Cover Story

Prevent Heat Illness — Know the Signs and Act

Summertime can put employees at risk for heat illness. High temperatures and humidity, direct sun or heat, limited air movement, physical exertion, poor physical condition, and some medicines are contributing factors to heat illness.

When the body is unable to cool itself by sweating, heat-induced illness such as heat stress, heat cramps, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke can quickly worsen and eventually cause death. Symptoms range from mild and easily correctable to severe and life-threatening, if not immediately addressed.

Many heat-related deaths are preventable when employees recognize the symptoms and know what to do. Watch out for these signs of heat illness:

- Hot, dry skin or profuse sweating;
- Headaches;
- Confusion or dizziness;
- Nausea or vomiting;
- Rapid pulse;
- Muscle cramps;
- Weakness or fatigue; and
- Rashes.

Employees must immediately notify their supervisor and call 911 if they experience signs of heat-related illness. Employees can also be proactive and beat the heat with these tips:

1. **Hydrate before, during, and after work.** Prevention is important — drink at least 8 ounces of water every 20 minutes.
2. **Dress appropriately for the weather.** On warm days, wear light-colored, loose-fitting, and breathable clothing to keep your body temperature down.
3. **Use the shade to stay cool.** When possible, use shaded areas to stay out of direct sunlight.

276.22 Possession of Firearms by Postal Service Employees

Except for Postal Service employees who are authorized by the chief postal inspector or by the inspector general,

Postal Service employees are prohibited from possessing firearms in the following instances:

- While on official duty, either on or off Postal Service property.
- While on or within Postal Service property at any time.

The term “possessing” includes carrying or storing of firearms.

DMM Revision: Mailing Letter-Size Mailpieces with Magnets at Automation Prices

Policy regarding the mailing of magnets in enveloped letter-size pieces or affixed to letter-size, card-type pieces at machinable or nonmachinable prices was first addressed in *Postal Bulletin* 22083 (8-22-02, page 16). In *Postal Bulletin* 22221 (12-6-07, page 5), the Postal Service™ updated the policy regarding mailing magnets in enveloped letter-size pieces or affixed to letter-size, card-type pieces to allow them at automation prices.

As a result of working with the mailing industry, the Postal Service will publish new Customer Support Ruling (CSR), PS-351, *Mailing Letter-Size Mailpieces with Magnets at Automation Prices*, which will address the specifications for including magnets in enveloped letter-size pieces or affixed to letter-size, card-type pieces and receiving the applicable automation prices without requirements for testing.

CSR PS-351 will provide mailers with greater flexibility in designing enveloped letter-size pieces and letter-size, card-type pieces while increasing customers’ ease-of-use. Previously approved mailpieces with enclosed or affixed magnets are still valid if the mailpiece design has not changed since the approval. Customers may seek approval for automation prices for mailpieces with designs that differ from the guidelines in CSR PS-351 by contacting their local manager, Business Mail Entry. Managers receiving such requests must coordinate analysis and testing with the Pricing and Classification Service Center.

Policy regarding magnets enclosed in flat-sized mailpieces will remain as stated in *Postal Bulletin* 22221 (12-6-07, page 5). The Postal Service will publish CSR PS-351 in the next online update of Postal Explorer®, which is available at pe.usps.com.

DMM Revision: Business Reply Mail Refunds for Postage Affixed

Effective September 10, 2018, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)*, section 604.9.2.6, to clarify the refund charges for Business Reply Mail® (BRM) pieces returned with postage affixed.

The Postal Service is revising section 604.9.2.6, Postage Affixed to Business Reply Mail, to clarify that when the total face value of the postage affixed is \$500 or less, charges will be assessed at 10 percent off the face value. If the total face value of the postage affixed exceeds \$500, a charge of \$50 per hour (or fraction thereof) will be assessed for the actual hours to process the postage affixed on BRM pieces. This clarification will make the DMM consistent with PS Form 3533, *Application for Refund of Fees, Products, and Withdrawal of Customer Accounts*.

Although the Postal Service will not publish this clarification in the DMM until September 10, 2018, the standards are effective immediately.

DMM Revision: Postage Evidencing Deposit of Mail

Effective September 10, 2018, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)*, section 604.4.6.3, for clarity and consistency based on changes to certain products (i.e., Priority Mail Express® and Priority Mail®) and with the use of terms within this section (i.e., postage evidencing).

Although the Postal Service will not publish this clarification in the DMM until September 10, 2018, the standards are effective immediately.

9.2.6 Postage Affixed to Business Reply Mail

* * * * *

[Revise the text of 9.2.6 to read as follows:]

A Business Reply Mail (BRM) permit holder may request a credit to an advance deposit account for postage affixed to returned BRM pieces. A refund may be requested for postage affixed to BRM only if an advance deposit is not used or is unavailable. Only the value of the postage affixed may be credited or refunded. Refunds are not given for foreign postage affixed to BRM. The permit holder must submit a completed PS Form 3533 to the postmaster documenting the excess postage payment for which a credit or refund is desired. The permit holder must also present properly faced and banded bundles of 100 (when quantities allow) identical BRM pieces with identical amounts of postage affixed. A charge of 10 percent off the face value is assessed if the total face value of the postage affixed is \$500 or less. If the total face value of the postage affixed exceeds \$500, a charge of \$50.00 per hour (or fraction thereof) is assessed for the work hours used to process the credit or refund. Credits or refunds are not given for any BRM or Qualified Business Reply Mail (QBRM) per piece charges, annual accounting fees, quarterly fees, or monthly maintenance fees.

- a. Mailers may deposit Priority Mail Express (including Flat Rate), Priority Mail (including Flat Rate), retail First-Class Mail, First-Class Package Service — Retail, retail Media Mail, Library Mail, and USPS Retail Ground with a postage evidencing indicia at any postal facility, preferably within the area of the customers' local Post Office. Zone-priced pieces must have postage affixed to each mailpiece that is calculated to include the amount due as specified in 4.3.1, taking into account the weight and the zone from the ZIP Code of the office where the mailpiece is deposited to the ZIP Code of the destination address.

[Add new items b. and c. and renumber current item c. as new item d. to read as follows:]

- b. Mailers must deposit all presorted price mail at the authorized mailing office.
- c. Mailers must deposit all mail not specified in 4.6.3a and 4.6.3b at a postal facility within the ZIP Code shown in the indicia.
- d. Mailers also may dropship metered mail according to the standards in 705.19.0.

The Postal Service™ updated the top section of PS Form 4003, *Official Rural Route Description*, dated July 2018. The revised form removes the “Converted to centralized boxes only” section and includes a variety of formatting changes, such as larger font for legibility and a more streamlined display. PS Form 4003 is no longer available

from the Topeka Material Distribution Center nor as an online form on PolicyNet.

Instead, PS Form 4003 is *only* available via the eForm4003 web application at form4003.usps.gov/form4003web.

Address Management

Mover's Guides and Internet Change of Address Message Cards

Postal Service™ employees should have recycled any old copies of Publication 75, *Mover's Guide* by July 1, 2018. All Post Offices™ should have received the new July–September 2018 issue of Publication 75 by June 30, 2018.

To account for more customers submitting their change-of-address orders online, Post Offices need fewer *Mover's Guide* copies. Conserve copies the following ways:

- Make sure customers know that usps.com is the most convenient, safe, and secure way to submit a change-of-address order.
- Encourage carriers to take Internet Change of Address (ICOA) message cards on their routes instead of *Mover's Guide* copies.

Important Reminders

- *Mover's Guide* is printed and distributed four times a year.
- Keep *Mover's Guide* copies behind the counter *only*, not in inner or outer lobbies or on clerk counters.
- Give customers who are unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at usps.com a complete, unopened copy of *Mover's Guide*.
- Limit of one *Mover's Guide* per customer. Upon request, you may provide up to three copies.

Shipment Information and Inventory Management

Post Offices will receive copies of *Mover's Guide* in one or two shipments. The first shipments should have arrived by the end of June. The second shipments will arrive 3 to 5 weeks later.

- Boxes with blue stickers are the first shipment for this print run.
- Boxes with yellow stickers are the second and final shipment for this print run.

Stamp Announcement 18-25: Global Poinsettia Stamp



On August 26, 2018, in Kansas City, MO, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *Global Poinsettia* stamp (Global Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail International® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 10 stamps (565900). The stamp will go on sale nationwide August 26, 2018.

Global Poinsettia is a new Global Forever international rate stamp that can be used to mail a 1-ounce letter to any country to which First-Class Mail International® service is available. A striking photograph of a poinsettia arranged against a white background graces this round holiday stamp. Taken from above, the photo captures the beauty of the green leaves, the red bracts, and the yellow flowers in the center of the plant. Text repeated twice around the circumference of the stamp reads “GLOBAL” in bold red letters and “USA,” “FOREVER,” and “2018” in black. William J. Gicker was the art director and Greg Breeding designed the stamp with an existing photograph by Betsy Pettet.

Availability to Post Offices: Item 565900, Global Poinsettia, \$1.15 Global Forever, PSA Pane of 10 Stamps

Stamp Fulfillment Services will make an automatic push distribution to Post Offices™ of a quantity to cover approximately 30 days of sales. Distribution quantities for the automatic push distribution are available by logging on to SFS Web at sfsweb.usps.gov. Post Offices may begin ordering stamps on the first-day-of-issue through SFS Web, but must also check the amount they will receive in their automatic push distribution.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office or at The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop. They must affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark up to a quantity of 50. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. All orders must be postmarked by December 26, 2018.

How to Order First-Day Covers

The Postal Service also offers first-day covers for new stamp issues and Postal Service stationery items postmarked with the official first-day-of-issue cancellation. Each item has an individual catalog number and is offered in the *USA Philatelic* publication and online at usps.com/shop. Customers may register to receive a free *USA Philatelic* publication online at usps.com/philatelic.

Stamp Announcement 18-26: John Lennon Stamps

On September 7, 2018, in New York, NY, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *John Lennon* stamps (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in four designs, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive pane of 16 stamps (Item 565400). The stamps will go on sale nationwide September 7, 2018. **The *John Lennon* pane of stamps may not be split or sold individually.**

The newest stamps in the *Music Icons* series honor singer-songwriter John Lennon (1940–1980), a rock-and-roll hero successful both as a founding member of the Beatles and as a solo artist. Still beloved around the world, Lennon's music remains an anchor of pop radio and continues to speak for truth, peace, and tolerance. The stamp design features a photograph of Lennon taken by noted rock-and-roll photographer Bob Gruen in August 1974 during the photo session for Lennon's 1974 album *Walls and Bridges*. For the stamps, the original black-and-white image has been treated in gradations of color.

The stamp pane is designed to resemble a vintage 45 rpm record sleeve. One side of the pane includes the stamps, brief text about Lennon's legacy, and the image of a sliver of a record seeming to peek out the top of the sleeve. A black-and-white photograph of Lennon seated at his white piano appears on the reverse, along with Lennon's signature and the *Music Icons* series logo. Taken by photographer Peter Fordham, the original photograph was used to promote Lennon's landmark 1971 solo album, *Imagine*. Art director Antonio Alcalá worked on the stamp pane with designer Neal Ashby.

Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches (horizontally) by 2 inches (vertically). Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals, including in their raw, unmanufactured state, are prohibited. Official Mail shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Reserved for future use.

I3. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 27 inches.

S. Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

V1. Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on *USPS.com*. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.

W. Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Cremated remains are prohibited.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches high by 4 inches long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through
