Humans, Helpers, Heroes

Letter Carrier Shonda Lemon was making deliveries in a Chicago neighborhood when she grew concerned about an 89-year-old customer, Helen Iwanski, whose mail was piling up.

Lemon contacted police and asked them to check on Iwanski, who was found in dire need of medical attention after falling several days earlier. The customer was rushed to a hospital.

When police called Lemon to tell her Iwanski was alive, “I was just so overwhelmed, I cried,” she later told CNN, one of many U.S. and international media outlets that covered the story. The woman’s family was grateful for the Postal Service™ employee’s attentiveness.

“She really does look out for people and cares about them,” a niece said.

Lemon, who fondly recalled mutual friendly gestures such as wrapping rubber bands around Iwanski’s mail so the customer could easily grip it and finding pieces of candy attached to outgoing mail for Lemon to pick up, said she was eager to greet Iwanski upon her discharge from a physical rehabilitation facility.

“Each person has an intricate part of your life,” Lemon said, “and you never know how important they’ll be.” The letter carrier also received a plaque and certificate from the Chicago Police Department in appreciation for her lifesaving actions.

Lemon is one of several thousand employees who have been recognized through the Postmaster General (PMG) Heroes’ Program. These men and women have gone above and beyond the call of duty in a variety of situations, such as assisting lost children, getting help for sick or injured customers, spotting fires, and more.

Now in its nineteenth year, the program is based on a simple idea: Postal Service employees know the habits of their customers and the rhythms of their communities and are often the first to notify emergency personnel and render aid when something is wrong.

Employees must be nominated for the PMG Hero Award. Corporate Communications reviews nominations for accuracy, then sends them to the Inspection Service and the Office of Inspector General for approval. Following approval, each nominee receives a commendation letter from Postmaster General Louis DeJoy. Honorees are also featured in “Heroes’ Corner” on the Postal Service’s daily employee news site, *Link*.

DMM Revision: Special Handling – Fragile Discontinued

Effective July 10, 2022, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM)*, in various sections, to reflect the Postal Service's decision to discontinue the Special Handling – Fragile extra service. The decision to discontinue Special Handling – Fragile will not affect live animals tendered to the Postal Service for shipping as provided in Publication 52, *Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail*.

In addition, the Postal Service is revising the applicable Quick Service Guides (QSG), Notice 123 – *Price List*, and Publication 52 to reflect this standard.

The Postal Service believes this standard, which is effective July 10, 2022, will provide customers with a more efficient mailing experience.

IMM Revision: Update to U.S. Sanctions for Belarus and Russia

The Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM) in Chapter 5 and in the Individual Country Listings for Belarus and Russia. These revisions update information based on recent U.S. government sanctions that regard export, re-export, or transfer (in country) of “luxury goods” to Belarus and Russia and for which the Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) requires a license and an Internal Transaction Number (ITN).

For purposes of the new license requirements, a “luxury good” refers to any item that is identified under 15 Code of Federal Regulations (15 CFR) § 746.10(a)(1) of the Export Administration Regulations (EAR).

Although these revisions will be published in the next edition of the online IMM, the standards are effective immediately.

In alignment with U.S. government sanctions and the Bureau of Industry and Security, “luxury goods” destined to Belarus and Russia require a license and an Internal Transaction Number (ITN) (see IMM 524 for additional information). For purposes of the new license requirements, a “luxury good” refers to any item that is identified under new § 746.10(a)(1) of the Export Administration Regulations (EAR). See Exhibit 533 for a list of luxury goods destined to Belarus and Russia that require a license and an ITN. No exemptions are allowed.

IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for Australia

Effective June 16, 2022, the Postal Service™ is revising the Individual Country Listing for Australia in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM) to note an additional phytosanitary certificate requirement for certain plant products to safeguard against the entry, establishment, and spread of the khapra beetle (*Trogoderma granarium*) in Australia.

This revision is based on a formal request that Australia Post (the designated postal operator of Australia) made through the Universal Postal Union via *International Bureau Circular* 63, dated April 25, 2022.

IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for Kazakhstan

Effective June 16, 2022, the Postal Service™ is revising the Individual Country Listing for Kazakhstan in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM) to reflect a revision to the observation regarding limits for the duty-free import of goods.

This revision is based on a formal request that Kazpost JSC (the designated postal operator of Kazakhstan) made through the Universal Postal Union via *International Bureau Circular* 60, dated April 25, 2022.

 - Starting October 1, 2022: 200 EUR and 31 kg (68 pounds), respectively. Customs duties will apply as follows: the greater fee of either 15 percent of the amount exceeding 200 EUR or at least 2 EUR per kg of the weight exceeding 31 kg (68 pounds).

Publication 52 Revision: Required Hazardous Materials Separations

Effective June 16, 2022, the Postal Service™ is revising Publication 52, *Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail* (Pub 52), to incorporate new requirements for mailers to separate, into identifiable containers, all hazardous material (HAZMAT) requiring hazardous marks or labels from other mail when tendering to the Postal Service. The Postal Service is also adopting related standard operating procedures for the Postal Service’s acceptance, dispatch, and mail processing personnel to maintain the integrity of HAZMAT separation.

Additionally, the Postal Service is revising Pub 52 to reflect new Postal Service requirements that pre-owned, damaged, or defective electronic devices (such as cell phones, laptops, tablets, cameras, etc.) packaged with or containing lithium batteries be mailed only via surface transportation (USPS Retail Ground®, Parcel Select®, Parcel Return Service, or Ground Return Service) and bear specified markings.

Although the Postal Service will not publish these revisions in Publication 52 until a future edition, the standards are effective immediately.

2 General Guidelines

25 Basic Guidelines for Postal Service Personnel

251 Guidelines for Acceptance Personnel

[Revise the text of 251 to read as follows:]

Postal Service personnel may not open mail sealed against inspection except under the circumstances described in ASM 274. Accordingly, knowledge of the content of such mail may be obtained directly from the mailer (e.g., a mailer may ask questions about mailing requirements or mark the outside of the mailpiece to indicate the contents) or indirectly through leakage or other escape of the contents. Subject to the applicable restrictions, acceptance personnel must:

- a. Determine the mailability of all hazardous materials, perishable matter, or otherwise restricted matter offered for mailing at a retail unit or business mail entry unit (BMEU). This process must include a thorough inspection of all sides of the mailpiece for evidence of hazardous materials (e.g., markings). At retail units, mailers must be asked the question: “Does this

parcel contain anything fragile, liquid, perishable, or potentially hazardous, including lithium batteries and perfume?”

- b. If the contents are mailable, determine the specific quantity limitations, labeling, and packaging requirements that apply.
- c. With the exception of mail entered at a Destination Delivery Unit (DDU), Destination Sectional Center Facility (DSCF), or Destination Network Distribution Center (DNDC), verify that all mailpieces containing mailable hazardous materials are presented separately from mailpieces not containing hazardous materials.
- d. Refuse (as permitted in POM 139) to accept any material that does not meet the applicable requirements for mailing and refer the circumstances to the local postmaster or PCSC for a mailability ruling under 213 or 215, as appropriate.
- e. If a mailpiece containing a diagnostic (clinical) specimen is in a sack or tub, PS Tag 44 must be attached to ensure that the sack will be emptied at the processing point.
- f. With the exception of mail entered at a DDU, DSCF, or DNDC, ensure that mailpieces containing hazardous materials remain separated from other mailpieces and are placed into labeled containers further separated by transportation type (see 327.1a and 327.1b).
- g. See 253 for guidance regarding hazardous materials found in lobby drops or retail collection boxes.

See Chapter 7 for guidelines that Postal Service acceptance personnel must follow when handling hazardous materials, restricted matter, or perishable matter to be transported by air.

If the mailpiece is nonmailable, leaking or stained, do not collect it; notify the customer, if present, and contact a supervisor.
- b. Ensure that mailable hazardous materials are separate from all other mail upon loading on the delivery and collection personnel’s vehicle and that mailable hazardous materials remain separated at all times.

Where mailpieces are tendered in containers, pallets, or other mail transport equipment (see Handbook PO-502, *Mail Transport Equipment*), hazardous-materials mailpieces must be presented in a separate receptacle from non-hazardous-materials mailpieces.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Orderxxr Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

It's time for business system owners to do their part to protect critical Postal Service data by completing mandatory, annual CyberSafe Assessment and Authorization (A&A) training. The deadline for completing the course is August 15, 2022.

The FY 22 CyberSafe A&A training course provides employees with information on the policies and standards used to protect information within Postal Service networks. In addition, employees will learn roles and responsibilities, as well as the Risk Management process as it relates to the A&A process.

If you have already taken the FY 22 training, HERO has automatically provided an equivalency credit. You should see the course in your completed training transcript.

On July 6, 2022, in Simi Valley, CA, the United States Postal Service® will issue the *Nancy Reagan* stamp (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 482600). The stamp will go on sale nationwide July 6, 2022, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

This stamp commemorates Nancy Reagan (1921–2016), wife of the 40th president and first lady of the United States from 1981 to 1989. The stamp art is a detail from the official 1987 White House portrait by Aaron Shikler. The oil-on-canvas portrait features Mrs. Reagan dressed in her signature red color, in a flowing gown designed by James Galanos. The full-body portrait was cropped to accommodate the stamp format. Art director Greg Breeding designed the stamp.

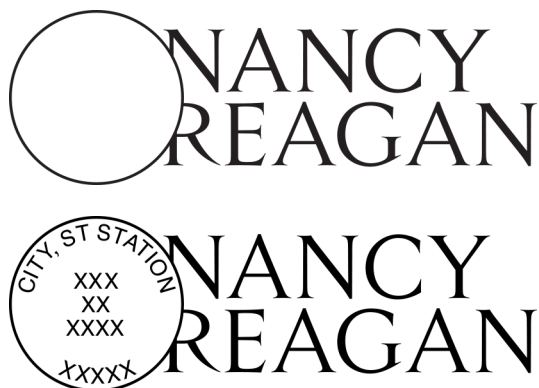

On July 21, 2022, in Newport, RI, the United States Postal Service® will issue the *Pete Seeger* stamp (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 16 stamps (580400). The stamp will go on sale nationwide July 21, 2022, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue. **The *Pete Seeger* pane of 16 stamps may not be split and the stamps may not be sold individually.**

With the newest stamp in the *Music Icons* series, the Postal Service™ honors folk singer, songwriter, and activist Pete Seeger (1919–2014). The stamp art features a color-tinted, black-and-white photograph taken in the early 1960s by Dan Seeger, the performer’s son. Pete Seeger is shown in left profile singing and playing his iconic banjo. The square stamp pane resembles a vintage 45 rpm record sleeve. One side of the pane includes the stamps and the image of a sliver of a record seeming to peek out the top of the sleeve. A larger version of the stamp-art photograph appears on the reverse side with the words “Pete Seeger FOLK SINGER.” Art director Antonio Alcalá designed the issuance. Dan Seeger’s photograph was color-tinted by Kristen Monthei.

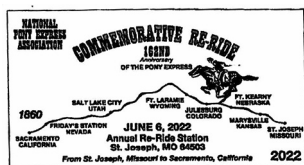
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

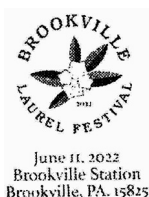

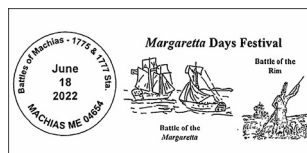

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 844-737-7826, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches (vertically) by 4 inches (horizontally). Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of

There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

Locally produced items are not authorized. Only merchandise that has been approved and assigned an item number by Headquarters Retail Marketing may be produced and sold.
