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652.3 Appeal of Letters of Warning in Lieu of Time-off Suspensions and/or Time-off Suspensions for Office of Inspector General Employees

[Revise 652.3 as follows:]

The employee may appeal the letter of decision in writing within 15 calendar days of receipt. If the employee is assigned to Headquarters or a Headquarters field unit or is in the Inspection Service, or if an area vice president is the deciding official in an action taken, the request is directed to the vice president of Labor Relations at the address shown in the letter of decision. If the employee is assigned to the Office of Inspector General, the request is to be directed to the Inspector General, or designee, at the address shown in the letter of decision. If the employee is assigned to a field installation, the request is directed to the area Human Resources manager at the address shown in the letter of decision. The review of the appeal is based solely on the record, and there is no opportunity for the employee or his or her representative to meet with the reviewing official. The reviewing official issues a written decision, and there is no further right of administrative appeal.

[Revise 652.44 as follows:]

The employee or representative may request a review of the Step B decision. The request of an employee adminis-

tratively responsible to the area vice president is directed to the area Human Resources manager. The request of a Headquarters, Headquarters field unit, or Inspection Service employee is sent to the vice president of Labor Relations, or designee, with a copy to the Step B official, who forwards the file to the reviewing official. If the employee is assigned to the Office of Inspector General, the request for review is to be directed to the Inspector General or designee. The request is in writing and gives specific reasons why the employee believes the Step B decision should be reviewed. The request is made within 15 calendar days from receipt of the Step B decision. The reviewing official replies in writing and states the disposition of the employee's request. This reply is final.

664 Bribery, Undue Influence, or Coercion

[Revise 664 as follows:]

An employee must report immediately to the Office of Inspector General:

- a. Any instance in which a person either within or outside the Postal Service uses or attempts to use bribery, undue influence, or coercion to induce or attempt to induce the employee to act or neglect to act in regard to official responsibilities.
- b. Any information that causes the employee to believe that there has been a violation of a federal criminal statute or any law or regulation directly or indirectly related to the responsibility of the Postal Service.

IMM Revision: Singapore Sets New Maximum Insurance Coverage Limit for Priority Mail International Parcels

- Offices will receive *Mover's Guide* copies in one or two shipments. The first shipments arrived in mid-December. The second shipments will arrive 4 to 6 weeks later. Shipments will be sent in quantities of 25, 100, and 300.
- Your facility may receive *Mover's Guide* copies addressed to other offices. Please check the labels and forward the guides as necessary. Remember to scan delivery confirmations affixed to each box.

Behind the Counter Program

- All Post Offices are now participating in the Behind the Counter program. To be in compliance with this program, you must continue to keep *Mover's Guide* copies behind the counter so that they are inaccessible to customers without the help of a retail associate.

New Bank for Payroll Checks

For the past 7 years, the Postal Service™ has used two banks, Citi and U.S. Bank, for the clearing of payroll checks issued to those employees not receiving their pay via direct deposit. A Finance team recently conducted and completed a competitive process to select a vendor for our payroll check clearing, and the winning bank was J.P. Morgan. Beginning with the pay date of February 5, 2010, all payroll checks will clear through J.P. Morgan.

For those employees who receive a paper check, the only difference in salary payment is that the checks will be drawn on J.P. Morgan bank rather than Citi or U.S. Bank.

2009 Tax Information: Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement

Current Mailing Address

To facilitate processing of 2009 tax information and to ensure correct and timely receipt of a 2009 Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement, all employees must have a current mailing address on file.

If you need to change your current mailing address, you have a number of options. In order of preference:

Address Change Information for Current Employees

3. All postal employees can change their mailing and residential addresses using the personnel computer kiosks located in large processing and distribution centers and Post Offices™. A tab titled **Present Job Info/Change of Address** appears on the main kiosk webpage.
4. For employees with PC access, use the Blue Page to change your address:

- Select **Log On** from the upper left of the Blue Page.
- Log on with your **ACE ID** and Password.
- Ensure the welcome screen has your name on it (upper left corner).
- Select the tab labeled **My Life**. Under this tab, on the right side of the page is the heading **My Profile**, where you will find two links titled **Address/Phone** and **Emergency Contact**. Select **Address/Phone**.
- Select the **Mailing Address** type from the drop-down and click the **Change** button.
- Make the desired changes and click **Save**.

Note: Employee Self-Service is no longer an option to change employee's address.

General W-2 Information

If an employee has earnings for more than one state or locality, a separate Form W-2 will be issued for each. The 2009 Form W-2 has been modified from the 2008 version to more closely follow the standard Internal Revenue Service (IRS) format.

General Questions

Imputed Income Life Insurance

The Imputed Income Life Insurance amount shown in Box 12 and a letter code of "C" on the 2009 W-2 form is the net result of the IRS computation for taxable insurance benefits less the amount an employee pays for optional insurance in the calendar year.

The IRS requires the Postal Service to report as income the cost of Group Term Life Insurance in excess of \$50,000, which is paid by the employer. The formula is based on an employee's age, salary, and life insurance coverage.

Thrift Savings Plan (TSP)

The following facts will clarify some of the common tax questions regarding TSP:

- a. Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d (see Instructions for Box 12) may contain employee TSP contributions including TSP catchup.
- b. TSP contributions are reported in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d, with a code "D". Letter code "D" is explained in "Notice to Employee" on the reverse side of Form W-2.
- c. Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation", has been reduced by the amount of the employee's TSP contributions shown in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d.
- d. Box 16, "State wages, tips, etc.", has been reduced by the amount of employee TSP contributions and may be reported in in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d for all states except New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Puerto Rico.
- e. New York City, NY, Kansas City, MO, Detroit, MI, St. Louis, MO, and Madison County, KY, are the only localities that allow income deferral for TSP. Box 18, "Local wages, tips, etc.", will be reduced by the amount of employee TSP contributions only if New York City, NY, Kansas City, MO, Detroit, MI, St. Louis, MO, or Madison County, KY, is indicated in Box 20, "Locality name".

Employee Business Expense (EBE)

Equipment Maintenance Allowance (EMA), Carrier Drive-Out, Vehicle Hire, Supervisor Vehicle Usage, and Special Delivery are all considered employee expenses and may be reported in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d. A letter code of "L" will contain the non-taxable (not the total) EBE amount.

Flexible Spending Account (FSA)

The amount contributed to an employee's Flexible Spending Account for health care and the amount contributed to dependent care will be included in Box 10, "Dependent care benefits". Both have been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation".

Health Benefit Pre-Tax and Health Savings Accounts

The amount contributed for Health Benefit premiums are considered pre-tax unless the employee declined the pre-tax benefit. The Health Benefit pre-tax amount has been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation" and is reflected in the reconciliation formula. Health Savings Accounts may be reported in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d with a letter code of "W".

FEDVIP

The amount contributed for Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP) is considered pre-tax unless the employee declined the pre-tax amount, which has been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation" and is reflected in the reconciliation formula.

Commuter Program

The amount contributed for the Commuter Program is considered pre-tax for 2009 up to the IRS \$230 monthly limit for public transportation and/or the IRS \$230 monthly limit for parking and has been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation" and is reflected in the reconciliation formula. Any commuting expenses that are elected over the IRS limits will be considered post-tax.

State/Terr. Gross Wages

The amount in Box 16, "State wages, tips, etc.", will equal Box 1 with the following exceptions:

- Mississippi does not allow income deferral for pre-tax commuter program public transportation and parking.
- New Jersey and Puerto Rico do not allow income deferral. Therefore, the employee TSP, FSA, FEDVIP, Commuter Program pre-tax contributions, and HB pre-tax contributions are not deducted from their State Gross.
- Pennsylvania is the only state that does not require the Imputed Income Life Insurance to be added into the State Gross. Also, Pennsylvania does not allow income deferral for TSP, FSA Dependant Care, and Commuter Program pre-tax contributions.

Annuity Protection Program (APP)

Form W-2s are issued to former employees who receive payments from the Postal Service under the Annuity Protection Program. Any questions regarding these Form W-2s should be directed to:

Relocation Payments

Relocation wages are reported in Box 12 on Form W-2.

Relocation gross is reduced by the excludable reportable amount reported in Box 12a, 12b, 12c, or 12d before it is added to Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation".

Excludable reportable moving expenses reimbursements may be reported in Box 12a 12b, 12c, or 12d with a code "P" and reflected in the reconciliation formula.

Obtaining Duplicate Forms**PostalEASE**

Employees may use *PostalEASE* "W-2 Re-print" for information viewing and/or printing. You may request any of the prior 15 years including the current year to be reprinted on an official document and mailed.

The W-2 re-print process is performed weekly and will be available for use at the beginning of February 2010. During the months of March and April, the W-2 re-print process is scheduled to execute daily. During Pay Periods 01-03 (approximately mid-December through the end of January), the W-2 request for mailing process will not be available. However, viewing of current information is available online.

Notice to Employee

Refund. Even if you do not have to file a tax return, you should file to get a refund if box 2 shows federal income tax withheld, or if you can take the earned income credit.

Earned income credit (EIC). You must file a tax return if any amount is shown in box 9.

You may be able to take the EIC for 2008 if (a) you do not have a qualifying child and you earned less than \$12,880 (\$15,880 if married filing jointly), (b) you have one qualifying child and you earned less than \$3,995 (\$3,995 if married filing jointly), or (c) you have more than one qualifying child and you earned less than \$38,845 (\$41,845 if married filing jointly). You and any qualifying children must have valid social security numbers (SSNs). You cannot take the EIC if your investment income is more than \$2,950. Any EIC that is more than your tax liability is refunded to you, but only if you file a tax return. If you have at least one qualifying child, you may get as much as \$1,750 of the EIC in advance by completing Form W-5, Earned Income Credit Advance Payment Certificate, and giving it to your employer.

Clergy and religious workers. If you are not subject to social security and Medicare taxes, see Pub 517, Social Security and Other Information for Members of the Clergy and Religious Workers.

Corrections. If your name, SSN, or address is incorrect, correct Copies B, C, and 2 and ask your employer to correct your employment record. Be sure to ask the employer to file Form W-2c, Corrected Wage and Tax Statement, with the Social Security Administration (SSA) to correct any name, SSN, or money error reported to the SSA on Form W-2. If your name and SSN are correct but are not the same as shown on your social security card, you should ask for a new card at any SSA office or call 1-800-772-1213.

Credit for excess taxes. If you had more than one employer in 2008 and more than \$6,324.00 in social security and/or Tier I railroad retirement (RRTA) taxes were withheld, you may be able to claim a credit for the excess against your Federal income tax. If you had more than one railroad employer and more than \$2,960.10 in Tier II RRTA tax was withheld, you also may be able to claim a credit. See your Form 1040 or 1040A instructions and Pub 506, Tax Withholding and Estimated Tax.

Instructions for Employee

Box 1. Enter this amount on the wages line of your tax return.

Box 2. Enter this amount on the federal income tax withheld line of your tax return.

Box 8. This amount is not included in boxes 1, 3, 5, or 7. For information on how to report tips on your tax return, see your Form 1040 instructions.

Box 9. Enter this amount on the advanced earned income credit payments line of your 1040 or 1040A.

Box 10. This amount is the total dependent care benefits that your employer paid to you or incurred on your behalf (including amounts from a section 125 (cafeteria) plan). Any amount over \$5,000 is also included in box 1. You must complete Schedule 2 (Form 1040A) or Form 2441, Child and Dependent Care Expenses, to compute any taxable and nontaxable amounts.

Box 11. This amount is (a) reported in box 1 if it is a distribution made to you from a nonqualified deferred compensation or nongovernment section 457(b) plan or (b) included in box 3 and/or 5 if it is a prior year deferral under a nonqualified or section 457(b) plan that became taxable for social security and Medicare taxes this year because there is no longer substantial risk of forfeiture of your right to the deferred amount.

Box 12. The following list explains the codes shown in box 12. You may need this information to complete your tax return. Elective deferrals (codes D, E, F, and S) and designated Roth contributions (codes AA and BB) under all plans are generally limited a total of \$15,500 (\$10,500 if you only have SIMPLE plans; \$18,500 for section 403(b) plans if you qualify for the 15-year rule explained in Pub. 571).

Deferrals under code G are limited to \$15,500. Deferrals under code H are limited to \$7,000. However, if you were at least age 50 in 2008 your employer may have allowed an additional deferral of up to \$5,000 (\$2,500 for section 401(k)(11) and 408(p) SIMPLE plans). This additional deferral amount is not subject to the overall limit on elective deferrals. For code G, the limit on elective deferrals may be higher for the last three years before you reach retirement age. Contact your plan administrator for more information. Amounts in excess of the overall elective deferral limit must be included in income. See the "Wages, Salaries, Tips etc." line instructions for Form 1040.

Note: If a year follows code D, E, F, G, H, or S, you made a make-up pension contribution for a prior year(s) when you were in the military service. To figure whether you made excess deferrals, consider these amounts for the year shown, not the current year. If no year is shown, the contributions are for the current year.

A-Uncollected social security or RRTA tax on tips (include this tax on Form 1040. See "Total Tax" in the Form 1040 instructions.)

B-Uncollected Medicare tax on tips (include this tax on Form 1040. See "Total Tax" in the Form 1040 instructions.)

C-Taxable cost of group-term life insurance over \$50,000 (include in boxes 1, 3 (up to social security wage base), and 5)

D-Elective deferrals to a section 401(k) cash or deferred arrangement. Also includes deferrals under a SIMPLE retirement account that is part of a section 401(k) arrangement.

E-Elective deferrals under a section 402(b) salary reduction agreement.

F-Elective deferrals under a section 408(k)(6) salary reduction SEP.

G-Elective deferral and employer contributions (including nonelective deferrals) to a section 457(b) deferred compensation plan.

H-Elective deferrals to a section 501(c)(19)(D) tax-exempt organization plan (see "adjusted Gross Income" in the Form 1040 instructions for how to deduct).

J-Nontaxable sick pay (not included in boxes 1, 3, or 5).

K-20% Excise tax on excess golden parachute payments (see "Total Tax" in the Form 1040 instructions).

L-Substantiated employee business expense reimbursements (nontaxable).

M-Uncollected social security or RRTA tax cost of group-term life insurance over \$50,000 (former employees only) (see "Total Tax" in the Form 1040 instructions).

N-Uncollected Medicare tax on cost or group-term life insurance over \$50,000 (former employees only) (see "Total Tax" in the Form 1040 instructions).

P-Excludable moving expense reimbursements paid directly to employee (not included in boxes 1, 3, or 5).

Q-Nontaxable combat pay. See the instructions for Form 1040 of Form 1040A for details on reporting this amount.

R-Employer contributions to your Archer (MSA) (see Form 8853, Archer MSAs and Long-Term Care Insurance Contracts).

S-Employee salary reduction contributions under a section 408(p) SIMPLE (not included in box 1)

Hardcopy COAs — part of *The Mover’s Guide* — are only available behind the counter, where customers have to request them from a retail associate. Why the change? The Postal Service™ wants retail associates to encourage customers to use the Internet version instead for these reasons:

It’s Fast

Internet Change of Address (ICOA) is fast. On average, USPS processes 97 percent of all ICOA transactions into the change-of-address system within 2 days after they’re filed. In Fiscal Year 2009, customers entered their changes of address sooner using ICOA than they did using hardcopy forms — with 60 percent entered on or before the day the customer moved, compared to only 20 percent for hardcopy forms. The sooner USPS knows about the customer’s move, the sooner it can begin forwarding the customer’s mail.

It’s Accurate

ICOA also is a more accurate option. There’s no chance of error due to illegible handwriting. The higher degree of

accuracy means reduced undeliverable-as-addressed mail volume and lower cost.

It’s Secure

Equally important, ICOA is a more secure option. USPS requires online customers to use a personal credit card or debit card for identity verification.

It’s Green

And it’s green. ICOA eliminates the use of paper, thus preserving our natural resources.

It’s Economical

This year, the Postal Service expects the ICOA share of all COA orders to increase more than 25 percent, generating about \$2 million in incremental revenue.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.1c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

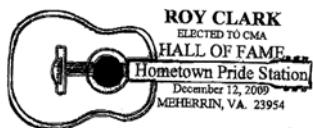
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

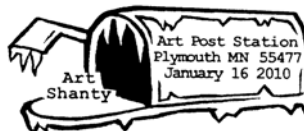

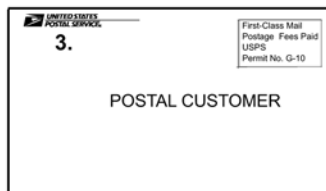
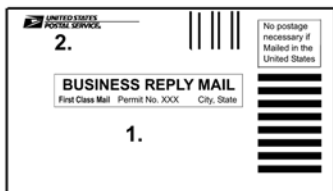

Establishment and Installation Heads: Statutory Requirement to Review and Post OSHA Form 300A Summary for Calendar Year 2009

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requires all Postal Service™ installation and establishment heads to prepare and post the OSHA Form 300A, *Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses*, summary for calendar year (CY) 2009. This requirement complies with 29 CFR 1904 and the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM) 821, Actions in the Event of Accident, Injury, or Illness.

From February 1 through April 30, 2010, post a completed and signed copy of the OSHA Form 300A for CY 2009 in a conspicuous place at every establishment where employees work or report to work. You must post an OSHA Form 300A even if you did not experience any OSHA injuries or illnesses in the calendar year.

Installation heads can get a blank copy of OSHA Form 300A at www.osha.gov/recordkeeping/RKforms.html. For assistance in completing this form, contact your servicing district safety office or see www.osha.gov/recordkeeping/index.html for detailed instructions.

Reviewing and Closing Out the OSHA Form 300 Log

OSHA Form 300A is a summary of data derived from the OSHA Form 300 Log. Before you complete and sign OSHA Form 300A, you must ensure that all entries on OSHA Form 300 Log are accurate and complete*. To verify the completeness and accuracy of OSHA Form 300 Log, you must do the following:

1. Make sure there are no entries in Columns A through F that have the word “other”. Entries must be more specific to be considered correct by OSHA.
2. Check column F carefully. To ensure accuracy, note the parts of the body affected (including which side of the body) and the object or substance that directly injured or made the person ill.

Example: Second-degree burns on right forearm from acetylene torch.

3. Check columns K and L carefully. If an injury is identified as “days away from work” on column K or “on-

the-job transfer or restriction” on column L, you must ensure that the number of days entered is current and accurate.

4. Check columns G through M(6), which correspond to entries in OSHA Form 300A. Make sure that these columns are added correctly on OSHA Form 300 Log and match the totals on OSHA Form 300A.
5. Fill out the form completely and correctly including the Completed By, Title, Phone, and Date boxes at the bottom left side. Also, use “N/A” on number 18, Employee Death, if applicable.

Note: Installations or establishments with 10 or fewer total employees at anytime during the calendar year are not required to maintain and update an OSHA Form 300 Log.

Accounting for Contractor Employees

OSHA-recordable injuries or illnesses sustained by contractor employees who are directly supervised by Postal Service personnel must be entered on OSHA Form 300 and included in the calculations on OSHA Form 300A. Contact your servicing safety office if you have questions or need guidance for including a contractor-supervised nonemployee to your OSHA Form 300 Log.

Retaining Forms

Make sure that an OSHA Form 301, *Injury and Illness Incident Report*, is on file for each entry on OSHA Form 300. Postal Service installations must retain OSHA Forms 300, 300A, and 301 for 5 calendar years. PS Form 1769, *U.S. Postal Service Accident Report*, often used in conjunction with the OSHA forms, also must be retained for 5 years.

Reviewing and Posting OSHA Form 300A

As an installation or establishment head, you are required to complete, review, sign, and post OSHA Form 300A. When you sign on the Company Executive line, you are certifying that you have verified that the entries on OSHA Form 300A — and its supporting documents — are true, accurate, and complete.

The following steps are required for completing and posting OSHA Form 300A:

OSHA's Form 300A (Rev. 01/2004)

All establishments covered by Part 1904 must complete this Summary page, even if no work-related injuries or illnesses occurred during the year. Remember to review the Log to verify that the entries are complete and accurate before completing this summary.
