SUBJECT: New Retail Uniforms Debut September 1

Times change. Tastes change. And so do fashions.

The time for that change is September 1. That's when retail employees from Orono, Maine, to Oxnard, California; from Walla Walla, Washington, to Weekie Wachee, Florida — and all points in-between — turn in their old duds for new. (At least *some* of them. The next phase of the change will include slacks, skorts, skirts, and belts.) This is one of the very few times the Postal Service has implemented a change of this magnitude, one involving every office and every affected retail employee, at a single time.

Why the push? As we said, times change. And with the changing times come some significant changes for postal retail operations. The new uniforms join new job titles and new training to place our retail operation firmly in a new century.

Titles? New retail personnel will be called "Sales and Services Associates" or "Sales, Services, and Distribution Associates." The "associate" titles, which better describe the work our retail employees actually do, go into effect this year, although employees on the rolls prior to 2000 will still see their former titles on their official Form 50s.

Training? That's been modernized, too. The nature of retail work has changed considerably over time, so the job description and supporting training received a face-lift, as well. The goal is to provide more structured, on-the-job training where information is put in context with actual experience. It's not about associates being "order takers" anymore, it's about helping customers find solutions; matching their needs with the right product or service.

So, how do we signal these significant changes? Ultimately, the service we provide will tell the whole story. But our customers will also notice the changes in our appearance — our new uniforms as well as the design of our retail stores. All three will show that we're postal, proud, and professional. We've become a twenty-first century retail company, and we can compete with the best of them.

Publication 286, Postal Customer Council Program

Publication 286, *Postal Customer Council Program*, is now available from the material distribution centers (MDCs). There will not be an automatic distribution of this publication. Publication 286 is the "bible" of the Postal Customer Councils (PCCs). It contains all of the various rules, regulations, and guidance required to run a successful local PCC program. This revision is the first since May 1995. It was compiled by Strategic Marketing and the PCC Advisory Committee, with input from various PCCs and Postal Forum feedback sessions.

Domestic Mail

Move the Mail to Get Out the Vote

Since this is an election year, election officials throughout the country are constantly depositing absentee balloting materials in the mail to enable eligible voters (as described in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E080) to apply for registration to vote by absentee ballot in U.S. elections. Absentee balloting materials consist of postcard applications, ballots, voting instructions, and envelopes for domestic and international airmail use.

At all times it is essential that post office acceptance and delivery units provide election officials maximum cooperation and assistance to ensure that every absentee ballot is accepted, dispatched, and delivered as expeditiously as possible.

All absentee balloting materials can be mailed without prepayment of postage to any destination, domestic or foreign (see DMM E080). Some election officials have stocks of older materials with references to DMM 137.3. *These older absentee balloting materials are also acceptable without postage payment.* Absentee balloting materials must not be detained or treated as unpaid mail, even if they lack the notation that postage is not necessary.

In a few isolated incidents, absentee balloting materials have been erroneously returned to election officials for payment of postage. Postal managers at acceptance and delivery units must ensure that absentee balloting materials are not detained for any reason.

DMM REVISION

Identification Statement in Periodicals Publications

Effective September 7, 2000, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E211.10.5e is revised to make optional the publication of a subscription price in the identification statement of a Periodicals publication. Since publishers must disclose the subscription price to the Postal Service on the application for Periodicals authorization and by completing item 6 of PS Form 3526, *Statement of Ownership, Management, and Circulation*, which must be filed each year by October 1, it is unnecessary for publishers to include the same information in each issue of the publication. However, as a reminder, the publisher of each Periodicals publication authorized as a general or requester publication must publish a complete statement of ownership, containing all information (including the subscription price, if any) required on PS Form 3526, in an issue each year at a prescribed time based on the publication's frequency of issuance.

These changes will be included in the monthly update of the online DMM available via Postal Explorer (<http://pe.usps.gov>) and will appear in the printed version of DMM Issue 56.

determine whether an APO/FPO ZIP Code is active and which conditions of mailing apply.

For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, all acceptance clerks must refer to the local hardcopy EMMS directory.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on non-dutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C024.1.1C. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail (A) are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

Length	
42"	72" length and girth combined
over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth
Maximum length 48"	

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail (A), and Standard Mail (B) (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

HANDBOOK F-1 REVISION

Stamps-by-Mail Losses

Effective accounting period (AP) 1 fiscal year (FY) 2001, district accounting offices (DAOs) no longer have to file a claim for loss for stamps-by-mail losses of \$25 or less. Section 526.3 is added to Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, to explain the procedures involved. These losses may be written off to AIC 406, Tolerance Difference Short. Districts may use the \$25 or less tolerance amount for all standard field accounting procedure (SFAP) offices. Any stamps-by-mail losses of \$25 or less currently in suspense awaiting a claim for loss processing can be tolerated as described earlier. The office reporting the loss must prepare a PS Form 1510, *Mail Loss/Rifling Report*, for each loss and forward it to the DAO to support the AIC 406 entry on PS Form 1412, *Daily Financial Report*.

Example: Customer calls or writes or comes by the local post office indicating stamps-by-mail were not delivered as requested. Clerk fills the original order for the customer and completes a PS Form 1510 for the missing order. The amount as reported on PS Form 1510 is reported in AIC 761, Miscellaneous Suspense, with the form attached as support. The DAO withdraws the funds from suspense and offsets them directly to AIC 406.

The use of AIC 406 is restricted to the DAO and, therefore, statement of account offices must continue to use the claim-for-loss process. Also, any stamps-by-mail losses in excess of \$25 must continue to be processed through the claim for loss process. Any recovered stamps-by-mail previously written off through the tolerance process must be offset against the previous write-off. When stamps-by-mail previously tolerated are received by the stamps-by-mail clerk, the clerk should place the stamps' value in trust in AIC 057, Employee Overage. The stamps' value must then be withdrawn from trust and offset to AIC 306, Tolerance Difference Over, by the DAO.

[Add new 526.3 to read as follows:]

526.3 Stamps-by-Mail

District accounting offices (DAOs) may clear 1412 suspense items for stamps-by-mail losses of \$25 or less with an offset to AIC 406, Tolerance Difference Short. This suspense applies to stamps-by-mail losses as reported by retail units. These suspense item amounts must be supported by Form 1510, *Mail Loss/Rifling Report*. These items are written off directly to AIC 406 by the DAO.

526.31 Recovered Stamps-by-Mail Stock — Retail Unit

The stamps-by-mail clerk must record recovered stamps-by-mail stock into the inventory. The retail clerk records the amount into AIC 057, Employee Overage (offset with a minus to AIC 090). The unit's 1412 will reflect this adjustment.

526.32 Recovered Stamps-by-Mail Stock Value — District Accounting Office

The DAO reduces AIC 057 with AIC 457 for the amount of the recovered stamps-by-mail value and offsets the amount to AIC 306, Tolerance Difference Short. This action adjusts the account previously affected when the loss occurred.

The Postal Service will issue five 33-cent *Deep Sea Creatures* commemorative stamps (Item Number 440100) in Monterey, CA, on October 2, 2000. Ethel Kessler of Bethesda, MD, designed the stamps, based on photographs by Bruce H. Robison of Monterey, CA, and Laurence P. Madin of Falmouth, MA. These stamps go on sale nationwide October 3, 2000. This pane may be split and the stamps can be sold individually.

The five life-forms represented on these stamps — fanfin anglerfish, sea cucumber, fangtooth, amphipod, and medusa — provide a glimpse into a vast and alien world seen by few people. The strange appearance and adaptations of these creatures of the deep sea fascinate adults as well as children.

The deep sea is the most expansive animal habitat on Earth, and the dominant physical factors are darkness, cold, and high pressure. In response to these conditions, the creatures there possess significant modifications that differ greatly from creatures that inhabit more benign regions. These adaptations include bizarre body forms and unusual lifestyles.

Chautauqua Named Greatest American Post Office 2000

Passing the laurels on to the new winner isn't so bad when the winner happens to be on your own team. Take a bow, Chautauqua, New York. The National Postal Museum says you're the Greatest American Post Office for 2000. That's some accomplishment! After all, there are about 38,000 Post Offices out there. We know you'll be gracious receiving your laurels from Postal Service teammate and winner of last year's first annual Great American Post Office contest, Galena, Illinois.

For excellence in customer service, historical significance *and* fancy architectural design, Chautauqua takes the Grand Prize, a brass plaque. It's perfect for display in Chautauqua's lobby. It's also perfect for letting the rest of America know what Chautauqua residents, who nominated their post office for the award, already knew — their Post Office is the greatest. And now they have the paperwork to prove it!

"It was a very difficult decision for the judges," said Jim Bruns, director of the National Postal Museum, part of the Smithsonian Institution. He's a gracious kind of guy, too, and credits Post Offices and communities across the nation for their help in getting the judges over the hump. When all was said and done, it was the enormous outpouring of photos, newspaper clippings, letters, and just plain

over-the-top support that helped the judges make sound decisions about the winners.

The judges pored over 150 nominations, judging every one in three categories — service, historical significance, and architecture. First runner-up to Chautauqua for the Grand Prize was the Marshall, Michigan, Post Office. Go Marshall! Returning Damaged MTE Rolling Stock for Repair

All mail transport equipment (MTE) users are reminded to attach a completed PS Form 4707, *Out of Order* (tag), to each damaged rolling container returned to a mail transport equipment service center (MTESC) for repair. MTESC equipment inspectors look for the red tags as an indicator of equipment needing repair. Unless untagged containers are visibly damaged, it is possible for them to be returned to a customer without the necessary repairs being made.

Please help us maintain the safety and efficiency of MTE rolling stock by identifying any damage to equipment. Once identified with "Out of Order" tags, make sure that damaged equipment is removed from general use and promptly returned to your serving MTESC for repair.

Handbook EL-502, CSRS Retirement Guide

Effective immediately, the following changes have been made to Handbook EL-502, *CSRS Retirement Guide*:

1. **Exhibit 231.3, Present Value Factors Table** — An updated Present Value Factor Chart was put into effect on October 1, 1997.
2. **Section 231.43, Interest on Redeposits for Refunded Service** — This change accurately outlines interest factors for redeposits made to OPM.
3. **Section 254.1, Eligibility and Payment** — Second sentence is revised to give clarification.
4. **Section 26, Annuity Commencement Date** — Examples are added to give clarification.
5. **Section 414, Reduction in Optional Insurance Coverage After Retirement** — The policy on reducing Optional Life Insurance Coverage After Retirement has been revised per OPM.
6. **Exhibit 41, FEGLI Premiums and Reductions to Value Table** — Basic Life Insurance monthly deductions from annuity changed effective April 24, 1999. In addition Optional Insurance election options and monthly deductions from annuity also changed effective May 1, 2000. Table has been revised to reflect correct premiums.
7. **Exhibit 82, Minimum Retirement Age (MRA) Chart** — Exhibit 82 did not include MRA information for employees born in 1949 and indicated erroneous MRA determinations for all employees born 1950 or later. The chart has been changed to show correct information.
8. **Section 86, Cost-of-Living Adjustments Table** — Annual FERS COLA if CPI is above 3% was

misrepresented. Correct COLA would be CPI increase minus 1% as shown in the updated table.

Note: An Errata Sheet (Appendix) indicating these changes is also being sent via cc:Mail to Managers, Personnel Services. This Errata Sheet should be used as a supplement to the CSRS Retirement Guide and given to employees along with the Guide.

Example: Using Exhibit 231.3, it is established that for a retiree at age 60, with an unpaid redeposit of \$1,500, the actuarial factor to determine the reduction to the annuity would be 186.1. Therefore: $\$1,500 \div 186.1 = \8.06 reduction to annuity per month.

231.431 Rates for Redeposit Applications Received Before October 1, 1982

Interest on *redeposits* for refunds is calculated from the *date of receipt* of the funds to the date redeposit is completed.

For those *applications for refund* that were received by either the agency or OPM before October 1, 1982, interest will be compounded annually from the date that the refund was paid as follows:

4% per year through December 31, 1947.

3% per year after December 31, 1947.

231.432 Rates for Redeposit Applications Received on or After October 1, 1982

For those *applications for refund* that were received by either the agency or OPM on or after October 1, 1982, interest will be computed as follows:

3% per year through December 31, 1984.

For all funds received after December 31, 1984, a variable rate of interest will be computed using the following table.

254 Alternative Form of Annuity (AFA)

254.1 Eligibility and Payment

In place of the basic annuity calculated above, *certain* employees may elect an alternative form of annuity (AFA). In general, AFA is limited to employees with a *life threatening affliction* who separate under either a voluntary (optional) retirement or an involuntary discontinued service retirement. The AFA allows the retiree to receive a lump-sum payment equal to the total contributions made by the employee to the retirement plan, plus any interest accrued before 1957, and to receive a *reduced* monthly annuity. Individuals eligible for AFA are provided an estimated alternative annuity on their annuity estimate printout under *Lump Sum*.

26 Annuity Commencement Date

The following are examples for employees retiring with the last day in pay status (LDIPS) earlier than the effective date indicated on their SF 2801:

Example 1: Employee elects retirement effective February 1, 2000 (date on SF 2801). Employee in LWOP since November 10, 1999 (LDIPS = November 9, 1999). Employee met retirement criteria effective September 30, 1999 (55 years of age + 32 years of service).

Annuity will be effective December 1, 1999, not February 1, 2000. Employee was eligible September 30, 1999, LDIPS was November 9, 1999. Per current retirement law, as the LDIPS was not before the third of the month, annuity would begin with the first of the following month, December 1, 1999.

Example 2: Employee elects retirement effective February 1, 2000 (date on SF 2801). Employee in LWOP since November 2, 1999 (LDIPS = November 1, 1999). Employee met retirement criteria effective September 30, 1999 (55 years of age + 32 years of service).

Annuity will be effective November 2, 1999, not February 1, 2000. Employee was eligible September 30, 1999, LDIPS was November 1, 1999. Per current retirement law, as the LDIPS was before the third of the month, annuity would begin the day after LDIPS, or November 2, 1999.

4 Insurance and Other Benefits
* * * *

414 Reduction in Optional Insurance Coverage After Retirement

If you have been enrolled in any of the Optional insurance benefits as an employee for the 5 years immediately preceding retirement (or for all of your service during which it was available to you, if less than five years), you may elect to continue the coverage. You may choose the Option B and Option C multiples you wish to continue into retirement and whether to have those multiples reduce. **EXCEPTION:** If you have assigned your insurance, you may not reduce the number of multiples of Option B coverage.

If you elect No Reduction, your coverage will not reduce and premiums will be withheld from your annuity for the rest of your life, or until you cancel or reduce the insurance.

If you elect Full Reduction, the month after you reach age 65 your Optional insurance will begin reducing in value by 2 percent each month. Option A reduces to \$2,500. Options B and C reduce until the insurance value reaches zero, with no extension of coverage or right of conversion.

As an annuitant, if you previously elected No Reduction of your optional insurance, you may change to Full Reduction at any time. If you are over age 65, the amount of insurance in force will be computed as if you had elected Full Reduction originally. There will be no refund of premiums.

If you previously elected Full Reduction, you may change to No Reduction at any time up until the second month following your 65th birthday. Once you receive an annuity check that shows no premiums withheld for Full Reduction, you cannot change your election from Full Reduction to No Reduction.

Premiums for the optional insurance are age-based and, in the case of Options B and C insurance, depend upon the multiples of coverage elected (see Exhibit 41, Premiums and Reductions to Value).

USPS mail transport equipment service centers (MTESCs) are reporting that an increasing number of large canvas hampers (Item 1046) and utility carts (Item 1075) are being turned in for repair without the canvas liners attached to their frames. This practice should be stopped immediately.

Please help us maintain your MTE rolling stock in top operating condition. Damaged hampers and utility carts should be marked as unserviceable with an orange PS Form 4707, *Out of Order Tag*. Segregate defective equipment from those in serviceable condition before turning in the defective equipment to the MTE SC.

In the case of canvas hampers, the canvas liner provides significant protection to the wire frame of the hamper regardless of condition. Unauthorized removal of the liner exposes the metal frame to corrosion and bending, which increases the repair costs necessary to restore serviceability.

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Purchasing and Materials

National Copier Inventory Survey

For the first time, the Postal Service is undertaking a National Copier Inventory Survey. Because methods of procurement for copiers vary (purchase, lease, etc.) and involve both capital and expense funds, there is no comprehensive inventory that projects a complete picture of our copier fleet. In order to capture supply chain savings from the purchase of copiers, a national copier team has been formed to investigate, innovate, and capture savings in future purchases of copiers, maintenance, and related supplies.

The National Copier Inventory Survey can be found on the Greensboro purchasing and materials service center (PMSC) Web page, <http://blue.usps.gov/purchase/material/pmsc/greensboro>.

Through information provided in the surveys, the copier team will be able to leverage the Postal Service's total buying power to obtain the best prices and make recommendations for the efficient use of copier equipment. Team members in each area office and Headquarters will be responsible for ensuring that material accountability officers (MAOs) at every postal location complete the survey information on each copier at their location. The only exceptions are coin-operated copiers in Postal Service retail lobbies. A listing of the coordinators is shown below. Please contact the coordinator in your area if you have questions.
