RURAL CARRIER HANDBOOK REVISION

Handling of Delivery Confirmation Mail and Mobile Data Collection Device

Effective immediately, Handbook PO-603, *Rural Carriers Duties and Responsibilities*, is modified to incorporate basic procedures for handling delivery confirmation mail and use of the mobile data collection device (MDCD). Copies of the following revisions should be incorporated to carrier route books until superseded by a complete reissuance of Handbook PO-603.

132 Delivery and Collection

[Revise 132.5 to include delivery confirmation mail as follows:]

132.5 All Classes of Mail

Accept, collect, and deliver on the route all classes of mail, including registered, insured, certified, special delivery, COD, Express Mail, and delivery confirmation mail. When required and authorized, transport mail between post offices located on the official line of travel.

[Insert new subchapters 280 and 281:]

280 Delivery Confirmation Data Collection Procedures

281 No Signature Required

281.1 Preparation In Office

Obtain and prepare the mobile data collection device assigned to your route as established by office policy.

281.2 At the Delivery Point

281.21 Delivery Events

If the item is delivered, scan the mailpiece barcode and enter other appropriate information into the mobile data collection device. If the mobile data collection device is not available, does not scan, or does not accept keyed-in information at a delivery point for a mailpiece being delivered, record the delivery confirmation barcode number (this can also be done by peeling the barcode off the item), date, ZIP Code, and time delivered onto PS Form 3849.

281.22 Non-Delivery Events

If the item cannot be delivered for any reason, scan the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate information into the mobile data collection device. If the mobile data collection device is not available, does not scan, or does not accept keyed-in information at a delivery point for a non-deliverable mailpiece, write the reason for non-delivery on the mailpiece along with the date, time attempted, and carrier initials. Leave completed PS Form 3849 for customer notification.

281.3 Return to Office

Return the mobile data collection device assigned to your route as established by office policy. If data could not be entered at the delivery point, or there has been a malfunction of the mobile data collection device while on the route, follow established office procedures for ensuring data is entered into a working mobile data collection device. Present the malfunctioning device to the supervisor and describe activity involved when equipment malfunctioned. Return mobile data collection device to the appropriate cradle.

341 Special Service Mail

341.1 General

[Revise 341.11 as follows:]

341.11 Acceptance. Registered, COD, certified, numbered insured, return receipt for merchandise, special delivery, delivery confirmation, and Express Mail may be accepted for mailing provided the customer prepays the required postage and fees.

[Insert new 341.9 as follows:]

341.9 Delivery Confirmation

341.91 Acceptance

341.911 Customers may obtain delivery confirmation by paying the required postage and fees.

341.912 If a customer requests a postmarked receipt, deliver it on the next trip.

341.921 When delivery can be made, delivery confirmation items should be delivered in accordance with procedures outlined in sections 281.21 and 330.

341.922 When delivery cannot be made, complete and leave PS Form 3849 for customer notification. See sections 281.22 and 330.

342.22 Other Information

Enter on the label the exact time, date of delivery, and your signature. Utilizing the mobile data collection device, scan the Express Mail barcode as prescribed in section 281.

342.3 Incomplete Delivery

Complete and leave a Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, when delivery cannot be made. Utilizing

the mobile data collection device, follow procedures for non-deliverable pieces as prescribed in section 281.22. Endorse Label 11-B with the exact time, date of attempted delivery, and your signature in the *Attempted Delivery* block. Return the article to the post office.

Interest Rate on Contract Claims

The Postal Service periodically publishes in the *Postal Bulletin* the interest rate payable on a claim decided in a contractor's favor under the Contract Disputes Act of 1978. This rate also applies for late payments to contractors under the Prompt Payment Act, as amended.

The interest rate effective for the 6-month period beginning January 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 1999, is 5 percent.

DMM REVISION

Labeling List Changes

Effective January 28, 1999, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) L002, L005, and L801 are amended to reflect changes in mail processing operations. In addition to the distribution and labeling changes, the header information for L002 is revised to reflect the availability of destination rates for Standard Mail (B), and to remove an obsolete exception reference for mail destinating in ZIP Code areas 572 and 573.

Although mailers are encouraged to label according to these revised lists immediately, they must comply with these changes beginning April 11, 1999. These changes will be incorporated into the electronic DMM available via Postal Explorer (<http://pe.usps.gov>) on February 11, 1999, and will be printed in DMM Issue 55.

DMM REMINDER**Minimum Weight — Bound Printed Matter and Parcel Post**

The minimum weight for Bound Printed Matter and Parcel Post has always been 1 pound. When Single-Piece Standard Mail (A) was eliminated as part of the R97-1 Rate Case, so, too, was the exception that allowed pieces weighing less than 1 pound to be mailed at Parcel Post or Bound Printed Matter rates if those rates were less than Single-Piece Standard Mail (A) rates.

Prior to January 10, 1999, customers' mailing systems and postal IRTs computed postage allowing this exception to pay a lower Standard Mail (B) rate for pieces weighing less than 1 pound.

Effective January 10, 1999, except for Special Standard Mail and Library Mail, mailable matter weighing less than 1 pound may be mailed only at First-Class Mail (13 ounces or less), Priority Mail, or Express Mail rates. Special Standard Mail and Library Mail have no minimum weight requirement; therefore, matter eligible for these subclasses can be sent at Special Standard Mail and Library Mail rates regardless of weight.

IRTs are correctly programmed to compute this postage.

REMINDER TO DELIVERY EMPLOYEES

Standard Mail Rate Markings

Effective July 14, 1998, mailers have the option of using the marking "Presorted Standard" or "PRSRT STD" instead of "Bulk Rate" or "Blk. Rt." on all regular rate bulk Standard Mail (A) mailings. Mailers of bulk Bound Printed Matter and carrier route Bound Printed Matter rate mailings also have a similar option of using "Presorted" (or "PRSRT") or "Presorted Standard" (or "PRSRT STD") instead of "Bulk Rate" (or "Blk. Rt."). These revisions were published originally in a *Federal Register* final rule on July 14, 1998, and were announced in *Postal Bulletin* 21977 (7-30-98). The DMM rules were included in *Special Postal Bulletin* 21984A (11-12-98). They appear in *Domestic Mail Manual* Issue 54.

Regular rate Presorted (bulk) Standard Mail (A) mailers have until January 10, 2001, to comply with the requirement to use "Presorted Standard" on their mailpieces. Until then, mailers may continue to use "Bulk Rate." Mailers of Bound Printed Matter have until January 10, 2000, to comply.

This new marking does not change the handling or treatment of Standard Mail (A). Please remember that undeliverable unendorsed Standard Mail (A), whether it bears the "Presorted Standard" marking or the "Bulk Rate" marking, is disposed of at the delivery unit.

Postal employees must familiarize themselves with BOTH of the acceptable markings (and their abbreviations) during the grace period. Employees should recognize mail with the PRSRT STD marking as Standard Mail (A) and handle it accordingly.

Special posters showing all of the new rate markings were distributed in R97-1 Implementation Kits sent to postmasters and plants. These new rate markings are included in DMM Issue 54. For your convenience, DMM Exhibit P040.4.1b is included with this article (See page 8). Publication 95, *Quick Service Guides*, and Publication 49, *Preparing Standard Mail (A)*, also include these new rate markings.

PUBLICATION 49 UPDATE

New Edition of Publication 49, Preparing Standard Mail (A)

A new edition of Publication 49, *Preparing Standard Mail (A)*, has been printed. Publication 49 was revised and updated to include rate and classification changes from R97-1. It also includes new text and graphics that guide customers step-by-step through filling out a postage statement.

An automatic distribution of Publication 49 was made to area marketing managers, district marketing managers, RCSCs, and each post office. Customers may obtain free copies of Publication 49 from their postmaster or postal business center. Publication 49 also is included in Postal Explorer 7.0 and can be accessed through the Postal Explorer website at <http://pe.usps.gov>.

Publication 49 is one of the Postal Service's most popular ease-of-use tools for beginning mailers. Employees are encouraged to share it with customers.

Employees should note that the new edition of Publication 49 distributed automatically contains an incorrect phone number for the National Customer Support Center in Memphis. The first paragraph on page 80 should read: "For information on addressing software, contact the Memphis NCSC at 1-800-238-3150, your local computer software store, or your postal business center."

Please share this correction with customers. Publication 49 is not available from the material distribution centers at this time. As soon as the corrected Publication 49 is available, a future *Postal Bulletin* will be printed with ordering information.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more. **Exceptions:** Mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable international mail or military mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. Non-dutiable international and military mail that weighs 16 ounces or more requires customs documentation with the following exceptions:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, letter packages, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more unless required by the destination country. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies for a permit imprint to a mailpiece. International or military mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on international mail and mail addressed to an APO or FPO unless required by the destination country.
- Official Mail going to, between, and from APO or FPO addresses is exempt from providing customs documentation unless required by the destination country.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C022.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail (A) are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

42"	72" length and girth combined
over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth
Maximum length 48"	

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 11 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail (A), and Standard Mail (B) (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

REMINDER

International Reply Coupons

Statement of Account post offices must include all U.S.-issued refunded International Reply Coupons (IRCs) and exchanged foreign-issued IRCs dated January 1, 1993, through December 31, 1998, with their statement of account for accounting period 6, or Postal Quarter II, ending February 26, 1999.

Redemption rates are:

Exchanged foreign-issued

- a. 1-1-93 through 7-8-95: \$0.50
- b. 7-9-95 through 12-31-98: \$0.60

U.S.-issued refunded (purchase price less \$0.01)

- a. 1-1-93 through 7-8-95: \$0.94
- b. 7-9-95 through 12-31-98: \$1.04

Section 426.9 of Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, updated by *Postal Bulletin* 21984 (11-5-98), contains specific instructions for collection and proper documentation of exchanged foreign-issued and U.S.-issued refunded IRCs for post offices, stations, branches, stamp distribution offices, and stamp services centers.

When submitting IRCs with statement of account, package the exchanged foreign-issued and U.S.-issued refunded IRCs separately. Separate each package by denomination (i.e., exchanged foreign-issued \$0.50 from the \$0.60, and U.S.-issued refunded \$0.94 from \$1.04). The Minneapolis ASC will only accept properly processed IRCs.

The Minneapolis Accounting Service Center (ASC), has discontinued distribution of the Vendor/Statement of Account (SOA) Out of Balance report, which was previously issued to reconcile Account Identifier Code (AIC) 615 totals on the Statement of Account.

Each accounting period, post offices must continue to reconcile AIC 615 on the Statement of Account to the Accounts Placed with Dun & Bradstreet report sent out by Dun & Bradstreet.

POM REVISION

Domestic Indemnity Claims

Effective immediately, Postal Operations Manual (POM), Section 147, subsections 147.112 and 147.121; and Exhibit 147.12 (page 2) are being revised. A future issue of the POM will incorporate these updates.

The revisions to subsections 147.112 are to clarify the proper procedures in handling indemnity claims for complete loss of registered or numbered insured articles, respectively. These revisions are reflected in the associated flow chart, Exhibit 147.12 (p. 2), on page 22.

Forward the claim form with all supporting documentation, such as evidence of value (as defined in DMM S010), to the St. Louis ASC. Claim forms submitted with an APO/FPO mailing address must have the unit or ship designation included.

[Insert new 147.121b as follows:]

- b. (For Registered Insured articles) If the article was addressed for delivery at a post office other than the one where the claim is filed, and the addressee signed the Form 1000 indicating nonreceipt or provided a statement denying receipt, attach PS Form 3861-A, Loss Claim, to the top two copies of the claim form and send it to the post office of address for a search of delivery records. Include all supporting documentation, such as evidence of value (as defined in DMM S010). Claim forms forwarded to APOs/FPOs must include the unit or ship designation in the mailing address.

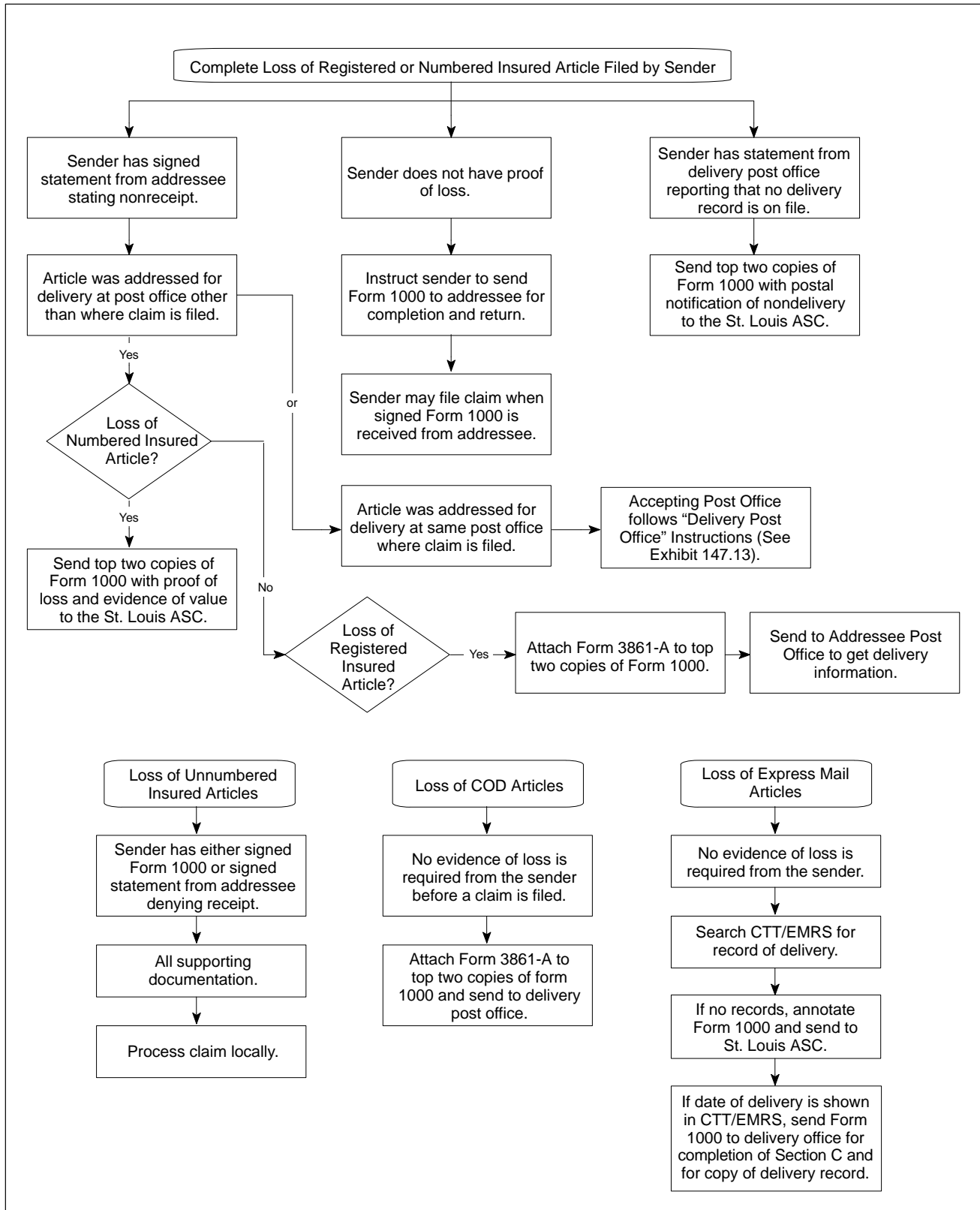

BIRD STAMP REMINDER

Migratory Bird Stamp Destruction

The following table is a reminder of the deadlines by which unsold migratory bird stamps should be returned for destruction. Additional information can be found in a previous change to Chapter 4 of Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, published in *Postal Bulletin* 21964 (1-29-98), which has been incorporated into the current online version of Handbook F-1.

Note: District customer service and sales offices must establish a destruction schedule to submit all unsold migratory bird stamps to the stamp destruction committee no later than AP 8.

The stamps go on sale nationwide the same day and will be sold only as a souvenir sheet. No individual stamps are available. **Sales of the souvenir stamp sheet must be recorded in AIC 085.**

Designed by Carl Herrman of Laguna Niguel, CA, and illustrated by Howard Koslow of Toms River, NJ, the souvenir sheet features 1940s subjects from the following categories: People and Events, Arts and Entertainment, Lifestyles, Sports, and Science and Technology. The 15 commemorative stamps in this sheet are titled: *World War II; Antibiotics Save Lives; Jackie Robinson; President Harry S. Distribution

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive approximately two-thirds of the standard automatic distribution of this souvenir sheet of 15 stamps. Distributions are rounded up to the nearest master carton size (750 individually packaged souvenir sheets = 11,250 stamps).

Initial Supply for Post Offices

SDOs and SDNs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to post offices for one-half of their standard automatic distribution quantities using PS Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, or PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before February 10, 1999.

Philatelic Requirement

SDOs and SDNs **will not** receive a separate quantity of this souvenir sheet for their authorized philatelic centers. The Philatelic Centers **must be supplied** their quantities from the initial standard automatic distribution made to the SDOs and SDNs.

Additional Supply

Post offices requiring additional souvenir sheets must requisition them from their designated SDO or SDN, using a PS Form 17. SDOs requiring additional souvenir sheets must order them from the appropriate accountable paper depositories (APD), using a PS Form 17. All APDs will receive

37,500 souvenir sheets for filling supplemental orders. The Dulles SDN will receive 198,000 additional souvenir sheets for filling supplemental orders. The Kansas City SDN will receive 4,020,750 additional souvenir sheets for filling supplemental orders from APDs.

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new *Celebrate The Century (CTC)* souvenir sheet. All *Celebrate The Century* souvenir sheet issues will remain on sale at post offices for the life of the *Celebrate The Century* program. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities using their normal ordering procedures. Other *Celebrate The Century* souvenir sheets now available for reorder include: *CTC (1900)*, Item 5537; *CTC (1910)*, Item 5538; *CTC (1920)*, Item 5541; and *CTC (1930)*, Item 5542. Sales for all *Celebrate The Century* souvenir sheets **must be recorded** in AIC 085.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 99-1

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

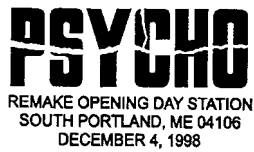
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items

submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self addressed envelope.

Y2K UPDATE

Forwarding of Year 2000 Inquiries

With less than 12 months before the end of 1999, we can expect a growing level of interest in the Postal Service's success in meeting the challenges of what is commonly called the "Year 2000 Problem." The problem results from computer programs that rely on 2-digit figures to reflect a calendar year. In some cases, the change from the year 1999, represented as "99," to the year 2000, represented as "00," can result in computational errors that would affect the ability of computer systems to operate properly.

The Postal Service's Year 2000 Initiative has created a clearinghouse to provide accurate and consistent information to inquiries on this subject. Management Instruction AS-840-98-3, *Effects of Turn of the Century on Postal Systems and Equipment*, requires that all Year 2000 correspondence be forwarded to the Clearinghouse for response.

With your cooperation, we can make sure our customers — large and small — receive prompt responses and current information addressing both their specific concerns and the issue of Postal Service readiness. ROTARY LOCK INVENTORY

Critical Shortage of Rotary Locks



Due to a critical shortage, all offices are directed to review their inventories of rotary locks. Offices may not maintain more than a 5-day supply of the locks as outlined in Handbook PO-502, *Container Methods*. Serviceable rotary locks greater than the 5-day demand should be sent to the registry

section of the servicing processing and distribution center. Centers with greater than a 20-day supply must return excess locks to the mail equipment shops, marked "Excess to needs."

Defective locks must be returned for repair to:

Rotary locks must be used to secure registered mail in transit, whether in pouches or CON-CON™ (the concentration and amassing at specific points, as well as the convoy transport of registered mail under controlled conditions containers). Rotary locks are a valuable asset to the Postal Service and must be kept in circulation for the fullest operational and financial benefits. Offices must obtain an adequate supply of locks from the servicing registry section or mail transport equipment center. Use of PSIN O817C seal, tin band, is only acceptable as an emergency substitution for the rotary lock. Tin band seals are 20 times costlier to the Postal Service than rotary locks.

POSTAL SERVICE AND GSA AGREEMENT

Delivery of GSA Mailable and Nonmailable Items

Under a joint agreement, the General Services Administration (GSA) will ship all mailable items ordered by postal installations via the Postal Service. The agreement also states that "freight shipments and nonmailable items will be sent by the most economical means that satisfies delivery requirements."

The agreement does not cover all current Federal Supply Schedules (FSSs), but will cover all new ones as they are promulgated. GSA is including a mandatory transportation clause in FSSs that specifically states "other commercial services shall not be used." Contractors will be required to ship mailable deliveries to the Postal Service by using their own vehicles or via the USPS.

GSA will attempt to separate mailable from nonmailable items in shipping orders, but may consider an entire order as nonmailable if one item in the order is nonmailable and can ship via a commercial carrier. Nonmailable items are those that are hazardous, oversize, overweight, or do not otherwise meet Postal Service packaging criteria.

Once an order is placed, do not refuse delivery. Contact your purchasing and materials service center or district material management specialist if you have any questions.

The C, F, and G Fund monthly returns are dollar-weighted; they reflect net earnings on the changing balances invested during the month. The C, F, and G Fund returns for the last 12 months assume, except for the crediting of earnings, unchanging balances (time-weighting) from month to month and that earnings are compounded on a monthly basis.

PS FORM 3849 UPDATE

Ordering Instructions for Revised PS Form 3849, Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt

This serves as an update to the article on page 74 in *Postal Bulletin* 21987 (12-17-98) on the design and ordering of the new barcoded PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, which will be used in support of the Postal Service's upcoming electronic signature capture program.

Each Area Purchasing Specialist will provide their district offices or field units with instructions on how to order their new barcoded PS Forms 3849. Some Area's vendors have not passed barcode quality tests and fulfillment has been delayed. We are expecting that all vendors will be ready to fulfill orders by mid-February.

When notified, postmasters and/or station managers can order new PS Forms 3849 overprinted with their post office name information. A maximum of five lines is allowed although four is preferred. It is recommended that offices include their correct physical address ZIP Code on the new overprinted PS Forms 3849. Use these examples as a guide:

Postmasters who do not order overprinted forms may obtain revised PS Forms 3849 from the materiel distribution centers (MDCs) starting January 29, 1999.

Your Area contract or MDCs are the only two sources for ordering the revised PS Forms 3849. Postmasters who previously ordered PS Forms 3849 through local vendors or other suppliers must discontinue this practice. This includes orders through the General Printing Office (GPO) and private companies.
