# **Cover Story**

### Store Empty Sacks Flat for Return to Mail Transport Equipment Service Centers

It's time to make a change in sack storage. For decades, Post Offices<sup>™</sup> and processing plants have "bummed" canvas and nylon sacks. The term "bum" is a carryover from the days when mail moved by rail. Sacks rode the rails without "working," which they would do if they were carrying mail.

Nineteen sacks were stuffed into one for return to the mailbag depositories for storage until they were needed again. Now, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> purchases plastic sacks rather than canvas or nylon sacks. Crumbling and stuffing these plastic sacks inside of each other reduces their life, wastes work hours, and can hide mailpieces from employees.

To properly store empty sacks for return to Mail Transport Equipment Service Centers (MTESCs), employees must:

- 1. Empty the mail sack;
- 2. Pull the label;
- 3. Elbow the sack to ensure all mail is out;
- 4. Lay the sack flat on a pallet, in a cardboard Gaylord box, or in a hamper; and
- 5. Return the sacks to the closest MTESC.

# Policies, Procedures, and Forms Updates

# Manuals

#### DMM Revision: Elimination of Fees

Effective April 3, 2017, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM<sup>®</sup>) in various sections to clarify the standards for the applicability of certain fees.

Effective with the January 22, 2017, price change, the Postal Service eliminated certain fees for outbound and return products. The Postal Service eliminated the permit imprint application fee for certain products, the annual mailing fee for certain products, the Business Reply Mail<sup>®</sup> (BRM) annual permit fee for parcel returns, the Qualified Business Reply Mail<sup>™</sup> (QBRM<sup>™</sup>) annual permit fee, and the fees for Merchandise Return Service (MRS), including USPS<sup>®</sup> Return Services.

The Postal Service eliminated the permit imprint application fee for all Priority Mail Express<sup>®</sup>, Priority Mail<sup>®</sup>, First-Class Package Service<sup>®</sup>, Media Mail<sup>®</sup>, Library Mail, Bound Printed Matter (BPM) Parcels, and Parcel Select<sup>®</sup> mailpieces. Other than for mailers using the Electronic Verification System (eVS<sup>®</sup>), a permit imprint application fee will continue to be required for mailing First-Class Mail<sup>®</sup>, USPS Marketing Mail<sup>™</sup>, BPM Flats, and international mail that uses a permit imprint.

The Postal Service also eliminated the annual mailing fee for mailings of Media Mail, Library Mail, BPM Parcels, and Parcel Select. An annual mailing fee will continue to be required for mailings of First-Class Mail automation or presort, USPS Marketing Mail, and destination entry BPM Flats.

The BRM Basic or High Volume annual permit fee is not required for the exclusive return of parcels. An annual permit fee is required for the return of letters, cards, or flats, including when a mailer also receives the return of parcels. The QBRM Basic and High Volume annual permit fees have been eliminated. An annual permit fee may be required if the BRM permit is not used exclusively for the return of QBRM pieces. QBRM will also be subject to the payment of an annual permit fee if pieces prepared as QBRM do not meet the format requirements for QBRM.

The annual permit fee and account maintenance fee for MRS (including USPS Return Services) have been eliminated.

In addition to the above DMM revisions, the Postal Service will also update Quick Service Guide (QSG) 505, *Business Reply Mail*, and Notice 123, *Price List*.

Although we will not publish the changes in the DMM until April 3, 2017, these standards are effective immediately.

#### 1.2.6 Destination Entry Mailing Fee

[Revise the text of 1.2.6 to read as follows:]

A destination entry mailing fee for BPM Flats destination entry mailings must be paid once each 12-month period at each Post Office of mailing by or for any person or organization that mails at the BPM Flats destination entry prices, except as provided otherwise for plant-verified drop shipments. For BPM Flats destination entry mail manifested using eVS under 705.2.9, only one annual BPM Flats destination entry mailing fee (paid at the Post Office where the eVS permit imprint account is held) is required regardless of the number of Postal Service facilities where mailings are verified. All BPM Flats destination entry prices are covered under the payment of a single annual fee. The fee may be paid in advance only for the next 12 months and only during the last 60 days of the current service period. The fee charged is that which is in effect on the date of payment. Payment of this fee is waived for mailers who present only qualified full-service flat-size automation mailings under 705.23.0.

#### 3.3 Postage Payment and Mailing Fees

- a. Mailers must pay postage, and for BPM Flats mailings the correct mailing fees, at each Post Office where they are authorized to present mailings for verification unless using the Electronic Verification System (eVS) under 705.2.9. Except for plant-verified drop shipments (see 705.17.0) and eVS shipments (see 705.2.9), mailers must have a permit imprint authorization at the parent Post Office for mailings deposited for entry at a DNDC, ASF, DSCF, or DDU. Correct mailing fees for BPM Flat mailings must be paid for the current 12-month period at the USPS facility where postage is paid for the mailing.
- b. Mailers who mail parcels paid with a permit imprint and claimed at Bound Printed Matter destination entry prices may use eVS under 705.2.9. Mailers using eVS must pay postage and applicable fees at the Post Office where they hold the permit used for all eVS mailings.

#### 1.1 BRM Postage and Fees

#### 1.1.1 Basic BRM

[Revise the first sentence of 1.1.1 to read as follows:]

For basic BRM, a permit holder is required to pay an annual permit fee as provided under 1.2 and a per piece fee under

1.1.7 in addition to the applicable Retail First-Class Mail (metered for letters) or Priority Mail postage for each returned piece.

#### 1.1.3 Basic Qualified BRM (QBRM)

[Revise the text of 1.1.3 to read as follows:]

For basic qualified BRM, a permit holder is required to pay an account maintenance fee under 1.1.8, and a per piece fee under 1.1.7 in addition to the applicable letter or card First-Class Mail postage for each returned piece. An annual permit fee may also be required under 1.2.3 if the BRM permit is not used exclusively for the return of QBRM pieces. Pieces that do not meet the format requirements for QBRM cannot qualify for the QBRM per piece fees or postage prices and are charged the high-volume BRM per piece fees and First-Class Mail postage under 1.1.2, and are subject to an annual permit fee.

#### 1.1.5 Bulk Weight Averaged Nonletter-Size BRM

[Revise the text of 1.1.5 to read as follows:]

In addition to an annual permit fee (which will apply under 1.2.3 for the return of any flat-size pieces), the per piece fee, and the applicable Retail First-Class Mail or Priority Mail postage, permit holders participating in bulk weight averaged nonletter-size BRM under 1.8 must pay an annual account maintenance fee and a monthly maintenance fee.

#### 1.2.2 Application Process

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>If a completed PS Form 3615 is already on file for the mailer for other permits at that office, then the mailer must submit the annual BRM permit fee, if required under 1.2.3, and the USPS amends PS Form 3615 by adding the BRM authorization.<sup>\*\*\*</sup>

#### 1.2.3 Annual Permit Fee

#### [Revise the text of 1.2.3 to read as follows:]

Except for permits used for only BRM parcels and QBRM, a permit fee must be paid once each 12-month period at each Post Office where a BRM permit is held. The fee may be paid in advance only for the next 12 months and only during the last 60 days of the current service period. The fee charged is that which is in effect on the date of payment. For agents authorized by a permit holder to distribute and receive BRM, see 1.7.

#### 1.2.4 Renewal of Annual Permit Fee

#### [Revise the introductory text of 1.2.4 to read as follows:]

Except for permits used for only BRM parcels and QBRM, an annual renewal notice is provided to each BRM permit holder by the USPS. Permits used for only BRM parcels and QBRM do not expire unless the account is unused for a period of 24 months. The renewal notice and the payment, if applicable, for the next 12 months must be returned by the expiration date to the Post Office that issued the permit. After the expiration date, the returned BRM pieces are treated as follows until the permit fee is paid, the unused permit is reactivated, or a new permit is obtained, as applicable:

b. Annual Permit Fee — Agents do not pay a separate annual permit fee but must submit evidence (usually a copy of PS Form 3544) to the local office once each 12-month period to show that the annual permit fee, if applicable, has been paid. This evidence is not required if the permit holder has a centralized account processing system (CAPS) account, through which the local Post Office can determine that the permit fee, if applicable, has been paid.

#### 3.0 Merchandise Return Service (MRS)

#### 3.1 Prices and Fees

#### 3.1.1 Permit

An approved merchandise return permit on PS Form 3615 must be on file at every Post Office to which parcels are returned.

#### 3.1.2 Advance Deposit Account

A permit holder must pay postage and extra service fees through an advance deposit account. When an advance deposit account is kept at each entry location, a separate permit (except as provided under 3.2.11 and for qualified national permit holders using scan-based payment for returns) is needed at each Post Office.

#### 3.2.6 Application Process

3.2

[Revise the text of 3.2.6 to read as follows:]

The applicant must submit a completed PS Form 3615 to the Post Office issuing the permit, or amend an existing PS Form 3615 on file at that office by adding the merchandise return service authorization to existing Returns Service permit authorizations. Except for MRS labels generated by the USPS Application Program Interface (API), PS Form 3615 must be accompanied by copies of the MRS labels (including printed copies of labels intended to be faxed to customers or transmitted to customers electronically) and the instructions provided to the permit holder's customers. All MRS labels that have preprinted USPS Tracking barcodes must be approved by the USPS. If articles are to be returned from customers as Registered Mail, the applicant must indicate "Registered Mail" on the application. After a MRS permit is obtained, any change to label formats or customer instructions must be approved by the Post Office where the permit is held. MRS permits do not expire unless the account is unused for a period of 24 months.

#### 3.2.7 Permit Renewal

[Revise the text of 3.2.7 to read as follows:]

Written authorization is not needed for permit renewal if there is no change to the authorization on file at the delivery unit.

[Revise the title and text of 3.2.8 to read as follows:]

#### 3.2.8 Canceled or Expired Permit

If the permit has expired, merchandise return mail bearing the sender's return address is returned to the sender; otherwise, it is treated as dead mail.

#### 3.2.10 Reapplying After Cancellation or Expiration

To receive a new MRS permit at the same Post Office after a merchandise return permit is canceled or expired, the applicant must amend the PS Form 3615 on file at that office to reflect the new application date; submit for approval two samples of any label format to be used; if canceled, provide evidence that the reasons for the permit cancellation are corrected; and provide and keep funds in an advance deposit account to cover normal returns for at least two weeks.

#### 3.2.11 Using Other Post Offices

#### [Revise the text of 3.2.11 to read as follows:]

The permit holder may distribute merchandise return labels for return through other Post Offices (i.e. stations or branches under a Main Post Office) if the permit holder opens and keeps their advance deposit account at the Post Office where the permit is issued and supplies that Postmaster the name, address, and telephone number of a representative in each additional station or branch, if different from the information on the application.

An application fee is required only when a permit imprint is used as the payment method for First-Class Mail, USPS Marketing Mail, Bound Printed Matter Flats, and international mail, and the mailer does not use the Electronic Verification System (eVS).

#### 6.4 Advance Deposit Account

[Revise the text of 6.4 to read as follows:]

Mailers may choose to establish an advance deposit account(s) from which postage, per piece charges, and other fees are deducted. For certain return services, an advance deposit account is required. Mailers may use a single advance deposit account to pay postage due charges for more than one return service (e.g., business reply mail, merchandise return service, and bulk parcel return service).

[Revise the title and text of 6.5 to read as follows:]

#### 6.5 Annual Accounting Fee for Return Services

Except for accounts used solely to pay postage due for shortpaid mail, address correction notices, and undeliverable-as-addressed pieces returned to sender (e.g., return service requested) mailers must pay a separate annual accounting fee, if applicable, for each return service paid through an advance deposit account. This fee covers the administrative cost of maintaining the account and provides the mailer with the accounting of all charges deducted from that account. The accounting fee is charged once each 12-month period on the anniversary date of the initial accounting fee payment. The fee may be paid in advance only for the next year and only during the last 60 days of the current service period. The fee charged is that which is in effect on the date of payment.



### DMM Revision: Media Mail and Library Mail

Effective March 6, 2017, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service,* Domestic Mail Manual (DMM<sup>®</sup>), in various sections of part 270, to include the Media Mail<sup>®</sup> and Library Mail parcel barcode standard, clarify flat-size mail preparation, and update DMM references.

The Postal Service will:

- Add the Intelligent Mail<sup>®</sup> package barcode (IMpb<sup>®</sup>) requirements for Media Mail and Library Mail parcels in new subsection 273.5.5 for consistency in the DMM.
- Revise the flat-size mail eligibility standard in 273.1.2 and move it under 275.4.0.
- Update several DMM references in 273.7.3.

Although we will not publish the changes in the DMM until March 6, 2017, the revisions are effective immediately.

- a. 5-Digit Presort Price. To qualify for the 5-digit price, a piece must be sorted to 5-digit sacks under 275.5.0 or 5-digit pallets under 705.8.0. All logical 5-digit bundles on pallets must contain at least 10 pieces.
- b. Basic Presort Price. All pieces prepared and sorted under 275.5.0 or 705.8.0, that are not eligible for the 5-digit price, qualify for the basic price.
- 7.3.2 Parcels \*

[Revise items a. and b. to read as follows:]

a. To qualify for the 5-digit price, a piece must be sorted to either 5-digit scheme (machinable parcels only) and 5-digit sacks under 275.6.0, or to 5-digit scheme (machinable parcels only) and 5-digit pallets under 705.8.0, or 705.22.0. All logical 5-digit bundles on pallets must contain at least 10 pieces. Nonmachinable parcels may qualify for the 5-digit price if prepared to preserve sortation by 5-digit ZIP Code as prescribed by the Postmaster of the mailing office.

b. All pieces prepared and sorted under 275.6.0, 705.8.0, or 705.22.0 that are not eligible for the 5-digit price may qualify for the basic price. Nonmachinable parcels may qualify for the basic price if prepared to preserve sortation by NDC as prescribed by the Postmaster of the mailing office.

# ELM Revision: Diversity, Equal Employment Opportunity, and Prevention of Employment Discrimination

Effective March 2, 2017, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> is revising the Employee and Labor Relations Manual (ELM), part 670, to update the Postal Service's obligations to promote diversity and inclusion, to provide equal employment opportunity, and to refrain from employment discrimination.

#### Employee and Labor Relations Manual (ELM)

- Diversity and inclusion in a manner that instills confidence that employment decisions are made in accordance with our equal employment opportunity policies - where all employees are treated fairly based on merit and neither advantaged nor disadvantaged based on factors like sex, sexual orientation, age, race, religion, national origin, military service, or disability.

The Postal Service reflects strategies to achieve diversity and inclusion by providing equal employment opportunity and refraining from discrimination in the following areas:

- Recruitment.
- Selection.
- Promotion (including succession planning and opportunities for training and development).
- Retention of employees.

The Postal Service expects its executives and managers to integrate inclusive values and strategies into the Postal Service's day-to-day personnel management.

- e The Architectural Barriers Act of 1968, which requires the Postal Service to make its facilities accessible to individuals with disabilities.
- f. The Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act (GI-NA) of 2008, which prohibits discrimination based on genetic information.
- g The Equal Pay Act of 1963, which prohibits discrimination in pay based on sex.

## IMM Revision: Suspension of Global Express Guaranteed Service to Ghana

Effective February 3, 2017, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> suspended Global Express Guaranteed<sup>®</sup> (GXG<sup>®</sup>) service for items sent to Ghana. Until further notice, Post Office<sup>™</sup> facilities must not accept GXG items destined to Ghana.

The Postal Service will deliver already deposited GXG items addressed to Ghana but cannot accept any new GXG shipments. The Postal Service will continue to accept international letter mail and other package services destined to Ghana.

The Postal Service will revise the next update of *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM<sup>®</sup>) to reflect this suspension.

## Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service<sup>™</sup> money order:

- Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
- 2. Check that the proper security features are present:
  - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
  - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.
  - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changed.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

**B.** Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976, PS Form 2976-A, or PS Form 2976-B) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. All PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter, except for Priority Mail Express, which requires a customs form for all contents and weights. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an MPO except for those MPOs to which restriction "B2" applies and except for Priority Mail Express, which requires a customs form from all mailers.
- If mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use Exempt from Customs Requirements."

**B2.** All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

**C.** Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

**C1.** Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

**D.** Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

**E1.** Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

**E2.** Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

**E3.** Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

**F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

**F1.** Weapons of any type are prohibited.

**F2.** Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

**F3.** Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

**H.** Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

**I3.** Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

L. All Official Mail is prohibited.

**M.** Fruits, vegetables, live animals, and live plants are prohibited.

P. Official Mail only.

**Q.** Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

**R.** All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under Publication 52, Part 421, are prohibited.

**R1.** Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

**S.** Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

**T.** Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

**U.** Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

**U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

V1. Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.

**W.** Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Cremated remains are prohibited.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.

**Z.** No outside pieces (OSPs).

**Z1.** The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No 0817E or 0818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

## Learn How to Secure PCI Data

The Corporate Information Security Office (CISO) introduced a series of online training courses to help employees working in the Payment Card Industry (PCI) environment to secure employee, supplier, and customer data.

Employees working in the PCI environment or handling PCI information are required to take a combination of the following courses by July 18, 2017, depending on their role and system access. The following users will be autoenrolled in the courses they are required to complete:

- Any employee who performs credit/debit card transactions at any time, including retail associates/window clerks, Postmasters, and Postmaster relief must take Protecting Payment Card Information: It's Everyone's Responsibility (LMS Course #10026255).
- Clerks and supervisors who process credit/debit card transactions must take *Protecting Payment Information: Back Office Training* (LMS Course #10026254).
- PCI application developers must complete Open Web Application Security Project (OWASP) Top 10 (LMS Course #10026251).

 PCI system, network, and database administrators must take PCI Administrator Security Awareness (LMS Course #10026252).

Employees working in the PCI environment will receive an auto-enrollment notification via eAccess. The courses are now available, and employees can log into the Learning Management System (LMS) to complete them.

**Note:** Users who don't complete the course by the deadline date will have their PCI system access suspended until the courses are completed.

## Protect Yourself from Cyber Crimes During Tax Season

Tax season is here again. Every year, millions of people fall victim to cyber crimes, such as phishing and identity theft, which occur frequently during tax season.<sup>1</sup> In fact, data from the U.S. Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration indicates that Internal Revenue Service (IRS)-related scams have cost taxpayers over \$50 million since 2013.<sup>2</sup>

Tax season is a popular time for scammers to try to lure you into providing personal information or paying money. Scammers may also try to impersonate the IRS to ask you to verify tax return information or make a tax payment. Avoid becoming a victim this tax season — take the proper precautions to protect personal and Postal Service<sup>™</sup> information from these common tax scams:

 Phishing Scams. Pay close attention to emails that contain the IRS logo. Scammers may send emails that resemble "official communications" from the IRS, impersonate tax and software companies to ask you about refunds and transcript information, or even lure you into a fake tax website. Do not click on any links or open any attachments from suspicious emails claiming to be from the IRS. The IRS will never send an email to you requesting immediate payment or action.

Phone Scams. Watch out for phone calls from unknown numbers claiming to be from the IRS. Scammers may impersonate an IRS agent and give you a fake IRS badge number to appear credible. Don't be fooled — the IRS will never call you to demand payment, threaten you with law enforcement, or ask you for a debit or credit card number.

If you believe you've been a victim of tax fraud in any form, contact the IRS.<sup>3</sup> You may also report instances of IRS-related phishing attempts and fraud to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration at 800-366-4484.

Stamp Announcement 17-18: Mississippi Statehood Stamp

On March 31, 2017, in Gulfport, MS, the U.S. Postal Service<sup>®</sup> will issue the *Mississippi Statehood* First-Class Mail<sup>®</sup> stamp (Forever<sup>®</sup> priced at 49 cents), in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 474800). The stamp will go on sale nationwide March 31, 2017.

This stamp celebrates the 200th anniversary of Mississippi statehood. Mississippi became the 20th state on December 10, 1817. The stamp features a photograph taken in 2009 showing a close-up of a musician's hands as he plays his guitar. Mississippi is the birthplace of many legendary blues artists who created a uniquely American genre of music. Art director Greg Breeding designed the stamp with an existing photo taken by Lou Bopp.


## Availability to Post Offices: Item 474800, Mississippi Statehood (Forever priced at 49 cents) Commemorative PSA Pane of 20 Stamps

Stamp Fulfillment Services will make an automatic push distribution to Post Offices<sup>™</sup> (in Mississippi only) of a quantity to cover approximately 30 days of sales. Distribution quantities for the automatic push distribution are available by logging on to SFS Web at *https://sfsweb.usps.gov*. Post Offices may begin ordering stamps before the first-day-of-issue through SFS Web. However, we ask that Mississippi offices check the website link in this paragraph to determine the amount they will receive on their automatic push distribution.

## **Special Dedication Postmarks**

Only the following pictorial postmark is permitted for the *Mississippi Statehood* stamp. The word "Station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design, because it will be a temporary station.

Guidelines for Finalizing Mississippi Statehood Stamp Pictorial Postmark Art



To finalize the *Mississippi Statehood* stamp pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state, and ZIP Code<sup>™</sup> of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches horizontally by 2 inches vertically. Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1 inch.

The Postal Service<sup>™</sup> must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services four weeks before the event using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announcement/Report*. To get a copy of the form, go to *http:// blue.usps.gov/formmgmt/forms/ps413.pdf*.

## How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office, at The Postal Store<sup>®</sup> website at *http://www.usps.com/shop*, or by calling 800-782-6724. They should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark up to a quantity of 50. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. All orders must be postmarked by May 31, 2017.



Effective close-of-business March 31, 2017, all Post Offices<sup>™</sup>, stations, branches, postal stores, vending outlets, and authorized philatelic centers must (1) completely withdraw the stamp stock items and all associated products listed in the table and their related vending and store-prepared stamp items from sale, and (2) prepare them for destruction. Submit items to destruction sites according to local established procedures, under the guidelines in Handbook F-101, *Field Accounting Procedures*, and subchapter 11-6, Returning Stock to the Stamp Distribution Office or Stamp Distribution Center.

Do not permit sales of the stamp stock items, products, and their related vending and store-prepared stamp items listed in the table at retail counters and outlets after March 31, 2017.

## **Pictorial Postmarks Announcement**


As a community service, the Postal Service<sup>™</sup> offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office<sup>™</sup> station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail<sup>®</sup> postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State,  $ZIP+4^{\textcircled{m}}$  Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.





## How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail<sup>®</sup> requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office<sup>TM</sup>, by telephone at 800-782-6724, or at The Postal Store<sup>®</sup> website at *www.usps.com/shop.* 

#### **Digital Color Postmarks**

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16 inches side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches high x 4 inches long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. #### **Traditional Postmarks**

Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service<sup>TM</sup> will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.
