Card Payment Report will be sent to approving officials after the billing tape is processed. Expenses for purchases made with the VISA card but not included on the September 12 accrual tape will also be paid against FY98 funds.

Note: All charges not on the August 18 billing will be charged to B/A Holder offices in FY98. No accruals will be accepted for any type of VISA card purchases. The September 18 billing will be the first of 12 tapes processed to B/A Holder offices in FY98. There will not be a tape processed in AP 10, FY98.

For purchases, credit card approving officials may manually reallocate their actual expense — within nonpersonnel categories and capital budget — to account for their credit card purchases, if they observe all guidelines on the use of the credit card.

D. Claims

All offices are requested to expedite the processing of tort claims and to forward completed tort claims that are within the San Mateo ASC's authority as rapidly as possible. Process all claims on hand and submit them by the COB September 12 to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15. These expenses will not be accrued; therefore, do not use Form 8163.

E. Travel and Relocation

All travel and relocation vouchers must be entered remotely or sent to the San Mateo ASC on or before the scheduled due dates furnished below. Employees traveling at the beginning of the accounting period who do not anticipate further travel before the close of the accounting period must prepare a voucher through September 12.

 The San Mateo ASC must receive vouchers for all relocation through September 12 no later than September 15. Remote on-line field users must also input all travel vouchers in the APARS by September 19. This includes the Remote Travel Pilots' activities. APARS will remain opened through September 19 for FY97 processing. **Note:** It may be necessary for the traveler to request a hotel bill or car rental bill as of September 12 and submit a travel voucher for all expenses incurred as of September 12. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue for these expenses.

- Area and District Finance Managers will arrange with travel agencies to accrue expenses incurred for transportation costs under the American Express GTA.
- 3. Employees must submit vouchers involving relocation expenses incident to a permanent change of duty station, if the expense is incurred on or before September 12, to arrive at the San Mateo ASC no later than September 15. These expenses will not be accrued; therefore, do not use Form 8163.
- 4. Costs incurred from relocation management firms services (e.g., transportation of household goods and home sale expenses) through September 12 must be submitted to Corporate Accounting and will be accrued by Corporate Accounting (Accounts Payable) at Headquarters.

F. Liquidation of Accruals

Accruals must be liquidated as soon as possible. Offices submitting accruals must monitor their accruals and payments against those accruals to ensure that the accruals are properly liquidated. All FY97 accruals processed by the San Mateo ASC that are not liquidated at the end of AP 6, FY98, will be reversed automatically as a prior year credit. Subsequent payments will be charged to the appropriate budget finance number as a FY98 expense.

G. Imprest Fund

Imprest Fund cashiers must submit SF Form 1129, Reimbursement Voucher, for expenses incurred through September 12, to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue for these expenses. Cashiers entering SF Form 1129 on-line must use September 19 as a cutoff for FY97 expenses.

H. Nonpostal Training

For training completed by September 12, offices must submit an original Form 1782, *Training Request and Authorization*, with supporting documentation (e.g., invoice, canceled check) to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 15. The San Mateo ASC will not accept Forms 1782 without supporting documentation. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue these expenses.

I. Government Printing Office (GPO) Expense and Government Printing Office Expense Accruals

The San Mateo ASC will receive GPO fiscal year-end billing magnetic tape by September 15. They will furnish an extract report to the funding offices for receipt verification and payment information. Due to time constraints, the procurement office must not return the GPO billing extract report to the ASC. There will be no opportunity to make adjustments to the extract report. However, significant errors on this report must be identified and reported to the San Mateo ASC.

The GPO will provide magnetic tapes of outstanding printing requisitions from which accruals will be established for those items with a contractual delivery date of September 12 and prior. Headquarters Printing Purchasing will coordinate the accrual information between GPO and the San Mateo ASC. Only printing requisitions greater than \$5,000 will be accrued.

J. American Express Government Travel Account

Corporate Accounting at Headquarters will make arrangements with the area office travel coordinators and travel agencies to accrue expenses incurred for transportation costs under the GTA program.

K. FTS2000

Corporate Accounting at Headquarters will arrange with the Raleigh Network Operations to accrue telecommunications expenses incurred for FTS2000.

L. Utilities — Revenue Offices Only

To estimate September 1–12 utility accrual, multiply .40 times the total utility bill for August 1997. Complete Form 8163 and submit to the San Mateo ASC.

Example:

AUGUST BILL = \$12,500 .40 X \$12,500 = \$5,000

The amount to be included on Form 8163 as the accrual for the first 12 days of September is \$5,000. Attach a copy of the August bill as documentation. A minimum of \$5,000 should be accrued per individual purchase or service.

L. Utilities — Non-revenue Offices Only

Submit all certified bills to the San Mateo ASC by September 15. Remote on-line field users must input all utility bills for non-revenue offices by September 19. To estimate September 1–12 utility accrual, multiply .40 times the utility bill for August. Complete Form 8163 and forward to San Mateo ASC. Attach a copy of the August bill as documentation.

N. Systems Purchasing Contracts

The San Mateo ASC will arrange with the vendors involved to ensure that expense purchases incurred through September 12 have been billed. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue for these expenses.

Exception: The San Mateo ASC will coordinate the Information Builders Incorporated (IBI) accrual with the contract administrator.

O. Non-Metered Fuel

Submit all certified bills to the San Mateo ASC by September 15. Do not use Form 8163 to accrue these expenses.

P. Government Bills of Lading (GBL)

GBL invoices dated through September 12 **must** be transmitted to the San Mateo ASC by September 18. There should be no transmission on September 19. National Traffic Service (NTS) should resume transmission on September 22.

IV. Miscellaneous Activities Affecting The Minneapolis ASC

A. Incentive Awards

Forms 1727, Award Recommendation/Authorization, and Vice President, SPOT, and Informal Awards forms for EAS employees, submitted in time to reach the Minneapolis ASC by September 9 are recorded in AP 13, FY97. Such forms received after this date will be recorded in AP 1, FY98.

B. Back Pay Awards

All offices are requested to expedite the processing of back pay awards and forward the completed documentation to the Minneapolis ASC as soon as possible. Documents submitted for payment on or before September 12 must be received at the Minneapolis ASC by August 29 to ensure processing in AP 13, FY97.

C. Carrier Drive-Out Payments

Submit all requests for reimbursements of expenses for carrier drive-out agreements, Forms 1839, *Payment Record for Carrier Drive Out Agreements*, and Form 1164-A, *Claim for Reimbursement for Postal Supervisors*, through normal approved channels prior to forwarding to the designated DDE/DR site for processing. To ensure that carrier drive-out payments incurred at the end of the FY are expensed in AP 13, FY97, submit all Forms 1839 to the servicing DDE/DR site (district) for input into the Employee Business Expense Processing System by Wednesday, September 10.

Ordering Procedures for Postmarking Ring Dies and Die Hubs

The prices below were effective September 1, 1996. This article supersedes the article in *Postal Bulletin* 21926 (8-15-96) and updates information in Publication 247, *Supply and Equipment Catalog*, pertaining to ordering ring dies and die hubs.

Special cancellation die hubs are nonpostal cancellations. Post offices may not order a special die hub on behalf of a sponsor before contacting and receiving authorization from Headquarters Business Mail Acceptance (BMA). After authorization has been granted, BMA will supply PS Form 3617, *Order for Special Canceling Machine Die Hubs* (May 1978). Additional set-up fees will be incurred for these dies.

Special cancellation die hubs may be ordered only if the request meets the description outlined in *Domestic Mail Manual* G900.2.1.

Ordering Procedures

- A. Form Number, Title, and Edition: PS Form 4636, *Post-marking Dies and Engraved Station Die Hubs Requisition* (February 1996).
- B. Use a separate form for each vendor from whom you are ordering. Ensure that the exact engraving is specified in the appropriate field. Customers may call the vendors for help in selecting the correct ring die; however, they should have the machine model and serial number available prior to making the call. Or you can contact your local Maintenance Department for assistance in determining the correct part number.
- C. Complete **all** information blocks in the lower portion of the form.
- D. Method of Payment: If paying by USPS Credit Card, include the Expiration Date and Card Number. If paying by check or money order, make payable to the appropriate vendor for the total amount, and attach to the PS Form 4636.
- E. Submit the completed forms directly to the vendors at the address listed in this article.
- F. Delivery of the ring dies and die hubs will be made about 60 days from the date the vendor receives the order. Shipping charges are included in the prices of the parts, which will be shipped via USPS First-Class Mail.
- G. Questions or problems may be addressed to the Topeka Material Distribution Center, Customer Service Department, at 1-800-332-0317, Option 3. The Minneapolis PMSC no longer handles these calls.

PS Form 4636 (February 1996, NSN 7530-02-000-9293, no Quick Pick Number) may be ordered from TMDC on PS Form 7380 or via TTOE, or may be copied from PUB 247.

Year dates may also be ordered from the TMDC using PS Form 7380 or TTOE.

To order type sets (months, days, etc.), your maintenance department must submit a request to TMDC using PS Form 4984, *Repair Parts Requisition*, and using its FEDSTRIP AAC.

Ordering Procedures for Rubber Stamps and Steel Hand Canceling Stamps

Effective immediately, this article supersedes the article published in *Postal Bulletin* 21943 (4-10-97) and modifies PSINs and pricing through February 28, 1999. Further, it updates information in Publication 247, *Supply and Equipment Catalog* (April 1996), as relates to ordering rubber and steel hand canceling stamps.

Ordering Procedures

- A. Form Number, Title, and Edition: PS Form 1567, Requisition for Rubber and Steel Hand Canceling Stamps (February 1996) (see pages 17–18 of this Postal Bulletin).
- B. Use a separate PS Form 1567 for each vendor. Note: If using an impression on PS Form 1567, be very careful to use the correct PSIN. Vendors have been instructed to use the impression rather than the PSIN if the two do not match.
- C. Complete all Requester Information (Items 4 through 10).
- D. Method of Payment:
- Place a check mark in the appropriate box.
- If paying by USPS credit card, include the expiration date and number.

- If paying by check or money order, make payable to the appropriate vendor.
- E. Send the completed forms to vendors at the addresses shown below.
- F. Expect delivery of requested stamps in approximately 30 days (note the exception for Hanley Postal Supply). Note: Delivery charges are included in the cost of the stamps.

PS Form 1567 (February 1996, NSN 7530-01-000-9360, Quick Pick Number 132) may be ordered from TMDC on PS Form 7380 or via TTOE, or may be copied from PUB 247.

F3 Fill is the corporate standard for the automation of internal postal forms. The software enables USPS employees and contractors to complete automated postal forms on their computers. These intelligent forms perform functions such as calculating, routing, generating pop-up lists, and providing help screens.

The Postal Service has a corporate license for F3 Fill software. This includes a right to copy and distribute to all USPS employees and contractors for USPS business purposes.

DMM CORRECTION

Nonmachinable Surcharge — Parcel Post

Effective August 28, 1997, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E620.2.5 is amended to clarify that a nonmachinable surcharge applies only to certain listed pieces of Parcel Post if pieces are mailed at the inter-BMC/ASF Parcel Post rates and no special handling fee is paid.

This notice corrects DMM 52 published July 1, 1997, which inadvertently dropped the word "no" before special handling in the introductory text.

This correction will be included in DMM Issue 53 (scheduled for release on January 1, 1998).

The nonmachinable surcharge applies only to the items listed in 2.5a through 2.5I if mailed at the inter-BMC/ASF Parcel Post rates and no special handling fee is paid. * * *

REMINDER

Proper Handling of Express Mail and Priority Mail Drop Shipments

Several companies have expressed concern regarding proper handling of Priority Mail Drop Shipment and Express Mail Drop Shipment when received at destination post offices.

Customers use the Priority Mail Drop Shipment and Express Mail Drop Shipment programs to speed delivery of pieces sent as First-Class Mail, Standard Mail, or Periodicals.

In a drop shipment, the mail is sent directly to a post office closer to the point of delivery, called the "destination post office." It bypasses handling in intermediate post offices. When the drop shipment is received at the destination post office, postal employees must immediately open the mail pouches or sacks and begin distribution of the mail to meet the service standards appropriate for the class of mail contained in the sack. Service standards for each mail class are contained in Publication 65, 1997 National Five-Digit ZIP Code and Post Office Directory.

Origin Office Instructions

Origin postal facilities must verify the contents of each drop shipment. The enclosed mail must meet the eligibility and preparation standards for the class and rate claimed (and any special services used), except that sacking and traying is not required if all packages are destined for the same five-digit ZIP Code as indicated on Tag 157, Express Mail Drop Shipment, or Tag 159, Priority Mail Drop Shipment, attached to the Express Mail or Priority Mail pouch or sack, as applicable.

Postal employees verifying the enclosed mail must ensure that each piece is endorsed to accurately reflect the class of mail claimed. See *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) M072, Express Mail and Priority Mail Drop Shipment, for more information.

The customer must pay postage costs for the class of mail inside the pouch in addition to the appropriate Express Mail and Priority Mail postage for the weight of the entire mailing (including the enclosed mail and any sacks or trays used in preparing the mail) from the origin post office to the destination post office. For zone-rated mail, mailers pay postage as if the enclosed mail had been entered at the post office where the drop shipment destinates.

For Express Mail

Each Express Mail Drop Shipment must be enclosed in the appropriate yellow and blue Express Mail pouch (sack). The proper Express Mail label or form must be placed in an EP-13 envelope and attached to each Express Mail pouch.

Each Express Mail Drop Shipment mail sack must have Tag 157, *Express Mail Drop Shipment*, attached. Each Tag 157 on each sack must be labeled:

"MANAGER, DISTRIBUTION AND OPERATIONS OPEN AND DISTRIBUTE"

The tag must be completed to show the class of mail for the contents enclosed and the name and address of the destination postal facility where the shipment destinates. An employee at the origin acceptance office where the contents of the pouch are verified must sign and postmark Tag 157 in the appropriate location.

For Priority Mail

Each Priority Mail Drop Shipment must be enclosed in white domestic or other approved sacks, properly labeled to the destination drop shipment facility, except that Priority Mail drop shipments of First-Class Mail must be presented in the appropriate orange Priority Mail nylon sacks.

Each Priority Mail Drop Shipment mail sack must have Tag 159, *Priority Mail Drop Shipment*, attached to identify it as Priority Mail. Tag 159 also provides a place to affix the appropriate amount of Priority Mail postage to cover the cost of the drop shipment. The tag must be completed to show the class of mail enclosed and the name and address of the destination facility. An employee at the origin acceptance office where the contents of the pouch are verified must sign and postmark Tag 159 in the appropriate location.

Each Tag 159 on each sack must be labeled: "MANAGER, DISTRIBUTION AND OPERATIONS OPEN AND DISTRIBUTE"

Destination Office Instructions

At the Express Mail and Priority Mail opening units of the addressed (destination) office, pouches and sacks are opened in accordance with local standard operating procedures. The enclosed mail is taken to the appropriate distribution processing operation and provided the service appropriate to the class of mail and rate paid for the enclosed contents.

For drop shipments addressed to a bulk mail center (BMC), the Express Mail and Priority Mail pouches and sacks are opened and processed in the BMC Opening Unit.

Customer Service

Express Mail and Priority Mail Drop Shipments allow a customer to use our premier expedited mail services to receive speedier service for pieces claimed at First-Class Mail, Periodicals, and Standard Mail rates. It also rushes bulk shipments to destination post offices. Postal employees processing drop shipments must ensure that pieces contained within drop shipment pouches are promptly processed upon receipt.

—Mail Preparation and Standards, Marketing Systems, 8-28-97

Proper Use of Tag 157, Express Mail Drop Shipment

Tag 157, Express Mail Drop Shipment, must be attached to each Express Mail Drop Shipment pouch of bulk and presort mail accepted in business mail entry units, detached mail units, or local offices. Tag 157, shown at right, confirms that the enclosed bulk or presort mailing was verified and postage was collected.

Customers use Express Mail Drop Shipment to expedite movement of other classes of mail from one USPS domestic facility to another. Customers sort the enclosed mail according to the applicable *Domestic Mail Manual* standards for the class of mail and place the mail into Express Mail pouches. Tags 157 are printed with the instructions "Open and Distribute At." The customer must address each Tag 157 to the Manager, Distribution Operations or Postmaster, as appropriate, with the facility address, city, state and ZIP Code, and affix the Tag 157 to each pouch.

After acceptance of the bulk mail, the acceptance personnel must indicate the class of mail enclosed and round-date and sign each Tag 157.

Tag 157 is not reusable and is discarded when the pouch is opened for distribution at the destination facility.

The table below outlines these conditions by APO/FPO ZIP Codes through the use of footnoted mailing restriction codes, which appear on the page following the table.

Acceptance clerks should use this table with the inte-

grated retail terminal (IRT) to determine whether an APO/FPO ZIP Code is active and which conditions of mailing apply. For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, refer to the local hardcopy EMMS directory.

The complete table appears in the last *Postal Bulletin* of each month.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured

state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

- B. Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more. **Exceptions**: Prepaid mail from contractors addressed to a military organizations for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use-Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or exemption endorsement. Known Mailers may use either Form 2976-A on each item or Form 2976 (or facsimile) with a mail manifest in conjunction with a packing list. Form 2976 must state "packing list enclosed." The packing list must include a description of the items, the dollar values of the items, and the complete address including the PSC box number and APO/FPO ZIP Code of the addressee, the date of mailing, the insurance registry number, if applicable, and the serial number of any item over \$25 in value and any electrical item over \$15 in value. The packing list should be enclosed in the parcel or attached to the outside of the parcel. The mail manifest which itemizes all parcels that a Known Mailer deposits will be given to Postal Official at Business Mail Acceptance Unit. Form 2976 may be used if the mailer does not wish to list the contents on the wrapper or in any case if the value exceeds \$400. Affix only the upper portion of the label on the package. A completed Form 2976-A (listing the contents and value in US dollars) must be enclosed in the package.
- **B1.** Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.
 - C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.
- **C1.** Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.
 - D. Coffee is prohibited.
- **E1.** Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.
- **E2.** Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.
- **E3.** Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.
- **F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C022.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.
- **F1.** Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.
- **F2.** Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

- G. Only First-Class letters, second- and third-class mail are authorized.
- H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.
 - H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{I}}.$ Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- **12.** This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.
- **K.** Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."
 - L. All official mail is prohibited.
 - M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.
 - N. Registered mail is prohibited.
- Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.
 - P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.
- **Q.** Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.
- **R.** All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.
- $\bf R1.$ Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.
- **T.** Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.
- U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."
- **U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 11 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.
 - $\textbf{U2.} \ \ \text{Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R}.$
- **U3.** Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.
- **W.** Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.
- X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.
- Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All second-class, third-class, and fourth-class mail (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.
 - Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).
- **Z1.** The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Finance

Accounting for Claim for Loss

Effective Postal Quarter I, September 13, 1997, the following change will be placed into effect regarding accounting for the claims for loss process.

At the present time all adjudicated claims for loss are recorded on the Statement of Account in AIC 633, Claim for Cash Loss. These amounts are currently reflected on the PSFR as a servicewide expense. Effective September 13, 1997, all amounts recorded in AIC 633 will be shown as an

increase to line 44 on the PSFR as an expense to the post-master's finance number.

Amounts recorded in AIC 180, Recovered Claim for Loss, will be reflected as a decrease to line 44 on the PSFR. These amounts will reduce the expense.

Accountbooks and Statement of Accounts for Fiscal Year 1998

The material distribution centers (MDCs) made an automatic distribution of accountbooks and statements of account (August 1996 edition dates) for postal fiscal year (PFY) 1998. These forms were distributed to the *district offices only* and should be distributed to the field no later than August 30, 1997. If an office does not receive its forms by this date, contact the servicing district accounting office, **not the MDCs.** Because of the omission of certain Account Identifier Codes (AICs) and the proper allocation of space for some entries, these forms are somewhat inconvenient to use; however, these forms are only temporary. They will be revised, reprinted, and redistributed in early FY98. A *Postal Bulletin* article will be issued announcing the effective dates of the revised forms and any necessary ordering procedures.

The following specific instructions **must be used** with the August 1996 editions. If your office frequently uses AICs that are not on the forms (including AICs 130, 096, 095, etc.) please write them in. AIC 158 must not be used until offices are advised to use it. Only one copy of PS Form 1551-G is contained in the accountbook package (the quantity will be increased in the next printing). Post offices that sell directly from the main stock may need to make additional copies of this form for use during the fiscal year. PS Form 1551-G is not available from the MDCs; instead, the form on page 39 of this *Postal Bulletin* must be reproduced locally as needed.

An accountbook consists of PS Form 1551 banded or shrinkwrapped as a set. Each CAG office that maintains the accountbook should have received one set. The statement of account PS Form 1555 is shrinkwrapped in sets of 16. All CAG A through G offices that prepare a statement of account for each accounting period should have received three sets to accommodate their reporting for the year. All CAG H through L offices that prepare a statement of account quarterly should have received one set.

If additional forms must be ordered after the automatic shipment, do not order more forms than needed. IMM REVISION

Suspension of International Money Order Service to Syria

Effective immediately, international money order service to Syria is suspended until further notice. Postal personnel must not sell international money orders for payment in Syria.

On page 57 is a revised chart of all countries that accept international postal money orders from the United States as of August 21, 1997. Post this chart to aid window clerks and postal customers. This chart replaces the chart published in *Postal Bulletin* 21952 (8-14-97).

- a. Term: July 18, 1997, through July 31, 1997.
- b. Type of Mail: Printed Matter: Every item must comply with the design and general preparation requirements provided by the U.S. Postal Service. All items contained in a single mailing must be of identical size and weight. Each piece will measure 275 mm by 215 mm and weigh 46 grams, +/-1 gram.
- c. Destination Country: Australia.
- d. Services Provided by the Postal Service: The Postal Service has agreed to: (1) furnish the mailer or mailer's mailing agent with the required international mail equipment; (2) provide the mailer or mailer's mailing agents consultation and training necessary to

comply with requirements for qualifying mail; (3) pick up and transport mail from the mailer's or mailing agent's facility to the International Service Center in Chicago, IL; (4) contract with air and surface carriers, as appropriate, for qualifying mail to be transported internationally for delivery by the destinating foreign postal administration.

- Minimum Volume Commitments: Minimum volume is 250,000 pieces.
- f. Worksharing: The mailer has agreed to prepare and tender a certain type of printed matter in accordance with the preparation requirements provided by the U.S. Postal Service.
- g. Rates: \$0.69 per piece.

- c. Destination Country: Brazil.
- d. Services Provided by the Postal Service: The Postal Service has agreed to: (1) furnish the mailer or mailer's mailing agent with the required international mail equipment; (2) provide the mailer or mailer's mailing agents consultation and training necessary to

comply with requirements for qualifying mail; (3) pick up and transport mail from the mailer's or mailing agent's facility to the International Service Center in Jamaica, NY; (4) contract with air and surface carriers, as appropriate, for qualifying mail to be transported internationally for delivery by the destinating foreign postal administration.

- e. Minimum Volume Commitments: No minimum. The mailer has agreed to use the Postal Service for all of its printed matter distributions to Brazil of a certain category while their agreement is in effect.
- f. Worksharing: The mailer has agreed to prepare and tender a certain type of printed matter in accordance with the preparation requirements provided by the U.S. Postal Service.
- g. Rates: \$0.24 per piece.

International Customized Mail

On July 28, 1997, the United States Postal Service (USPS) entered into an International Customized Mail service agreement with a qualifying mailer. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 294, the USPS hereby makes public the following information about that service agreement:

- **a. Term:** August 1, 1997, through August 1, 1998.
- b. Type of Mail

Printed Matter: Every item must comply with design requirements for international mail set forth in the IMM. Every item must comply with the preparation requirements for IPA as set forth in IMM 284 except as those requirements conflict with the applicable Specific Requirements set forth in the service agreement.

Letters: Every item must comply with the size limits for LC and AO mail set forth in IMM 223 and 243 for IPA. Each item must meet the letter-size mail criteria as defined in DMM C050.2.0, except the length may be no less than 5 1/2 inches long. The piece weight over the term of the agreement must be no less than 0.3 ounces and no greater than 11 ounces for a certain type of printed matter.

Flats: Every item must comply with the size limits for LC and AO mail set forth in IMM 243 for IPA. Each item must meet the flat-size mail criteria as defined in DMM C050.3.0. The piece weight over the term of the agreement must be no less than 1.0 ounces and no greater than 2 pounds for a certain type of printed matter.

c. Destination Countries: Printed matter destined worldwide during the term of the service agreement.

- d. Services Provided by the U.S. Postal Service: The USPS has agreed to: (1) furnish the mailer or mailer's mailing agents with the required international mail equipment; (2) provide the mailer or mailer's mailing agents training necessary to comply with requirements for qualifying mail; (3) contract with air and surface carriers, as appropriate, for qualifying mail to be transported internationally for delivery by the destinating foreign postal administrations; (4) perform quarterly reviews of the mailer's mail density as specified in the service agreement; (5) involve the mailer in emerging barcode technology for international mail; and (6) monitor and maintain service as specified in the service agreement.
- e. Minimum Volume Commitments: 3 million pieces.
- f. Worksharing: The mailer has agreed to: (1) package mail in bundles that are securely tied or rubberbanded in both directions; (2) sort and sack mail for printed matter; (3) pay postage for qualifying mail in accordance with IMM 282.211 using a system approved by the appropriate Rates and Classification Service Center (RCSC); (4) provide a measurement system, acceptable to the appropriate RCSC, as specified in the service agreement; (5) maintain an established number of pieces per pound over the course of the service agreement, and (6) tender qualifying mail to the USPS at the designated USPS facility; (7) coordinate a schedule of mailings and provide notifications as specified in the service agreement.
- g. Rate: For IPA, \$5.45 per pound.



How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 30 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase the new stamps at their local post office, affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service returns the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by October 30, 1997.

The Philatelic Fulfillment Service Center also offers first day covers for new stamp issues and postal stationery items postmarked with the official first day of issue cancellation. Each item has an individual catalog number and is offered in the quarterly *USA Philatelic* catalog. Customers may request a free catalog by writing to:

First day covers remain on sale for at least 1 year after the stamps' issuance.

Distribution

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive half their standard distribution for a 20-stamps-per-pane issue, rounded to the nearest master carton size (50,000 stamps).

SDOs and SDNs will make subsequent automatic distributions to post offices for their standard distribution, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before September 24, 1997.

Philatelic Requirement

SDOs and SDNs with authorized philatelic centers will receive automatic distributions of this stamp in six positions for subsequent distributions to each center:

Additional Supply

Post offices requiring additional stamps must requisition them from their designated SDO or SDN, using a separate Form 17. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from their APD, using a separate Form 17.

The Washington, D.C., Memphis, Tennessee, and Denver, Colorado, accountable paper depositories (APDs) will receive 3,350,000 stamps for filling supplemental orders. The New York, New York, Chicago, Illinois, San Francisco, California, APDs and the Kansas City, Missouri, SDN will receive 3,400,000 stamps for filling supplemental orders.

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale, generally 1 year from the date of issue. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 97-18

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.



The C Fund is invested in the Barclays Equity Index Fund, which tracks the S&P 500 stock index. The F Fund is invested in the Barclays U.S. Debt Index Fund, which tracks the Lehman Brothers Aggregate Bond index. Because of expenses and changing balances in the C and F Funds, their returns vary from Barclays' returns. The G Fund is invested in special issues of U.S. Treasury securities.

Future performance of the three funds will vary and may differ significantly from the returns shown above. See the "Summary of the Thrift Savings Plan" for detailed information about the funds and their investment risks.

The monthly C, F, and G Fund returns represent net earnings after deduction of accrued administrative expenses. The C and F Fund returns also reflect the deduction of trading costs and accrued investment management fees.

The C, F, and G Fund monthly returns are dollar-weighted: they reflect net earnings on the changing balances invested during the month. The C, F, and G Fund returns for the last 12 months assume, except for the crediting of earnings, unchanging balances (time-weighting) from month to month and that earnings are compounded on a monthly basis.

To Employees of The U.S. Postal Service

The Fair Labor Standards Act as amended (the Federal Minimum Wage Law) requires:

An hourly minimum wage of at least: \$5.15 – Effective the first pay period beginning after September 1, 1997

And overtime pay at 1-1/2 times the employee's regular rate of pay after 40 hours work in a workweek.

Exemptions:

There are specific exemptions from the minimum wage and overtime pay requirements for individuals employed as bona fide executive, administrative or professional employees (who meet the requirements of Department of Labor Regulations defining these terms).

Child Labor:

16 years is the minimum age for most occupations. An 18-year minimum applies to hazardous occupations. Youths 14 and 15 years of age may work in various jobs outside school hours under specified conditions of work.

Equal Pay:

An employer may not discriminate on the basis of sex by paying employees of one sex at rates lower than those paid to employees of the opposite sex in the same establishment for doing equal work on jobs requiring substantially equal skill, effort, and responsibility which are performed under similar working conditions.

Age Discrimination:

Arbitrary age discrimination in employment is prohibited by the Age Discrimination in Employment Act. Generally individuals who are at least 40 years of age are protected from age discrimination in matters of hiring, discharge, compensation, or other terms, conditions or privileges of employment.


The Department of Labor may bring action against the Postal Service for law violations. Courts may order payment of back wages or fines.

The Act prohibits discharging, or discriminating against, an employee who has filed a complaint or participated in a proceeding under the Act.

The law requires employers to display this poster where employees can readily see it.
