DMM Correction: Click-N-Ship Insurance Indemnity Coverage Increase — Feasibility Test

On November 19, 2009, the article “DMM Revision: Click-N-Ship Insurance Indemnity Coverage Increase — Feasibility Test” in *Postal Bulletin* (PB 22272, pages 8–10) announced a new test program in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) section 709.4. The feasibility test period in the third paragraph gave an incorrect ending date. The paragraph is repeated below with the corrected date in bold.

The feasibility test program period runs for 6 months from November 14, 2009, through **May 14, 2010**. Mailing and claims data will be analyzed during the program period

to determine if this program should be a permanent offering, revised, or terminated. Additionally, the Postal Service may, at its option, withdraw the offering prior to the May 14, 2010, end date.

We will incorporate this revision into the next printed version of the DMM, and the revision was incorporated into the November 29, 2009, update of the online DMM, which is available via Postal Explorer® at <http://pe.usps.com>.

DMM Revision: Priority Mail Commercial Base and Commercial Plus Prices Expanded to Merchandise Return Service Priority Mail Items

Effective January 4, 2010, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 402.2.1, 423.1.2 and 423.1.3, 424.1.1, 425.2.2, and 507.11.1.5 to allow Priority Mail® commercial base and commercial plus prices for permit holders who use Priority Mail service for Merchandise Return Service (MRS) mailpieces.

For commercial base prices, permit holders must meet all current MRS requirements for Priority Mail as stated in DMM 507.11.

For commercial plus prices, Priority Mail account volumes must have exceeded 100,000 pieces in the previous calendar year or permit holders must have a customer commitment agreement with USPS®. Permit holders must meet all other MRS requirements for Priority Mail service.

DMM Revision: Expanded Option for Hardcopy and Electronic Return Receipt

Effective January 4, 2010, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 503.2.1 to allow a combined purchase of hardcopy and electronic return receipt service.

Current standards allow the purchase of either a hardcopy return receipt or an electronic return receipt, but not both. This revision permits a combined purchase that will accommodate customers who wish to purchase both.

DMM Revision: Permit Imprint Postage Payment Allowed for Express Mail Using the Electronic Verification System

Effective January 4, 2010, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®), 413 and 414 to clarify that Express Mail® commercial base and commercial plus prices are available to permit imprint customers using the Electronic Verification System (eVS®) program to document and pay postage.

On October 5, 2009, the Postal Service revised the DMM to allow Express Mail postage payment via permit imprint for mailers participating in the eVS program. See *Postal Bulletin* 22268 (9-24-09, page 12).

All Express Mail eVS mailings must be paid with a permit imprint and meet the standards in DMM 604.5.0 and 705.2.9.

DMM Revision: Stamped Mail Over 13 Ounces Must Be Presented at a Retail Service Counter

Effective January 4, 2010, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to require all mailpieces weighing more than 13 ounces bearing only postage stamps be presented to a Postal Service employee at a retail service counter in a Post Office™ facility.

These changes are consistent with the *Federal Register* final rule (74 FR 52147–52148) published October 9, 2009,

and ensure compliance with safety and security directives as required by the Postal Inspection Service.

ELM Revision: Reductions in Grade

The *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), Subchapter 420, Wage Administration Policy for Bargaining Unit Employees, is revised in 422.125, Reductions in Grade, to modify a policy change that became effective on June 10, 2006.

This policy change, effective immediately, applies to the step and next step date to be assigned to nonbargaining unit employees when they receive a reduction in grade to a bargaining unit position. The reductions in grade include voluntary changes to a lower level, management-initiated changes to a lower level, and demotions.

The policy that became effective on June 10, 2006, was intended to simplify the salary determination rules used to process bargaining unit voluntary reductions in grade by

“slotting” the existing salary to the new lower grade. However, for nonbargaining unit to bargaining unit downgrades, which are subject to the rules of the assigned bargaining unit, the policy change sometimes led to their being “slot- ted” to the top step of their new bargaining pay grade without regard to previous time served in the rate schedule or total years of service.

The revised policy set forth here will require determination of a hypothetical step for a nonbargaining unit employee downgraded to a bargaining unit position as if the employee had continued with uninterrupted service in the Rate Schedule Code (RSC) and level occupied on the effective date of his or her promotion to the nonbargaining unit position. This hypothetical step will be then be used to

determine the proper level and step for the newly assigned position using the appropriate reduction in grade, promotion, or reassignment policies in ELM 420.

422.125 Reductions in Grade

[Revise 422.125 as follows:]

The following provisions apply:

- a. *General.* Reductions in grade include voluntary changes to a lower level, management-initiated changes to a lower level, and demotions.
- b. *Step and Next Step Date Assignment for Bargaining Unit to Bargaining Unit Reductions in Grade.* Assignments are made as follows:
 - (1) *Step.* The employee's current salary is moved to the lower grade. If the current salary falls between two steps in the lower grade, the salary is set at the higher of the two steps. The salary may not be set below the minimum or above the maximum of the lower grade.
 - (2) *Next Step Date.* Creditable service in the former position is maintained toward the next step increase, with the following exceptions:
 - (a) If the employee's salary is increased by at least one most prevalent step in the former grade, a new step waiting period begins on the effective date of the reduction in grade (see 421.45c).
 - (b) If the conditions of 422.125b(2)(a) are not met, and if the waiting period time already served equals or exceeds that required to advance to the next step following the reduction in grade, the employee is advanced one additional step

and a new step waiting period begins on the effective date of the reduction in grade.

- c. *Step and Next Step Date Assignment for Nonbargaining Unit to Bargaining Unit Reductions in Grade.* For all nonbargaining reductions in grade to the Rural Carrier schedule, consult 422.423 and 422.424 to determine the proper step and next step date. For all other nonbargaining-to-bargaining reductions in grade, determine the employee's salary, step, and next step date as if the service had continued uninterrupted from the level/step in effect at the time of the nonbargaining promotion.

- (1) For reductions in grade to the same Rate Schedule occupied immediately prior to a promotion to a nonbargaining position, the following provisions apply:
 - (a) When an employee returns to the same level as that occupied immediately prior to the nonbargaining promotion, assign the salary, step, and next step date as if the service had continued uninterrupted from the level/step in effect at the time of the nonbargaining promotion.
 - (b) When an employee changes to a higher level than that occupied immediately prior to the nonbargaining promotion, apply the promotion rules for the appropriate salary schedule in 422 to determine the employee's new salary, step, and next step date.
 - (c) When an employee changes to a lower level than that occupied immediately prior to the nonbargaining promotion, apply the reduction in grade rules in 422.125b to determine the employee's new salary, step, and next step date.
- (2) For reductions in grade to a different Rate Schedule occupied immediately prior to a promotion to a nonbargaining position, use the Equivalent Grades chart (exhibit 418.1) and apply the appropriate rule as follows:
 - (a) When an employee changes to an equivalent level, apply the reassignment rules in 422.124c to determine the employee's new salary, step, and next step date.
 - (b) When an employee changes to a higher level, apply the promotion rules for the appropriate salary schedule in 422 to determine the employee's new salary, step, and next step date.
 - (c) When an employee changes to a lower level, follow the reduction in grade rules in 422.125b to determine the employee's new salary, step, and next step date.

- (3) For reductions in grade when there is no prior bargaining unit service, the employee is assigned to the step and next step date in the lower grade as if all career postal service had been in the lower grade.
- d. *Rate Retention*. Rate retention provisions do not apply to changes to a lower grade that are voluntary or disciplinary. However, they do apply in nondisciplinary management reductions, as follows (also see 421.511 and 421.512 for application):
- (1) *Protected Rate*. The employee continues to receive the wage he or she received in the higher grade for 2 calendar years (a) if the grade of the position is reduced due to a management action such as a change in job ranking criteria that affects the grade of only one position and (b) if the employee occupied the position at the higher grade for 2 consecutive years preceding the effective date of the reduction. (See also 421.51.)
- (2) *Saved Rate*. For saved rate:
- (a) An employee has a saved rate resulting in a red-circle amount if the grade of his or her position is reduced due to a management action such as a change in job ranking criteria that affects the grade of more than one position under the same job description.
- (b) If an employee who receives a red-circle amount is subsequently promoted and later returned to the former position through no fault of his or her own, the red-circle amount is restored. (See also 421.52.)
- (3) *Saved Grade*. A bargaining unit employee is entitled to saved grade if he or she is assigned to a lower grade position because of a management action that eliminates the position (e.g., job elimination due to technological and mechanization changes). (See also 421.53.)

Effective January 4, 2010, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) to reflect changes to prices and mailing standards for the international shipping services noted below.

Global Express Guaranteed Service

On average, Global Express Guaranteed® (GXG®) prices will increase 4.1 percent. We continue to offer 10-percent-lower-than-retail prices when customers prepare and pay for their shipments using commercial base pricing options. Global Express Guaranteed service is our premier expedited service through an alliance with FedEx Express to more than 190 countries. Prices start at \$33.95.

Express Mail International Service

On average, Express Mail International® prices will increase 2.9 percent. We continue to offer 8-percent-lower-than-retail prices when customers prepare and pay for their shipments using commercial base pricing options. Express Mail International service provides reliable, high-speed delivery service to more than 190 countries with a date-certain, money-back guarantee to select destinations. Prices start at \$26.95.

Priority Mail International Service

On average, Priority Mail International® prices will increase 3.0 percent. We continue to offer 5-percent-lower-than-retail prices when customers prepare and pay for their shipments using commercial base pricing options. Although the Postal Service announced distinct pricing for the domestic Priority Mail Flat Rate Envelope and the domestic Priority Mail Small Flat Rate Box, these flat-rate products, when used for international service, will still share the same price, based on destination country — \$11.45 for Canada and Mexico, and \$13.45 for all other countries.

Other Minor International Classification Changes

The following revisions to international shipping services are also effective January 4, 2010:

- The Postal Service adds an individual country listing for Kosovo to reflect its independence from the Republic of Serbia. All services currently available to Serbia will be available to Kosovo, with the exception of Express Mail International service and Priority Mail International insurance.

- To clarify terminology regarding parcels in the IMM, and to make the IMM language consistent with language currently used in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®), we are replacing the term “circular” (regarding parcels) to “nonrectangular.”

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPO/DPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

Exceptions: All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.1c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Handbook DM-109 Revision: Verification of Overnight Drop Time-Sensitive Periodicals

The Postal Service™ is revising Handbook DM-109, *Business Mail Acceptance*, section 5-8.4, to reflect a new acceptance policy for overnight drop time-sensitive periodicals.

5-8.4 Overnight Drop of Time-Sensitive Periodicals at Small Post Office Locations

[Revise 5-8.4 to read as follows (to include the current text under a new heading 5-8.4.1, and add new 5-8.4.2):]

5-8.4.1 General

The Postal Service allows an exception to timely entry requirements for time-sensitive Periodicals mailings deposited at origin post offices after business hours (late night or early morning), commonly referred to as overnight drops.

Publishers may make an overnight drop as long as the origin post office approves it and the publisher guarantees that sufficient funds are deposited in their advance deposit account to ensure that a negative balance does not exist. Publishers must understand that regardless of the date

entered in the “Date of Mailing” field on the postage statement, all classes of mail, including Periodicals, deposited after BME Critical Acceptance Time (CAT) shall receive the next day’s date recorded in the “Mailing Date” field in *Posta!One!*® The “next day” is defined as the first possible processing day after the mail is deposited.

In the scenarios below, the postage statement and marked copy of the publication (if applicable) must be provided no later than 11:00 A.M. on the following business day that the drop occurs — or no later than 11:00 A.M. on the next business day following a weekend or holiday period when acceptance personnel are not available. Saturdays and Holidays shall be included as a “business day” for sites open to the public on those days. The postage statement must be entered into *Posta!One!* immediately upon receipt to ensure that postage is properly collected and reported. In accordance with the procedures described in Handbook DM-109 5-8.4, postage statement entry must be governed according to the overnight drop mailing scenarios described below:

- **Overnight Drops occurring after close of business during the business week:** The postage statement and marked copy (if applicable) must be submitted no later than 11:00 A.M. the following business day, and the postage statement must be entered into *Posta!One!* immediately upon receipt to ensure that postage is properly collected and reported. Since the mailing was deposited after CAT the previous business day, the date entered in the “Date of Mailing” field on the postage statement and the date recorded

in the “Mailing Date” field in *PostalOne!* should be the same.

- **Overnight Drops occurring after close of business for a non-Holiday weekend:** The postage statement and marked copy (if applicable) must be submitted no later than 11:00 A.M. of the next business day following the weekend closing, and the postage statement must be entered into *PostalOne!* immediately upon receipt to ensure that postage is properly collected and reported. Since the mailing was deposited after CAT the previous business day, the date entered in the “Date of Mailing” field on the postage statement and the date recorded in the “Mailing Date” field in *PostalOne!* may vary by no more than the number of non-business days from the drop date to the next business day. **Example:** If the mailing is dropped after CAT Friday at 3:00 A.M. Saturday morning and released to Operations, the postage statement must be received and finalized in *PostalOne!* on Monday. The “Mailing Date” (the day the mail arrives for verification and acceptance) is Saturday, the “Certification Date” (the date *PostalOne!* shows the mail was finalized in the system) in *PostalOne!* is Monday, and the date variance is three (3) days.
- **Overnight Drops occurring after close of business for a Holiday weekend:** The postage statement and marked copy (if applicable) must be submitted no later than 11:00 A.M. of the next business day following the Holiday, and the postage statement must be entered into *PostalOne!* immediately upon receipt to ensure that postage is properly collected and reported. Since the mailing was deposited after CAT the previous business day, the date entered in the “Date of Mailing” field on the postage statement and the date recorded in the “Mailing Date” field in *PostalOne!* may vary by no more than the number of non-business days from the drop date to the next business day. **Example:** If the mailing is dropped after CAT Friday at 3:00 A.M. Saturday morning and released to Operations, the Holiday is on Monday, and the postage statement must be received and finalized in *PostalOne!* on Monday. The “Mailing Date” is Saturday, the “Certification Date” in *PostalOne!* is Tuesday, and the date variance is four (4) days.
- **Overnight Drops occurring after close of business for a mid-week Holiday:** This scenario is governed by the same procedures detailed above in Overnight Drops occurring after close of business for a non-Holiday weekend.

5-8.4.2 Verification

Acceptance employees are required to adhere to the following mail acceptance policy for low circulation and mail

volume Periodicals that meet the criteria outlined below. Periodicals affected by this policy are commonly referred to as newspapers and are produced to provide predominately local time-sensitive information, news, and events to a subscription or requester base of recipients. These Periodicals are mailed at frequencies weekly or more often. Due to the challenges regarding publication of these time-sensitive publications and the limitations on business mail acceptance capabilities where the publication’s accounts are held, local origin acceptance offices have allowed these types of Periodicals to be dropped at local office or local delivery offices after normal business mail acceptance hours so they can be processed for timely delivery. This policy supersedes all current HQ, Area, and District acceptance and verification procedures for these newspaper Periodicals that have been authorized to enter the mailing at Post Offices or local postal delivery facilities so that they can be processed for timely delivery.

This policy regarding the application of non-standard verification processes only applies to publications currently authorized to mail under Periodicals privileges (Periodicals authorization approved or an application to mail at Pending Periodicals privileges has been filed and fees paid prior to November 16, 2009) and the publication was granted authorization to drop overnight by the Origin Entry acceptance office Postmaster prior to the effective date of this policy. This policy is *effective November 16, 2009*.

All requests for authorizations for Overnight Drop for Time-Sensitive Periodicals after November 16, 2009, must be approved by the District Manager Business Mail Entry who, in addition to notifying the requesting publisher, must also forward notice of publisher approval to his/her respective Area Customer Service Programs Analyst and Business Mail Acceptance HQ. All future authorizations to mail as Overnight Drop for Time-Sensitive Periodicals will require the publications to use the electronic features offered in the *PostalOne!* system. Publishers will be required to submit all postage statements and supporting documentation electronically to the *PostalOne!* system. Exceptions to this requirement can only be approved by the Manager, Business Mail Acceptance, HQ, USPS.

Publications authorized for acceptance under this procedure must meet all of the following criteria:

- Mail less than 300,000 copies annually.
- Mail less than 5,000 copies per postage statement.
- Mail at a frequency of weekly or more often.
- Are authorized to deposit mailings after mail acceptance hours or in time to meet scheduled transportation.
- Are deposited at the office where the publication account is maintained or at a designated local delivery facility as identified by the Postmaster of the origin entry office.

- Are primarily (50% or more of the mailed distribution) for In-County distribution within the local area of the Known Office of Publication (KOP).
- Funding for mailings must always be on account prior to deposit of the mailing.
- Can be used with or may be more effectively accepted under an Exceptional Dispatch procedure.
- Would not be more effectively accepted using a drop shipment procedure.

In some cases a Publication can meet all of the criteria identified above except for the total pieces in the mailing may exceed 5,000 copies. Publishers may request an exception to the mailing volume criteria in writing to the District Manager Business Mail Entry. These requests will be handled and approved on a case by case basis. There will not be any exceptions for mailings that exceed 10,000 copies per mailing.

Publications authorized as “overnight drop for time-sensitive periodicals” will not be subjected to all required acceptance processes as other mailings as defined in the DM 109. Since these Periodicals publications will often have been processed for delivery or may have to immediately be loaded onto USPS transportation for critical dispatch, they may not always be subjected to cursory or in-depth verification procedures. Though these required verification procedures may be waived in the interest of timely dispatch or delivery, acceptance offices should always attempt to perform (at least cursory level) as much verification as possible (couple of sacks/bundles) without disrupting the established service expectation of the publisher.

This policy does not provide any exceptions for the annual verifications required for all Periodicals publications. Annual verifications must be performed as required by the DM 109. The annual reviews require verification of the information reported by the publisher on the Statement of Ownership, Management, and Circulation (PS Form 3526), eligibility, advertising, frequency, and postage statement accuracy.

The origin acceptance office must ensure that it follows policy established in Management Instruction DM-707-2009-2 on acceptance procedures for marked copies and postage statement process for Overnight Drop for Time-Sensitive Periodicals (pg.15). Whenever possible publishers of Periodicals granted this authorization should be encouraged to transition to using the electronic documentation features available through the *PostalOne!* system.

The origin acceptance office must notify all processing/delivery facilities of any Periodicals publications they have authorized for Overnight Drop for Time-Sensitive Periodicals and provide them with the publication title, the frequency and the planned drop day/time, and approximate volume. This notification will not be required for mail being dispatched to meet critical dispatch times. The origin acceptance office must ensure that there are adequate notification processes in place for the facilities where the

mail is being dropped at or dispatched to for reporting problems associated to the publication (e.g., missing frequency of drops, preparation or sort problems, dropping mail other than that specifically authorized or volumes in excess of 5000 copies). When problems are reported the origin acceptance office must take immediate action and contact the publisher to remedy them. Failure on the publisher's part to adhere to the conditions of the authorization or meet mailing requirements may result in an immediate suspension of this privilege requiring the publisher to submit their mailings during scheduled hours of operation for acceptance.

Modifications to the *PostalOne!* system and the Performance Based Verification model strengthen verification procedures for the annual verifications required on mailings authorized to mail at Periodicals prices.

Modifications to the *PostalOne!* system also provide a checkbox on the Account Management Edit Permit/Periodical page to designate the publication “Overnight Periodicals”. When this box is checked, no verification will be requested by the system and the statements for those publications will be excluded from the verification performance reports.

Postmasters, district managers, vice presidents, and other records custodians (see Handbook AS-353, *Guide to Privacy, the Freedom of Information Act, and Records Management*, 4-8) must complete PS Form 8170, *Freedom of Information Act Request Report*, for each request processed under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). The collection and reporting of this information are required by the FOIA statute.

When Must Forms Be Submitted?

Any outstanding reports for requests processed during fiscal year 2009 should be completed and submitted by December 24, 2009.

What Are the Exceptions?

Do not complete PS Form 8170 for any of the following:

- Requests for individual change-of-address information under Handbook AS-353 5-2d.
- Requests from federal, state, or local government agencies for any type of information.
- Requests from a union, unless the request cites the FOIA.

Where Do I Send Reports?

- Field offices submit reports to the area Consumer Service Program Analyst (CSPA) or district Consumer

Affairs Manager (CAM), who serve as FOIA coordinators.

- Custodians located at Headquarters and Headquarters field units and FOIA coordinators submit reports to the manager, Records Office, at Headquarters (reports may be sent via facsimile to 202-268-5353 or via e-mail to FOIA-PA@usps.gov). Custodians and FOIA coordinators are responsible for verifying the forms for accuracy of completion before submitting them to the Records Office.

The international reply coupon (IRC) item 330700 (pictured below) expires on December 31, 2009. IRCs that bear the December 31, 2009, expiration date may be redeemed or exchanged as follows:

- *Foreign-origin IRCs* with the expiration date December 31, 2009, may be redeemed thru December 31, 2009. **Do not** redeem after December 31, 2009.
- *U.S.-origin IRCs* with the expiration date December 31, 2009, are exchangeable under current *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual, policies through December 31, 2009 (purchase price less 1 cent). **Do not** exchange after December 31, 2009.

Images of the front and back of the expiring IRC are shown below.

Note: IRCs (foreign- or U.S.-issued) with an expiration date prior to December 31, 2009, have no value and must not be redeemed or exchanged.

After December 31, 2009, retail associates (RAs) must return all IRCs (foreign- and U.S.-issued) with the December 31, 2009, expiration date from retail stamp credits and segments to the unit reserve. Additionally, after December 31, 2009, ensure all RAs are instructed to redeem/exchange only IRC, item 330800 (shown on page [49](#)) with the expiration date of December 31, 2013.

Postal Bulletin 22275 (12-31-09) will provide instructions and dates for returning redeemed/exchanged IRCs to Stamp Distribution Offices (SDOs) or Stamp Services Centers (SSCs).

The version of the IRC currently being offered for sale by the Postal Service™ and foreign postal administrations is pictured on page [49](#). This version of the IRC does not expire until December 31, 2013, and can be redeemed or exchanged pursuant to instructions and procedures in Handbook F-101, *Field Accounting Procedures*. Postal retail units may request this item from their servicing SDO or SSC and are reminded to order stamps and stamped paper to meet customer demand and not to exceed stamp stock limits.

2010 Social Security and Medicare Tax Withholding Limits

For 2010, the maximum limit on earnings for withholding of Social Security (old age, disability, and survivors insurance) is \$106,800.00. This is unchanged from last year. The Social Security tax rate remains at 6.2 percent, resulting in a maximum Social Security tax of \$6,621.60.

There is still no limit on the amount of earnings subject to Medicare (hospital insurance). The Medicare tax rate applies to all taxable wages, and remains at 1.45 percent. The FICA tax rate, which is the combined Social Security rate of 6.2 percent and the Medicare rate of 1.45 percent, remains at 7.65 percent for 2010.

Express Mail Refund Eligibility Adjustment for December 22–25, 2009

From December 22 through December 25, Postal Service™ customers choosing Express Mail® Next Day service will be provided with adjusted refund eligibility information. Express Mail items accepted on these days will be eligible for a postage refund only in instances where delivery or attempted delivery is not made within 2 delivery days after the mailing date.

Providing accurate communications to the thousands of customers arriving at Post Offices™ during the holiday week is critical. Retail associates will follow a special Express Mail Acceptance SOP, which includes marking the original section of the label with the word “Holiday.”

During the week of Christmas, unexpected heavy volumes and unpredictable weather issues occasionally result in challenges to the ability to transport all Express Mail items for timely overnight delivery. The refund adjustment continues to provide customers with a money-back guarantee, while modifying expectations in the event overnight service in any particular area of the country becomes unachievable.

Service commitments and performance measurements will not change. Delivery employees will continue to deliver Express Mail items the day they arrive at delivery units, regardless of the markings on the label.

Stamp Announcement 10-01: Celebrating Lunar New Year: Year of the Tiger

On January 14, 2010, in Los Angeles, California, at the El Pueblo Historical Monument, the Postal Service™ will issue a 44-cent, *Celebrating Lunar New Year: Year of the Tiger* commemorative stamp in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) souvenir sheet of 12 stamps (Item 574300). Designed by Ethel Kessler of Bethesda, Maryland, the stamp goes on sale nationwide January 14, 2010. **The \$5.28 *Celebrating Lunar New Year: Year of the Tiger* souvenir sheet may not be split, and the stamps may not be sold individually.**

The U.S. Postal Service® introduced its *Celebrating Lunar New Year* series in 2008. This is the third stamp in that series, which will continue through 2019 with stamps for the Year of the Rabbit, Dragon, Snake, Horse, Ram, Monkey, Rooster, Dog, and Boar.

Art Director Ethel Kessler and artist Kam Mak, who grew up in New York City's Chinatown and now lives in Brooklyn, worked on the new series and decided to focus on some of the common ways the Lunar New Year Holiday is celebrated. To commemorate the Year of the Tiger, which begins February 14, 2010, they chose narcissus flowers, considered auspicious at any time of the year and, thus,

especially appropriate at this time of renewed hope for the future. The illustration was originally created using oil paints on a fiberboard panel. This updates products first described in the articles “Stamp Announcement 09-15: Koi” in *Postal Bulletin* 22254 (3-12-09, pages 39–40) and “Stamp Announcement 09-24, Seabiscuit Stamped Envelope”, and “Stamp Announcement 09-25, Forever Stamped Envelope” in *Postal Bulletin* 22256 (4-9-09, pages 29–35 and 36–42). All these new varieties of cards and envelopes will have their first day of issue, January 4, 2010, in Kansas City, Missouri.

The new varieties of these cards and envelopes differ from the previously announced cards and envelopes only by the addition of the Cradle to Cradle (C2C) logo on each card or envelope, indicating that USPS® stamped cards and stamped envelopes have been awarded Cradle to Cradle Silver-level Certification. This certification provides the Postal Service™ with a means to measure achievement in environmentally intelligent design while helping customers purchase and specify products that are pursuing a broader definition of quality. This further highlights how the Postal Service is instituting strategies for social and environmental responsibility.

Cradle to Cradle Certification is awarded to products that pursue an innovative vision of ecologically intelligent design that eliminates the concept of waste. These products have been certified by McDonough Braungart Design Chemistry (MBDC) for human and environmental health for their material content, recyclability, and manufacturing characteristics. As a result, the Postal Service not only exceeds governmental standards from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, but it is the only mailing and shipping company to earn such certification for a wide range of its materials, helping it remain a global leader in environmental initiatives.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in *italics* under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

Stop Sending Copies of PS Form 8176, Premium Forwarding Service Application, to Headquarters

Offices are no longer required to send a copy of PS Form 8176, *Premium Forwarding Service® (PFS®) Application*, to Headquarters. This requirement ended in 2007 when the application was revised and page 4 (HQ copy) was removed. In 2005, the PFS program office at Headquarters (HQ) required a copy of page 4 when PFS was an experiment. However, the experiment ended in 2007 when PFS became an official product offering. Offices that still send copies to HQ are wasting workhours and money—especially some offices that send it by Express Mail®, Registered Mail®, and Priority Mail® service.
