Cover Story

Lean Green Teams Promote Resource Conservation and Save the Postal Service Money

“Rethink, reduce, renew” is more than just a slogan at the Postal Service™. It’s a way of working greener that has been embraced by employees, and it is producing impressive results.

The Postal Service has saved millions of dollars — \$5 million in 2010 alone — through its efforts to reduce energy and conserve resources. The Postal Service is recycling paper, plastic, cardboard, and metal at a rate that’s unprecedented in its history. Last year, the Postal Service recycled more than 222,000 tons of material, which generated \$13 million in revenue and saved an additional \$9.1 million in landfill fees.

Taking advantage of the high rebates for mixed paper and cardboard, Postal Service recycling in 2011 is on track to save dividends of more than \$20 million. The combined efforts of three districts — Suncoast, Houston, and Arizona — have generated just under \$1 million in revenue from the sale of recycled material in the first 4 months of fiscal year 2011. In some locations in Tennessee, Florida, and Alabama, employees are bringing in their recyclable material from home to add to the recycle stream, which is generating over 100 tons per month and over \$10,000 in revenue in the Suncoast alone.

Playing a crucial role in this trash-to-treasure success story are Lean Green Teams. More than 80 of these cross-functional teams are in place at postal facilities, working to promote low-cost and no-cost ways to save money and

reduce consumption. Actions could be as simple as making sure lights are turned off in empty rooms or adjusting building thermostats. The Postal Service plans to deploy Lean Green Teams nationwide by 2012.

“Postal employees understand the needs of both the environment and our organization and are stepping up to the challenge,” says Emil Dzuray, acting chief sustainability officer. “Working together, we’re building a conservation culture and reducing our carbon footprint.”

With the assistance of Lean Green Teams, the Postal Service is getting closer to achieving its 2015 sustainability goals of reducing facility energy use 30 percent, petroleum fuel use 20 percent, water use 10 percent, and waste sent to landfills 50 percent.

The Postal Service also plans to reduce spending on consumables 30 percent by 2020, and increase the amount of environmentally preferable products it buys by 50 percent by 2015.

DMM Revision: New Mailing Options for Flats and Irregular Parcels Bearing a Simplified Address

Effective June 6, 2011, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* 602.3.2.1 to extend the option to use a simplified address format to Periodicals flats and irregular parcels and Bound Printed Matter flats, intended for distribution to city delivery routes and to Post Office™ (PO) box sections in Post Office locations with city delivery service.

In the article “DMM Revision: Extension of the Simplified Address Format” in *Postal Bulletin 22300* (12-16-10, pages 46, 71–73), the Postal Service revised DMM 345.6.9.4, 445.7.6.4, and 602.3.2 to remove a restriction on the use of simplified addressing for saturation flat-size mailpieces and irregular parcels that are delivered by Postal Service city carriers or to PO boxholders at Post Office locations with city delivery service. These revisions were effective on January 2, 2011, but were limited only to mailers of Standard Mail® saturation (carrier route) flats and irregular parcels.

In response to inquiries from the mailing community, the Postal Service will now extend the simplified addressing option to mailers of Periodicals flats, irregular parcels, and Bound Printed Matter flats meeting saturation carrier route standards. Mailers are reminded that pieces bearing a simplified address for distribution to city delivery routes, or to PO boxholders at Post Office locations with city delivery service, must meet the applicable physical standards for flat-size pieces under DMM 301, or irregular parcels under DMM 401, in addition to all other eligibility criteria.

These new changes will be reflected in the June 2011 DMM, but mailers may begin preparing their mailings in accordance with these new standards immediately.

3.2 Simplified Address

3.2.1 Conditions for General Use

The following conditions must be met when using a simplified address on commercial mailpieces:

[Revise the introductory sentence of 3.2.1b as follows:]

- b. Standard Mail, Periodicals, and Bound Printed Matter flat-size mailpieces and Standard Mail and Periodicals irregular parcels for distribution to a city route and to Post Office boxes in offices with city carrier service may bear a simplified address, but only when complete distribution is made to each active residential delivery or each active delivery, under the following conditions:

IMM Revision: Mail Preparation to Canada for International Priority Airmail and International Surface Air Lift Mail Services

The article “IMM Revision: Mail Preparation to Canada for International Priority Airmail and International Surface Air Lift Mail Services” in *Postal Bulletin 22303* (1-27-11, pages 9–12) noted several revisions to *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, *International Mail Manual (IMM®)* section 292.47, as well as the addition of section 293.47. However, we are making the following revisions to the text published in that article:

- We are revising section 292.47 to add to item “a” an additional sentence to stipulate that the mailer must complete PS Tag 115, *International Priority Airmail*, write “Canada” on the reverse, and tape the tag to the tray sleeve for IPA mailings. This requirement was inadvertently left out of the standards published in the article in *Postal Bulletin 22303*.
- We are revising section 293.47 to reflect that a mailer preparing an International Surface Air Lift (ISAL) mailing to Canada may *not* prepare letter trays for letter-size pieces and flat trays for flat-size pieces. Instead, the mailer must prepare an ISAL mailing only in sacks, which are the only authorized container for all destination countries (including Canada). This standard is consistent with IMM 293.461, which stipulates that all types of mail, including letter-size bundles, flat-size bundles, and loose items, can be commingled in the same sack for ISAL mailing.

These revisions will be effective March 7, 2011.

- a. *Letter-Size and Flat-Size Mail.* Prepare letter-size items in letter trays, either 1-foot or 2-foot, depending on volume. Prepare flat-size items in flat trays. Face all letter-size items and flat-size items in the same direction. Ensure that all trays are full enough to keep the mail from mixing during transportation. Cover (i.e., “sleeve”) all letter-size and flat-size trays, and secure them with strapping. Do not prepare the content of trays in bundles. In addition, the mailer must complete PS Tag 115, *International Priority Airmail*, write “Canada” on the reverse, and tape the tag to the tray sleeve.

POM Revision: Carrier Release Program Changes

Effective February 24, 2011, we will revise *Postal Operations Manual*, part 617, to standardize the language and procedures for the Carrier Release Program. The changes authorize delivery personnel to leave parcels in unsecured locations when the parcel bears the “Carrier — Leave If No Response” endorsement.

617.2 Delivery of Parcels

617.21 Heavy or Bulky Items

A heavy or bulky item of any class is delivered as addressed, if facilities are available.

617.22 Delivery to Other Than the Addressee or Mail Receptacle

[Revise text to read as follows:]

Unless the addressee has filed a written order asking that parcels not be left outside the authorized delivery receptacle, uninsured parcels or parcels that do not require a signature may be left in an unprotected location, such as a stairway or uncovered porch, if:

- The addressee has filed a written order to leave parcels.
- The mailer has endorsed the item “Carrier — Leave If No Response.” The endorsement must appear directly to the left of the postage area (preferred) or be placed directly below the return address. A minimum 1/4 inch clear space must appear between any other printing and the carrier release endorsement. If an ancillary service endorsement is used, the carrier release endorsement must be separated from the ancillary service endorsement by the equivalent of one blank line of the type size used.

617.3 Additional Attempts to Deliver

617.31 Someone Normally Available to Receive Parcel

[Revise text to read as follows:]

When someone is normally available to receive parcels, and an uninsured parcel (a parcel not requiring a signature or a parcel that is not part of the Carrier Release Program) cannot be delivered on the carrier’s first attempt, a second delivery attempt is made the next working day and no PS Form 3849 is left on the initial attempt. If the parcel cannot be delivered on the second attempt, a PS Form 3849 is left at the address to indicate that the parcel is being held.

617.32 No One Usually Available to Receive Parcels

[Revise text to read as follows:]

If no one is available to receive the parcel, the carrier knows that someone at the address is not usually available to receive parcels, and the parcel is insured, requires a signature, or is not part of the Carrier Release Program, a PS Form 3849 is completed and left after the first attempt. When it is not known if someone is usually available to receive parcels, a PS Form 3849 is left after the first attempt if the parcel is insured, requires a signature, or is not part of the Carrier Release Program. Additional attempts are made only at the customer’s request.

Handbook M-41 Revision: Carrier Release Program Changes

Effective February 24, 2011, we will revise Handbook M-41, *City Delivery Carriers Duties and Responsibilities*, section 322.3, to standardize the language and procedures for the Carrier Release Program. The changes authorize delivery personnel to leave parcels in unsecured locations when the parcel bears the “Carrier — Leave If No Response” endorsement.

322.311 When the Carrier Is Authorized to Leave Parcels

[Revise items a and c as follows:]

- a. Uninsured parcels or parcels that do not require a signature may be left in an unprotected location such as a stairway or uncovered porch when the mailer participates in the Carrier Release Program by endorsing the parcel “Carrier — Leave If No Response” or the addressee has given written directions for an alternate delivery location. PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, with the “It Is Located: _____” block completed, must be left in the mail receptacle notifying the addressee of the mail left in the authorized alternate location.

- c. Mailers who participate in the Carrier Release Program understand that there are unsecured areas where the Postal Service will leave parcels and also that carriers will leave packages without protection from inclement weather.

322.312 When the Carrier Is Not Authorized to Leave Parcels

[Revise text to read as follows:]

- a. *When someone is usually available to receive parcels.* When an uninsured parcel, a parcel not requiring a signature, or a parcel that is not part of the Carrier Release Program is not delivered on the first attempt and the carrier knows that someone at the address is usually available to receive parcels, do not leave PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*. Write the date and the carrier's initials and route number near the address and return the parcel to the office. Place the parcel in the gurney at the carrier's case. Attempt a second delivery on the next delivery day. If the parcel is not delivered after the second attempt, complete and leave PS Form 3849. Legibly endorse the form with the following information:
- (1) Article number (if applicable).
 - (2) Date.
 - (3) Sender's name.
 - (4) Type of mail.
 - (5) Article requiring signature at time of delivery (if applicable).
 - (6) Addressee's name and address.
 - (7) Amount due (if applicable).
 - (8) Date and time customer can pick up article at Post Office.

- b. *When someone is not usually available to receive parcels.* If no one is available to receive the parcel, the carrier knows that someone at the address is *not* usually available to receive parcels, or the parcel is insured, requires a signature, or is not part of the Carrier Release Program, complete and leave PS Form 3849 (see Exhibit 322.312) after the first attempt. When the carrier does not know if someone is usually available to receive parcels, PS Form 3849 should be left after the first attempt if the parcel is insured, requires a signature, or is not part of the Carrier Release Program. Endorse the parcel near the address, showing the reason for nondelivery, e.g., "No Response", date delivery was attempted, and the carrier's initials and route number. Upon returning to the office, deposit the parcel in the designated place for undelivered parcels.

331.1 General

[Revise text to read as follows:]

Parcels must be taken out for delivery on the first trip after they arrive at the office.

331.2 Oversized Parcels

331.22 Leave Outside the Box

[Revise text to read as follows:]

Uninsured parcels or parcels that do not require a signature may be left outside the box or in an unprotected location such as a stairway or uncovered porch when the addressee has given written directions for an alternate delivery location or the mailer participates in the Carrier Release Program by endorsing the package "Carrier — Leave If No Response."

- a. **Customer Authorization to Leave.** If a customer has filed a written order stating that parcels too large

for the box may be left outside the box or in another designated location, you may do so.

b. **Mailer Authorization to Leave.** When a parcel is endorsed, “Carrier — Leave If No Response,” and no one is available to receive it, you may leave it in an unprotected location, e.g., stairway or uncovered porch. A PS Form 3849, *Delivery/Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, with the “It Is Located: _____” block completed must be left in the mail receptacle notifying the addressee of the mail if left in an alternate location. Mailers who participate in the Carrier Release Program understand that there are unsecured areas where the Postal Service will leave parcels and also understand that carriers will leave parcels without protection from inclement weather.

c. **Liability.** By following the mailer’s or addressee’s instructions, the Postal Service provides customers

with a more convenient way to receive parcels. Carriers are not liable for loss or theft when the customer’s instructions and postal regulations are followed.

Stamp Announcement 11-09: Latin Music Legends

On March 16, 2011, in Austin, Texas, the Postal Service™ will issue a *Latin Music Legends* commemorative stamp (Forever® priced at 44 cents), in five designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 467100). The stamp, designed by Ethel Kessler, Bethesda, Maryland, will go on sale nationwide March 16, 2011.

With this 2011 stamp issuance, the U.S. Postal Service® honors five musicians and performers of the Latin sound whose contributions have had a lasting impact on American music — Tito Puente, Carmen Miranda, Selena, Carlos Gardel, and Celia Cruz. Among the distinctive musical genres and styles represented are latin jazz, samba, tejano, tango, and salsa.

For these stamps, artist Rafael Lopez, San Diego, California, painted semi-realistic portraits of each musical artist designed to evoke their personality, their vitality, and even their sound. He used a warm palette of colors — from brilliant yellows, pinks, and lime green to rich shades of purple and blue — to suggest the flavor and energy these artists brought to their work. Each musician is depicted in mid-performance. Art Director Ethel Kessler says, “My goal was that when you see the stamp, you hear the music.”



Stamp Announcement 11-10: Neon Celebrate!

On March 25, 2011, in Cleveland, Ohio, the Postal Service™ will issue a *Neon Celebrate!* special stamp (Forever® priced at 44 cents), in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 576200). The stamp, designed by Phil Jordan, Falls Church, Virginia, will go on sale nationwide March 25, 2011.

Inspired by a visit to the Museum of Neon Art in Los Angeles, Art Director Phil Jordan began to think about the possibility of using neon to depict a stamp subject. He decided that a “*Neon Celebrate!*” stamp, with its imagery of vivid colors, fit the bill. The black background of the stamp is reminiscent of a night sky. Like a fireworks display on a summer evening, brilliantly colored images of swirls, circles, and dashes in pink, blue, orange, yellow, and green seem to erupt from the ground to illuminate the darkness. Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration form is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise) addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. PS Form 2976 is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces, and PS Form 2976-A is required for items weighing 16 ounces or more. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). When the surface area of the address side of the mailpiece is not large enough to contain a PS Form 2976-A, the smaller PS Form 2976 may be substituted (e.g., the Priority Mail Small Flat Rate Box). The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:

- Maximum length 12 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
- Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Stamp Announcement 11-11: Jazz

On March 26, 2011, in New Orleans, Louisiana, the Postal Service™ will issue a *Jazz* commemorative stamp (Forever® priced at 44 cents), in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 466600). The stamp, designed by Howard E. Paine, Delaplane, Virginia, will go on sale nationwide March 26, 2011.

The U.S. Postal Service® is proud to pay tribute to jazz, America's musical gift to the world, and to the musicians who play it on festival stages as well as in studios, clubs, and concert halls. Art Director, Howard Paine, designed the stamp to showcase the work of Paul Rogers, an artist living in Pasadena, California. In creating the art for the stamp, originally using ink on paper and then finishing his work digitally, Rogers explored the way images could become a visual equivalent of jazz music. He was inspired by the cover art from vintage jazz record albums — work that captured the music's improvisational quality while built on a clear understanding of its underlying structure.

On April 7, 2011, in New York, New York, the Postal Service™ will issue a 29-cent *Herbs* stamp in five designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 104400) and a PSA coil of 100 (Item 771900). The stamp, designed by Phil Jordan, Falls Church, Virginia, will go on sale nationwide April 7, 2011.

The United States Postal Service® will issue five stamps featuring various herbs used for fragrance, flavoring, medicine, and/or decoration. Artist Teresa Fasolino, New York, New York, created original oil paintings for each stamp. Each stamp depicts a particular species in bloom, as well as a typical leaf and flower or seed capsule. 

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.



Stop Sending Copies of PS Form 8176, Premium Forwarding Service Application, to Headquarters

Offices are no longer required to send a copy of PS Form 8176, *Premium Forwarding Service*® (PFS®) *Application*, to Headquarters (HQ). This requirement ended in 2007 when the application was revised and page 4 (HQ copy) was removed. In 2005, the PFS program office at HQ required a copy of page 4 when PFS was an experiment.

However, the experiment ended in 2007 when PFS became an official product offering. Offices that still send copies to HQ are wasting workhours and money — especially some offices that send them by Express Mail® , Registered Mail® , and Priority Mail® service.


