

What's new?

What's changing?

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. What will I find on the new USPS.com?
- A. Most importantly, you will find an e-commerce site that is designed to help customers do business with us more easily. This includes navigation that helps customers take action, whether they want to ship, send mail, manage their mail, or shop. "Quick Tools" links on every page will keep the most popular functions on USPS.com at customers' fingertips. There's also a more modern look and feel and streamlined account signup. You will also find a separate site, about.USPS.com, designed to help customers find information about us.
- Q. What will I find on about.usps.com?
- A. You will find the corporate site, separate from USPS.com, that is designed to help customers find information about us more easily. It contains a vast array of information on USPS, such as press releases, annual reports, career information, and publications. It will be easily accessible from a banner on the USPS.com home page, via an "About USPS" link on the bottom of every page (similar to other websites), or by going directly to www.about.usps.com.
- Q. Will the URL (web address) for USPS.com remain the same?
- A. Yes, you can still access the USPS site by entering the following URL: www.usps.com.
- Q. Why are we changing USPS.com?
- A. We've redesigned USPS.com to improve the customer experience for households and small businesses (convenient, simple, consistent), to grow revenue (introduce new services to the web, and be the preferred option against competitors), and to reduce costs (migrate transactions to lower cost channels).
- Q. What are "Quick Tools?"
- A. "Quick Tools" are the most frequently used applications on USPS.com, which allow you to perform specific tasks such as Track & Confirm, Find a Post Office, Calculate a Price, and Look up a ZIP Code without leaving the page you are currently viewing.
- Q. Where can I find "Quick Tools?"
- A. "Quick Tools" can be found on every new page on USPS.com in the upper left-hand corner.
- Q. If I already have an account on USPS.com do I need to sign up again?
- A. You will not need to set up a new account. All of your profile information will remain as you had originally entered it, including your login ID and password, and any data you have saved previously, such as stored

- credit card and address book information. The only difference you will see is a newly designed log-in page.
- Q. How is the process to sign up for new customers on USPS.com simpler?
- A. Registration will now be done on 1 page versus the previous 3-page process.
- Q. Is Track & Confirm redesigned?
- A. Yes, the new Track & Confirm Quick Tool now allows you to enter up to 10 tracking numbers at one time. In addition, your tracking information will be presented in a format that is easier to read.
- Q. Is free Package Pickup redesigned?
- A. Yes, it has a more modern look and feel and streamlined process that mirrors the other new pages on USPS.com. As more applications are redesigned and added, they will also have the same look and feel, making it easier and quicker for customers to switch from application to application and complete their tasks.
- Q. Can I still buy stamps and order free shipping supplies at USPS.com?
- A. Yes, you will still be able to purchase stamps and order free shipping supplies through The Postal Store[®] now found under the "Shop" link in the top navigation. A new Postal Store is planned for release later this fall.
- Q. Will I still be able to print a shipping label?
- A. Yes, Click-N-Ship[®] service will still be available to create, manage, and print shipping labels, and will be found under the "Ship a Package" link in the top navigation. A completely redesigned Click-N-Ship application is planned to be released early 2012.
- Q. Will I be able to manage my mail? (e.g., Hold Mail, Forward Mail, Change Address, and Schedule a Redelivery)
- A. Yes, these and other services and more will be available and will be found under the "Manage Your Mail" link in the top navigation.
- Q. Are there other enhancements to USPS.com planned for this fall?
- A. Yes, this is just the beginning! In addition to a redesigned shopping experience on USPS.com this fall, there will be new/redesigned applications for Hold Mail, Redelivery, Personalized Stamp Envelopes, and Premium Forwarding Service[®]. DMM Revision: Use of Precanceled Stamps — Clarification

Effective August 1, 2011, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 234.0, 244.0, 334.0, 344.0, 434.0, 444.0, and 604.3.0 to clarify standards for use of precanceled stamps and the use of mailer's precancel postmarks.

This revision clarifies that mailers may place more than a single denominated stamp on each mailpiece when those stamps are precanceled by an authorized mailer's precancel postmark, provided that the total of the postage on the mailpiece equals the exact monetary value of the USPS® precanceled stamp appropriate to the price category of the mailpiece (i.e. \$0.05, \$0.10, \$0.15, and \$0.25).

The Postal Service further clarifies that, unless permitted by other standards or Business Mailer Support authorization, when using USPS precanceled stamps, mailers must affix only a single USPS precanceled stamp to each mailpiece, and that each mailpiece prepared as part of the same mailing must bear the same amount of affixed postage.

USPS precanceled stamps, or denominated stamps precanceled by a mailer's precancel postmark, are optional postage payment method(s) for mailers who choose these methods in lieu of a permit imprint or postage meter imprint when presenting commercial mailings at presorted or automation First-Class Mail® or all Standard Mail® prices.

Throughout this revision, the Postal Service clarifies the standards for postage payment using precanceled stamps and eliminates redundant and obsolete language.

Mailers may begin preparing their mailings in accordance with these new standards immediately.

[Delete 3.3, Nondenominated Precanceled Stamps, and 3.4, Precanceled Stamps in Lower Price Denominations, in their entirety and renumber current 3.5 as new 3.3.]

3.1.5 Amount of Postage

[Revise 3.1.5 as follows:]

The value of precanceled stamps affixed to each piece in a mailing must be either the exact amount due or the exact monetary value of the USPS precanceled stamp appropriate to the price category of the mailpiece. Unless permitted by other standards or Business Mailer Support authorization, the same monetary value of stamp(s) must be affixed

to every piece in the mailing. Refunds for overpayment must meet the standards in 9.0.

3.3 USPS Precanceled Stamps

USPS precanceled stamps are preprinted with a price category as the precancellation method. The following also applies:

- a. Unless used to pay single-piece postage under 3.3d or to pay postage under 3.5 or 3.6, or permitted by other standards or Business Mailer Support authorization, only one USPS precanceled stamp may be affixed to each piece in a mailing.
- b. Mailpieces bearing a USPS precanceled stamp must include the return address.
- c. If the return address is not within the delivery area of the Post Office of mailing, the mailer must place a cancellation endorsement on the piece or provide mailing information to the Post Office shown in the return address.

d. USPS precanceled stamps may be used to pay single-piece postage if the piece bearing the stamps has the correct marking (e.g., "First-Class Mail") immediately under the postage.

3.4 Precancellation of Stamps by Mailer

3.4.1 Definition of Stamps Precanceled by Mailer

[Revise 3.4.1 by adding a new second sentence as follows:]

***Mailers authorized under 3.4 may precancel one or more
postage stamps provided the total of the postage on the
mailpiece equals the exact monetary value of the corresponding USPS precanceled stamp appropriate to the

price category of the mailpiece.***

Handbooks

Handbook PO-101 Revision: Discontinuance Procedures

Effective July 14, 2011, Handbook PO-101, Postal Service-Operated Retail Facilities Discontinuance Guide, is revised to incorporate changes to discontinuance procedures for Postal Service-operated retail units. This edition supersedes Handbook PO-101, Post Office Discontinuance Guide, August 2004, and all previous editions.

As a matter of policy, revised Handbook PO-101 extends the notice and comment procedures for Post OfficeTM discontinuance actions to discontinuance of classified stations and classified branches. The changes to this handbook are not retroactive and are not mandatory for discontinuance actions that commenced when previous procedures and regulations were in effect and for which the initial feasibility study was begun before the effective date of the revised handbook.

Except as indicated here, any previous applicable directive that is in conflict with this handbook is rescinded, and the previous issue of Handbook PO-101 is obsolete.

The July 2011 issue of Publication 75, *Mover's Guide* has been shipped to all Post Office™ facilities. All shipments should have been received by June 30, 2011. After June 2011, recycle all expired versions.

The cover of the *Mover's Guide* envelope now includes color-coded up/down arrows along with the in-market dates to convey its effective quarter.

The corresponding color code of the up/down arrow for the July 2011 issue is *purple*.

Mover's Guide Information

- Offices will receive copies of Mover's Guide in one or two shipments. The first shipments should have arrived at the end of June. The second shipments will arrive 3 to 5 weeks later. Shipments are sent in quantities of 25, 100, and 300.
- Your facility may receive copies of Mover's Guide addressed to other offices. If so, break down each pallet in accordance with the posted plaque, check the labels, and forward the guides as appropriate.

Behind the Counter Program

Below are a few points about program compliance:

- Copies of Mover's Guide must be kept behind the counter. No copies of Mover's Guide should be placed in the inner or outer lobby or on the clerk counters. Postal carriers are encouraged to distribute Internet change-of-address (ICOA) Message Cards in lieu of copies of Mover's Guide on postal routes.
- Retail associates should encourage their customers requesting change-of-address information to go online at www.usps.com. ICOA transactions provide customers with the most convenient, safe, and secure way to change their address. Furthermore, ICOA transactions reduce processing time, improve address accuracy, and generate significant revenue for the Postal ServiceTM.
- Advise customers to take an ICOA Message Card to reinforce an online change-of-address message.
- Customers unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at www.usps.com should be given a complete, unopened copy of Mover's Guide.

Note: The Mover's Guide Behind the Counter Program is part of the ad-hoc section of the 2010 Retail Customer Experience Program, so it is critical that your Post Office be compliant with the program throughout the year by keeping copies of *Mover's Guide* out of Post Office lobbies.

ICOA Message Card Information

- If your Post Office has an ICOA Message Card display, do not throw it away. The display is required to be in the lobby and expected to have the ICOA Message Cards in it at all times. Replenishment cards and updated banners are mailed with your Mover's Guide shipments.
- If your Post Office does not have an ICOA Message Card display, you must call the replenishment phone number below for ICOA Message Card replenishment.
- If any Post Office runs out of ICOA Message Cards between shipments, call Imagitas at 800-816-6837 for replenishment.
- All Post Offices must have ICOA Message Cards in their lobbies for customer reference.

Reminder: Every Door Direct Mail Shipment Options

As a reminder, Every Door Direct Mail™ (EDDM) mailers and mail service providers (MSPs) can ship EDDM mailpieces to destinating offices or facilities without having to travel to those locations to drop off mailings in person. Procedures differ for EDDM and EDDM Retail. Only EDDM customers entering mail through the Business Mail Entry Units (BMEUs) may use Priority Mail Open and Distribute (PMOD) service.

- EDDM customers (BMEU entry) may ship their mailings to destinating facilities using PMOD. The *Priority Mail Open and Distribute Operational Guide* is available from the Customer Services Operations and Retail website at http://blue.usps.gov/procops/proc/PMOD_2010_r7.1.pdf, or see http://www.usps.com/shipping/opendistribute.htm for more information.
- EDDM Retail customers can ship their Standard Mail[®] flats to destinating Post Office[™] facilities using regular Priority Mail[®] service with delivery instructions, docu-

mentation, and payment enclosed. August 19, 2011 (HOL).

Starting with the June 25, 2010, print cycle, the Englishonly brochures have been replaced with bilingual (English and Spanish) brochures. All orders received from SBM sites by June 25 and thereafter will be provided bilingual brochures. There is no change in the price.

You may pay for orders (under \$10,000) with local IMPAC credit cards, checks, or money orders. However, Cyril-Scott Company cannot process the order until it receives payment. Local eBuy procedures may also apply (refer to local procurement procedures). Cyril-Scott Com-

pany must receive orders placed by mail by close of business the day of the print run cut-off date listed here. Orders received after the cut-off date will be processed the next print run date.

All local Post Offices[™] and centralized sites should follow the ordering instructions contained within this article and use local funds.

For Orders Exceeding \$10,000

Use eBuy to process brochure orders that exceed \$10,000.00. In the Purchasing Method field, select "Route Req to Supply Mgmt," then in the After Approval Route field, select "Customer Products & Fulfillment CMC (Aurora, CO)" Include completed PS Form 3227-O with imprint information with the eBuy order.

Note: These approved eBuy orders must be received by Supply Management at least 10 days before a published run cut-off date to be included in that run.

Cyril-Scott Company will deliver orders within 35 calendar days after printing. Printing begins 1 week after the deadline date, and actual receipt of the order will depend on the ultimate destination and the corresponding delivery service standard. You should save copies of all orders placed at your local Post Office until the order has been received. Ensure procedures are in effect locally for proper verification of receipt.

Stamp Announcement 11-35: Flags of Our Nation: Set 5



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On August 11, 2011, in Columbus, Ohio, at the American Philatelic Society Stamp Show, the Postal Service™ will issue the *Flags of Our Nation: Set 5* (Forever® priced at 44 cents) in 10 designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) coil of 50 stamps (Item 788300).

With these 10 new designs, the U.S. Postal Service[®] continues its *Flags of Our Nation* series with stamps that feature the flags of eight states — Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, and Tennessee — as well as those of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. In addition to the official flag, each stamp design includes artwork that provides a "snapshot view" — such as an everyday scene or activity, rare wildlife, perhaps, or a stunning vista — of the state or other area represented by the pictured flag. Art director Howard E. Paine collaborated with artist Tom Engeman on the 50 stamps in this series.

The stamp will go on sale nationwide August 11, 2011.

Distribution: Item 788300, Flags of Our Nation: Set 5 (Forever priced at 44 cents), PSA Coil of 50 Stamps

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution centers (SDCs) will receive an automatic distribution quantity of this PSA coil stamp. Distributions are rounded up to the nearest master carton size of 800 coils.

Initial Supply to Post Offices

SDOs/SDCs will *not* make an automatic distribution to Post Offices for this stamp issue. Post Offices must requisition them from their designated SDO/SDC using PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition/Stamp Return*. Post Offices may preorder this item 30 days before the August 11 first day

issue date to ensure their office has quantity available. SDOs/SDCs must not distribute this commemorative stamp to Post Offices before July 29, 2011.

Sales Policy

All Post Offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp for a minimum of 90 days from the first day of issue, and beyond that as long as customer demand exists, until inventory is depleted, or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale. If supplies run low, Post Offices must reorder additional quantities using their normal ordering procedures.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™ facility, at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop, or by calling 800-STAMP-24. They should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by October 11, 2011.

Special Dedication Postmarks

Only the following pictorial postmark is permitted for the *Flags of Our Nation:* Set 5 stamp. The word "Station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design, because it will be a temporary station.




















To finalize the *Flags of Our Nation:* Set 5 stamp pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state and ZIP $Code^{TM}$ of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches horizontally by 2 inches vertically. Collectors prefer the dimensions 3 1/2 inches by 1.

The Postal Service must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services 4 weeks before the events using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announce-ment/Report*. Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service $^{\text{TM}}$ money order:

- Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
- 2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration form is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise) addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. PS Form 2976 is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces, and PS Form 2976-A is required for items weighing 16 ounces or more. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). When the surface area of the address side of the mailpiece is not large enough to contain a PS Form 2976-A, the smaller PS Form 2976 may be substituted (e.g., the Priority Mail Small Flat Rate Box). The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

- C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.
- **C1.** Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.
 - **D.** Coffee is prohibited.
 - $\textbf{E1.}\ \textbf{Medicines}\ \textbf{or}\ \textbf{vaccines}\ \textbf{not}\ \textbf{conforming}\ \textbf{to}\ \textbf{French}\ \textbf{laws}\ \textbf{are}\ \textbf{prohibited}.$
- **E2.** Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.
- E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.
- **F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.1c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.
- **F1.** Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.
- **F2.** Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.
- **G.** Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.
- H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.
 - **H1.** Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

- I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:
 - Maximum length 20 inches.
 - Maximum width 12 inches.
 - Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

- I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.
- $\mbox{\bf I2.}$ This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.
 - J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.
- **K.** Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."
 - L. All official mail is prohibited.
 - M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.
 - N. Registered mail is prohibited.
- Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.
 - P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.
- **Q.** Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.
- **R.** All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.
- **R1.** Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.
- **S.** Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:
 - Maximum length 12 inches.
 - Maximum width 12 inches.
 - Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
 - Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

- **T.** Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.
- **U.** Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."
- **U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.
- $\mbox{\bf U2.}$ Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.
- **U3.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.
 - V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.
 - V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.
- **W.** Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.
- **X.** Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.
- **Y.** Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.
 - Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).
- **Z1.** The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Alternatively, Missing Children posters can be maintained in a binder behind the counter to be used as a reference guide. The posters also may be posted in a prominent location where letter carriers will be able to see them before or after they go out on their routes. Making this information available to letter carriers is consistent with the NALC/USPS Child Alert Program to facilitate identification of missing children.

Companion posters, authorized for display on bulletin boards maintained by employee organizations, appear periodically in *The Postal Record*, a publication for members of the National Association of Letter Carriers.

This poster is published in cooperation with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the United States Department of Justice, and the National Association of Letter Carriers. Information appearing on this poster is selected solely by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC).

In addition to *Postal Bulletin* updates, NCMEC distributes information periodically. Notification of newly reported missing children is sent to designated district "Missing Children" coordinators via e-mail addresses provided by district managers. Within 24 hours of receipt of an e-mailed Missing Children poster, district coordinators should distribute copies to all Postal Service™ facilities in their districts. Missing Children posters are to be displayed as noted above for 30 days unless notification is received (from NCMEC) to remove a particular poster sooner. The e-mail network is used to distribute posters and information in only the most urgent cases of missing children. This system supplements, but does not replace, the missing children information in this *Postal Bulletin*.

Missing Children posters are available to the U.S. Postal Service[®] only as described above. If Postal Service employees are contacted by individuals or local agencies about displaying a sign or poster of a missing child in local Post Offices, the individual or agency should be politely informed that the U.S. Postal Service displays only those posters provided by NCMEC, because it has been designated by the U.S. Department of Justice to be the national clearinghouse and resource center for missing and exploited children. The individual or agency should then be referred to NCMEC at 800-843-5678.

On August 12, 2011, in Columbus, Ohio, at the American Philatelic Stamp Show, the Postal Service[™] will issue an *Eid* definitive stamp (Forever[®] priced at 44 cents) in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 576700).



Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail[®] postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4[®] Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office $^{\text{TM}}$, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.



The next Semi-Annual Capital Property Review is scheduled to begin on August 1, 2011; the completion deadline is August 15, 2011. The list of items to be verified by the selected finance numbers will be sent out by e-mail from "Materials, Customer Service - Topeka, KS" the week of August 1, 2011.

The Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews are a Sarbanes-Oxley (SOX) requirement. A list of finance numbers that receive a Semi-Annual Capital Property Certification Report but do not submit the report on time will be provided to senior management.

As needed, the Asset Accountability Service Centers (AASCs) will be contacting Headquarters, area, district, and/or local management to verify the points of contact for the upcoming August 2011 Semi-Annual Capital Property Review. The AASCs will provide instructions and guidelines on how the Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews are to be conducted by the field and Headquarters groups. Handbook AS-701, *Material Management*, is under revision; instructions and guidelines provided by the AASCs will supersede Handbook AS-701 where there are conflicts.
